Health insurance

As an exchange student, you are covered by the “Student IN” insurance through the Swedish financial agency Kammarkollegiet. It is valid 24 hours/day in Sweden and in the Schengen area *if you have a Schengen visa* and can be used for direct travel to and from your home country to Sweden. It includes emergency care, liability coverage and personal property coverage.

Students must obtain a contents insurance to cover dorm room/apartment and your belongings against theft and damage (such as Länsförsäkringar).
