Nomination


If you wish to study at DUFE as an exchange student, we need an official nomination emailed to the coordinator by your home institution by the given deadline. (nomination form attached)

Visa Application

International students should apply for a visa (category X) to study in China at the Chinese Embassy in your home country. The following documents are usually required for applying an X visa to China:

- 1. JW202 Form issued by DUFE
- 2. Admission letter from DUFE
- 3. Physical examination record made in the latest month
- 4. A valid passport
- 5. Completed visa application form attached with one of the applicant's recent color photograph
- Contact Chinese Embassy/Consulate for detailed information
- Students from certain countries may not need a JW202 form when they apply for a 1 semester study visa. Contact the Chinese Embassy/Consulate for detailed information.

Food
