Accreditation

The American College of Greece is accredited by The New England Commission on Higher Education (NECHE) and its degree programs are validated by The Open University (OU) in the United Kingdom.

Credit System

ACG requires that students complete 121 US credits in order to meet the bachelor's degree requirements. Most courses carry 3 credits, thus students need to have satisfactorily completed 40 courses to be eligible for graduation. Science courses, which include lab hours, carry 4 credits, whereas some courses can carry 1 or 2 credits.

A student may register for up to 15 credits in the Fall/Spring semesters, and up to 6 credits in each Summer session.
