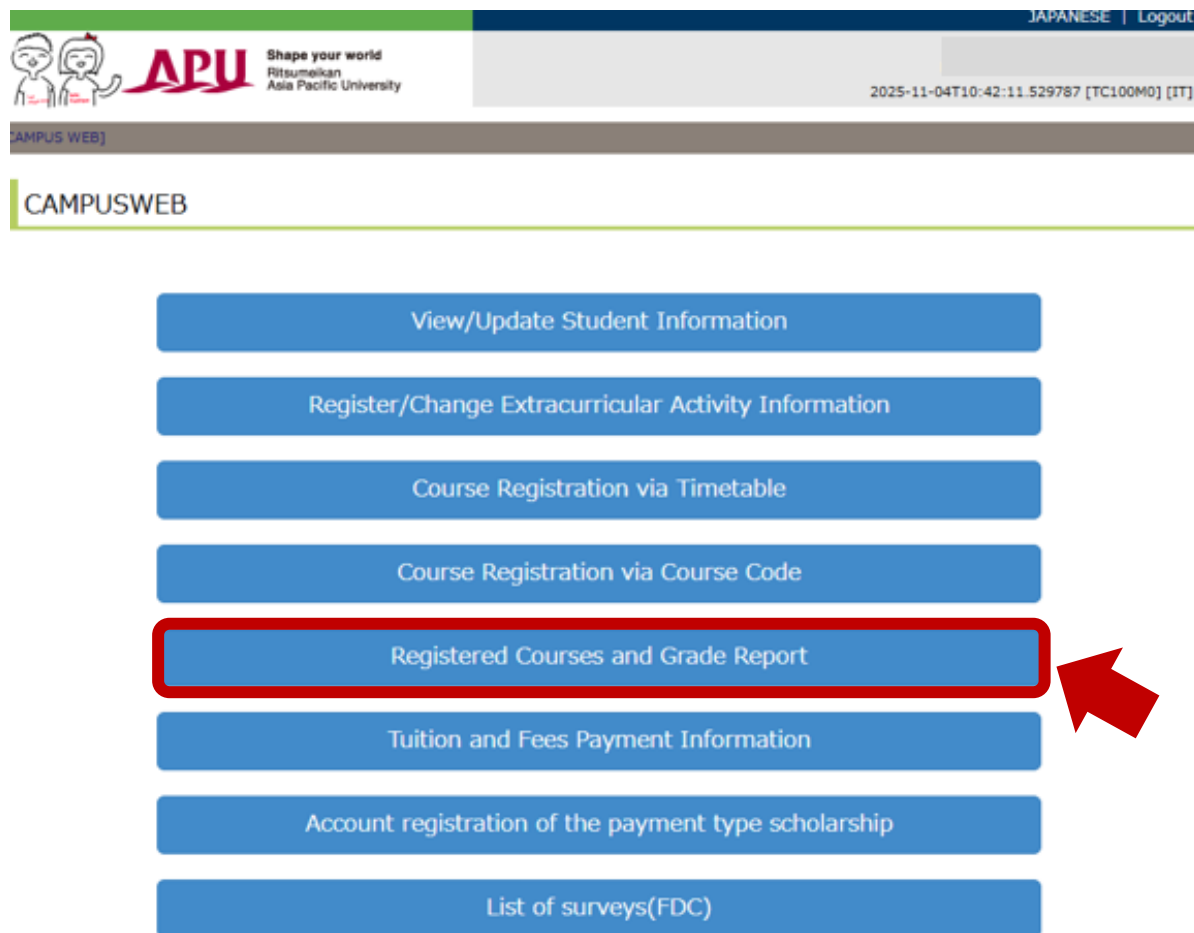

Key Point 1

The total number of credits required for graduation is **124 credits**.Out of 124 credits, **102 credits** must be earned from:■Common Education Subjects (**40 credits**) and■Major Education Subjects (**62 credits**).

The remaining 22 credits are not restricted to any specific subject field.

You may freely complete the credits from subject fields of interest.

$$124 \text{ credits} - 102 \text{ credits} = 22 \text{ credits}$$
