Changes to the TOEFL ITP Test

Initially we required everyone who passed the 1st stage screening to take part in a TOEFL ITP test. However, due to the changes to the academic calendar and move in dates brought on by COVID-19 we are making the below changes.

New TOEFL ITP Test Date : Wed. 22 April

Students required to participate

- Those students whose current English test score does not satisfy the requirements necessary by the time of departure.
- Those students who satisfy the requirements but whose score validity lapses before 15 May.

Only students to whom either of the above applies, will be required to take part in the TOEFL ITP test organized by the university.

We plan to conduct the test either in a large classroom or separated over several rooms in order to lower the chance of infection. However, if you would prefer not coming to the test venue due to concerns over COVID-19 infection, please let us know.
