\* Number of participants: For long-term programs that cover more than one academic year, only the number of students who started the program in the corresponding academic year is listed.

\* Implementation Period: For overseas travel-based programs, the period of overseas travel is indicated, and for online programs, the period of practicum, we basically hold pre- and post-program classes to give students opportunities to prepare for the practicum and to reflect on the knowledge or skills they have learned. Through these classes, students deepen their learning through the program.
