


- You can check the credits required for graduation by following the steps below.

## Key Point 1

The total number of credits required for graduation is **124 credits**.  
 Out of 124 credits, **102 credits** must be earned from:  
 ■Common Education Subjects (**40 credits**) and  
 ■Major Education Subjects (**62 credits**).  
 The remaining 22 credits are not restricted to any specific subject field.  
 You may freely complete the credits from subject fields of interest.  
 $124 \text{ credits} - 102 \text{ credits} = 22 \text{ credits}$   
 The subject fields for the remaining 22 credits are not specified.
