About SolBridge International School of Business

Established in 2007, SolBridge International School of Business is a prestigious AACSB-accredited institution located in Daejeon, South Korea's Silicon Valley. SolBridge offers a comprehensive range of programs, including undergraduate (BBA), graduate (MBA, MS), and doctoral (Ph.D.) degrees, with all classes conducted in English.

Mission and Vision

SolBridge's mission is to educate the next generation of Asian thought leaders, equipping them to succeed in the fast-growing and rapidly changing Asian economy. Its vision is to become an Asian center of excellence in global business education, fostering innovation and leadership in an increasingly interconnected world.

Location

SolBridge is situated in Daejeon, South Korea, just 55 minutes from Seoul by high-speed train. Known as Korea's Silicon Valley, Daejeon is the country's fifth-largest city and a hub for innovation, hosting approximately 300 research and development institutions. With a population of 1.5 million, the city boasts the highest concentration of researchers in South Korea, including over 10,000 Ph.D. holders who live and work in the area.

Korea's most international business school

With 1200 students on campus, SolBridge has 70% international students representing over 70 different nationalities from Europe, Asia, North and South America, Africa, and Oceania. 70% of our faculty members are international professors who hold a PhD degree from prestigious American, European, or Asian universities.

An American-style curriculum focusing on Asian expertise

Based on an American curriculum, SolBridge delivers an Asian-focused business education with global perspectives. During their studies, students will acquire practical and marketable skills.

Spring 2025 semester dates

- Nomination deadline for Spring: November 15
- Application deadline for Spring: December 15
- Orientation week (typically 1 week before the start of the semester): Spring 2025: February 24 – February 28, 2025
- Dates of the Spring semester (including course make-up week): March 4 - June 20, 2025

Fall 2024 semester dates

- Nomination deadline for Fall: May 15
- Application deadline for Fall: June 15
- Orientation week (typically 1 week before the start of the semester): e.g. Fall 2024: August 26 – 30, 2024
- Dates of the Fall semester (including course make-up week): September 2 – December 20, 2024

SolBridge's credit system

Bachelor students need to complete 120 credits to graduate over the period of four years (8 semesters). Standard semester workload of BBA students is 15 credits per semester. Most courses at SolBridge are worth 3 credits. To be able to graduate with one of the chosen Specializations, students shall write and defend a Specialization Project (Bachelor's degree thesis) equivalent to 3 credits.

MBA students need to complete 36 credits to graduate in one year. Standard semester workload of MBA students is 12 credits per semester.

MS students need to complete 45 credits to graduate in two years. Standard semester workload of MS students is 9 credits per semester.

Language skills

Within the curriculum, regular BBA students are encouraged to take intensive Korean language courses to get a decisive advantage when entering the job market in Korea, or abroad. BBA transfer/dual degree and graduate students are free to choose extra foreign languages as electives.

Study abroad opportunities

SolBridge offers exchange and dual degree opportunities with over 250 partner universities in over 60 different countries. Students can spend one or two semesters abroad in places such as Canada, the United States, Europe, East and Southeast Asia.

Dual Degrees program are available at Bachelor level (2+2, 3+1, as well as 4+1 and 3+1+1 pathway to Master programs) and Master level (1+1, 0.5+1).

Tuition scholarships for degree-seeking students

SolBridge International School of Business offers financial aid in the form of admission scholarships. Scholarships are granted on a case by case basis depending on the applicant's English level, academic standing, and extracurricular activities. Admission scholarships are given for tuition only and typically range from 30 - 70% of the cost of tuition. In extraordinary circumstances, a financial tuition grant of 100% may be granted. Admission scholarships are valid for one semester and are renewable depending on the student's academic performance.

Accommodation - the school policy requires BBA freshmen students to stay at the residence provided by SolBridge for their first semester in South Korea. BBA students share a double bedroom with a private bathroom. After completing their first semester, students can live off-campus. Visiting and graduate students may stay at the residence depending on availability. Otherwise, they will be guided towards living off-campus. Breakfast - breakfast is provided at the school residence and is a compulsory component of accommodation fees.

