I. Expected entry to Japan / Details for AP House Move-In

- O Staff and student RAs (resident assistants) are moving forward with preparations at AP House for accepting new residents so that in cooperation with one another dormitory residents will be able to live safely, worry-free, and in good health. As measures for preventing novel coronavirus infections, in addition to installing AI fever detection cameras at building entrances, we have also begun building an online system that can immediately track the results of the health monitoring that each new dormitory resident carries out.
- We have established two periods: "Move-In Period 1" and "Move-In Period 2", for moving into AP House.

- O If you wish to move into the dormitory during [Period 1], we are able to accept you. - For those of you planning to move into AP House during 【Period 1】, please be sure to monitor your health twice daily (morning and night) beginning the day you review this announcement. Each student shall download the "★体温体調記録シート/ Temperature & condition record sheet", record the results every time they monitor their health, and then email the record sheet to the AP House Office by the submission deadline shown below.

- For English-basis undergraduate students, successful completion of Japanese Foundation (I II III) and Intermediate Japanese is one of the graduation requirements. There are three starting levels for registration: Foundation I, Foundation II, and Intermediate. Your starting level will be determined by the results of your Japanese placement test (held 9/14 and 9/24), so be sure to take the test.
- The time schedule for Japanese classes differs as follows depending on the starting level you register for.

Further, all language subject classes will be held online (Zoom). As real-time attendance is required, in consideration of students living in countries and regions with a time difference of more than two hours from Japan, we will be offering a special time schedule.
