Throughout the process, students are expected to gain insights into Japanese ways of life, behaviours, attitude, and thoughts. Students are also expected to work collaboratively within a multicultural group, which is an essential skill in their APU life.
到達目標 Course Objectives	Standards for Course Completion: In order to successfully complete the course, students are required to fulfill ALL of the following points: 1) attend all sessions, including pre-program, field research (in-person or online), and post-program sessions 2) actively participate in group meetings, activities, and discussions 3) adhere to the university policies and regulations during field research to ensure students' safety and courtesy to interviewees 4) complete all the assignments, including written reports, group presentation(s), and a final reflection paper* *Final reflection paper submission is a must to pass this course.
