
AY 2019 Fall Course Registration Checklist

Timetable	Is the subject offered in AY 2019 Fall Semester?	No →	Even if listed within your curriculum, there are courses which are not offered during AY 2019 Fall Semester. Please confirm the AY 2019 Fall Semester classes by downloading the class timetable from the Academic Office website, or viewing the class times listed in the syllabus.

Curriculum	Is the subject available for your curriculum?	No →	There are certain courses which are only available on the AY 2017, AY 2011 curriculums. Please confirm the courses available for your curriculum by viewing the AY 2019 Fall Semester class timetable (Academic Office website), referring to the Undergraduate Academic Handbook (pp. 90-99 for the AY 2017 curriculum) (pp. 120-130 for the AY 2011 curriculum).

Registration Period	Can the subject be registered during Course Registration Period A?	No →	During Course Registration Period A, students may only register for Language Subjects, Common Liberal Arts Subjects (AY 2017 curriculum*, AY 2011 curriculum) and Major Subjects from one's own college. *However, there are some Common Liberal Arts Subjects which cannot be registered during Period A for the AY 2017 curriculum so please make sure to check the Undergraduate Academic Handbook (pp. 136-137). Major Subjects from another college may be registered from Registration Period B. Subject fields may be confirmed with the AY 2019 Fall Semester class timetable (Academic Office website), the Undergraduate Academic Handbook (pp. 90-99 for the AY 2017 curriculum) (pp.120-130 for the AY 2011 curriculum).

Credit Completion	Have you already received credit for this course?	Yes →	With the exception of courses specifically allowing repeat registration, you may not register for a course which you have already completed, even if the instructor or language of instruction differs. You may confirm your credit completion status from the Campusmate Grade Confirmation Screen or printed grade report. Courses which may be registered multiple times are listed in the Undergraduate Academic Handbook (p. 135 for the AY 2017 curriculum) (p. 138 for the AY 2011 curriculum).

Prerequisite Subjects	Have you completed the prerequisites for the subject?	No →	Certain subjects require the completion of credit for their prerequisite subjects before registration is possible. Please confirm prerequisite subjects for courses in the Undergraduate Academic Handbook (pp. 90-99 for the AY 2017 curriculum) (pp. 120-130 for the AY 2011 curriculum).

Year Level	Do you meet the course's required year level?	No →	In the case of some subjects, you may only register once you have met or exceeded the specified year level. Language Proficiency*	Do you have permission to register subjects held in the language opposite to your language basis?	No →	Before you are able to register subjects held in the language opposite to your language basis, you must first meet the requirements established by your own curriculum. Prior Application	Does the subject require prior application in order to be registered?	Yes →	Subjects requiring prior application may not be registered from the Course Registration Screen. Please review the course syllabus and Courses Requiring Prior Application from the Academic Office website.
Session Subjects	No ↓ Are you eligible to graduate this semester?	Yes →	Students eligible to graduate in March 2020 may not register session subjects. *Students who have earned less than 100 credits prior to their semester of graduation are eligible to apply.