Additional Costs - As of March 2021 according to the Korean legislation, every international student will be a subject for a compulsory national health insurance (NHI) registration. The national insurance monthly cost is estimated to ~60 dollars. Please, see the guidelines [here](#).

General living expenses - meals in South Korea are generally very affordable. Meals at the school cafeteria cost around USD 4 - 7. Meals outside campus may range from 5 to 12 dollars. Personal expenses depend upon the student's lifestyle. The school recommends students plan monthly living expenses around USD 400 – 500.

Expenses for the initial week in South Korea - some additional payments of around USD 300 might be needed during the first week in Korea (airport shuttle bus, medical check-up, personal care products, residence security card, Local ID card registration, etc.).

Part-time job opportunities - working part-time is allowed after the completion of the first semester. According to the Korean government regulations, students can work on or outside campus up to 10 hours per week, 40 hours per month.

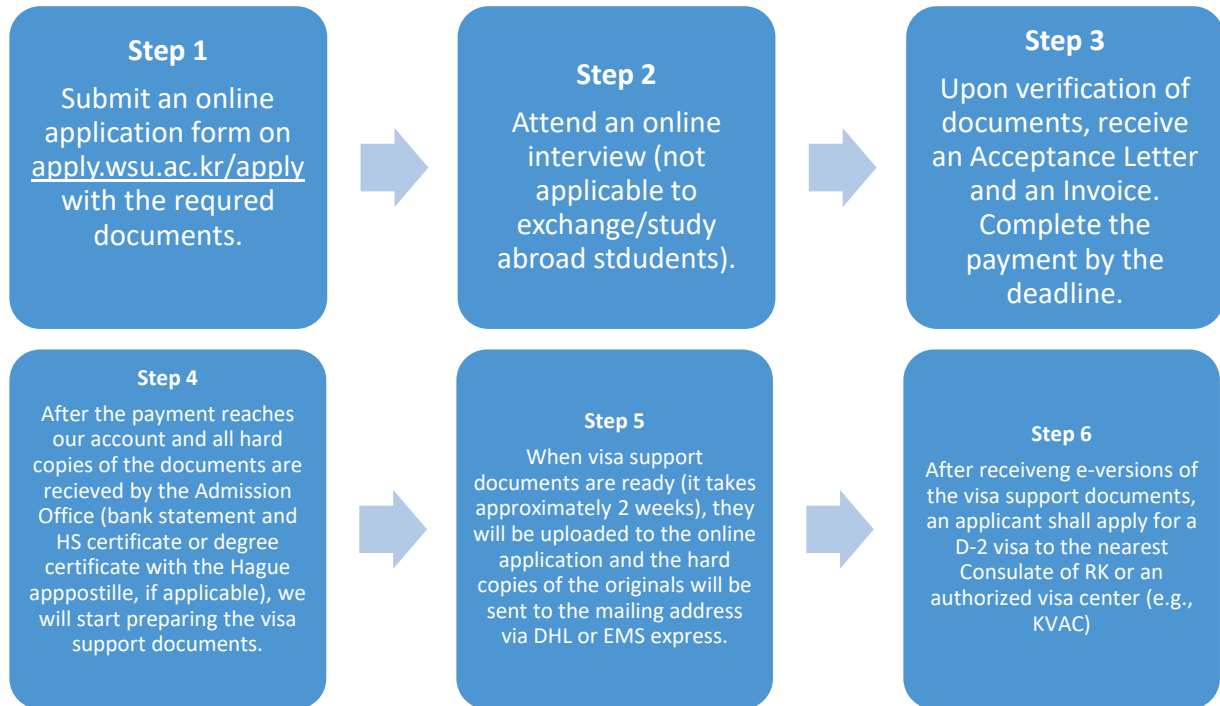
