9. Objective	<p>The course is a supplementary study for APS students who are interested in learning about diffusion and acceptance of innovations in society. The cases will be studied from different social and technical perspectives of the four-APS area of studies of International Relation &amp; Peace studeis (IRPS), Environment and Development (ED), Tourism and Hospitality (TH) and Culture, Media and Society (CSM).</p> <p>The program is offered to students interested in experiencing and exploring good practices in Kitakyushu city, Fukuoka, Japan. OECD has selected the city of Kitakyushu as one of the four cities of Green Growth City. Being exposed and having the chance to learn from the policies, strategies, culture, values and experiencing the Japanese concept, the field study will provide the platform for students to study and develop their knowledge and skills of finding practical solutions for a sustainable community.</p> <p>This program focuses on:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.Introducing the strategies that Kitakyushu has utilized to revitalize the region and became model for urban decentralization, and be selected as the first Green Growth City by OECD</li> <li>2.To realize and compare the progress of Kitakyushu as a model city with</li> </ol>

Requirements for students.	<p>Since the program is designed based on group works and peer-peer learning, all students are required to be punctual and actively attend all activities of the program including pre-activities, field visits and post-activities.
