Advices for Future Students in this program

Academic advice:

Course Selection: Choose courses that align with both interest and future goals as AIU has a variety of courses. Study Methods: Be proactive, participate in class discussions, and use AIU's academic resources as they are super useful.

Support System: AIU has strong student support, including professors and personal counsellor.

Daily Life Tips:

AlU is in a remote location—be prepared for fewer entertainment options. The remote campus builds a strong, close-knit student community. Explore Akita's local culture and nature as it has a lot to offer.


[Host University Supports]


Host University's staff helped us if we had a problem, but it was difficult to gather information about life at the university and course registration etc., because the university's website had limited resources.
