Course Overview	[Course Overview] The program is an introduction to Thai language and culture. This program offers learners with a well-crafted lesson of 4 skills of speaking, listening, reading, and writing Thai to be applied and used for everyday life basis. Students will also be able to enjoy and involve in a hands-on experience while participating in the cultural activities and fieldworks, which will enhance them to immerse naturally into the use of Thai language in the real settings. [Program Contents] This program gives students basic language skills for everyday living, based on practicing in real situations. It provides basic Thai lessons and is a friendly course for any students who has interest in Thai language and wish to study Thai and/or further Thai language development. The class sessions are divided into two; the morning session and the afternoon session. The lessons are aimed at enhancing the students' practical oral and written Thai language skills. There are also field trips to reinforce students' language exercises, cultural classes and cultures. Study the language in class with skilled instructors who have experience in teaching Thai to foreigners. Students will have chances to use their language skills by participating in nearby fieldwork. Also, during the program, students will be accompanied by language partners (Thai students) who will introduce them to various aspects of Thai culture.

Course Objectives	This course aims to develop Thai language skills further from Thai language classes in APU by focusing on engaging in the practice of the real situations both in the classroom and through fieldworks. Upon course completion, students should be able to: 1) convey individual and important information in Thai, 2) communicate fluently in daily basis situations, 3) enhance the skills and experiences concerning traveling and working in Thailand, and 4) understand and grasp fully the implication of Thai culture and be able to immerse themselves properly into the real situation.		
Teaching Methods	This couse uses "Linguistic Field Methods" where students get a chance to elicit Thai language ability from native speaker teachers, lecturers, and informants in an engaging manner both in the classroom and out in the real Thai environment. Students will use the acquired Thai language from the class to obtain more vocabularies and sentences from different real life situations. They have to actively participate in a hands-on activity, as well as, take notes, draw, and take photos by themselves.
