### **Testing Microphone/Speaker Function (1/2)**

#### Before Class Starts

- When you enter the meeting ID, the message to the right will automatically be displayed on your screen
- Click "Test Computer Audio" and you will be able to test your speaker and microphone
- Follow the instructions on your screen (Reference: see next page)

#### **Outside of Class**

 As shown on the left, when you are not in a class it is also possible to start up the Zoom application and test your audio or camera from the settings screen
