



#### Basic rules of credit transfer

- > All credits taken at the host university will be transferred as Subject Field.
- In general, transferred credits do not count towards Areas of Study.
   \*For APS students, up to 10 credits may be approved to count towards an Area of Study based on the screening carried out by the College of Asia Pacific Studies (APS)
- Akita International University are not accredited by either AACSB, EQUIS, or EPAS. Therefore, major subjects at the host university may not be transferred as APM major education subjects.
- Credit transfers are determined by Academic Affairs based on the students' application.
   Courses that are not related to APU's course offerings (e.g., physical education, art, etc.) cannot be approved.

Therefore, please keep that in your mind whey you apply for this program. We strongly recommended you to take courses you wish to study at AIU. If you are concerned about credits, we recommend you to study at AIU for a semester in stead of one year.


