## REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be enrolled at least in the second year of undergraduate studies at the home university
- Be in good standing at home university

Standard credit load (per semester) Recommended: 4 courses (12 credit hours)  
Minimum: 3 courses (9 credit hours)  
Maximum: 5 courses (15 credit hours)



## PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT

Exchange students are not required to submit an official language certificate, however, we ask our partners to ensure students have one of the following:

- IELTS: minimum of 5.5 with no bands less than 5.5
- iBT TOEFL: minimum of 70
- Cambridge English: B2
- Duolingo: minimum score of 100
