HOW TO START THE APPLICATION PROCESS?	<p>First, we need to receive an official nomination from the home university. The nomination has to be sent by e-mail to incoming@mup.cz and includes the following information:</p> <p>First and last name Date of birth Gender Study programme at your home institution and degree of studies Planned study period at MUP Contact e-mail address Nationality</p>
APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURE	<p>1. APPLICATION FORM After the official nomination, students receive in their e-mails a personal application ID number that will enable them to log into our online application system. They are asked to complete all required fields and apply. Please note that an electronic passport-size photograph (not a whole passport photograph, just a photograph of yourself) is also required, the application will not be saved in the online application system without it.</p> <p>2. LEARNING AGREEMENT Please download and complete the relevant form according to the exchange program/home university. When completed, it has to be signed by the student and also approved by the responsible person at the home university.</p>

	<p>3. TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS A summary of the previous study results. It must be issued in English and confirmed by the relevant person at the home university.</p> <p>4. LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE A certificate that proves the level of English (doesn't apply to native speakers and Slovak students who wish to study in Czech study programs). It can be either an international language certificate or proof issued by the home university.</p> <p>Apply and send all the above-mentioned documents (except the application form that is completed online) in scanned copies to incoming@mup.cz within the deadline.</p> <p>Incomplete forms or forms without necessary signatures will not be accepted.</p>
<p>MINIMUM LANGUAGE SKILLS</p>	<p>B2 (but higher level recommended) - Please note that your language skill level is directly related to your academic success. Even if you fulfill the minimum language requirement, you are advised to further improve your language skills before the beginning of your semester abroad.</p>
