

- The remaining **26 credits** (62 credits - 36 credits) may be taken freely from Major Education Subjects offered under any of the three Areas of Study (CSM, GE, IR).
- Credits completed from Major Education subjects under an Area of Study you are not registered for will be counted toward “<APS Major Education Subjects (\_\_, \_\_)>.”

## Key Point 1

The total number of credits required for graduation is **124 credits**.Out of 124 credits, **102 credits** must be earned from:■ Common Education Subjects (**40 credits**) and■ Major Education Subjects (**62 credits**).

The remaining 22 credits are not restricted to any specific subject field. You may freely complete the credits from subject fields of interest.

$$124 \text{ credits} - 102 \text{ credits} = 22 \text{ credits}$$

The subject fields for the remaining 22 credits are not specified.

## Key Point 3

Japanese Language Education is required up to the intermediate level. Your starting level and required credits will vary depending on your placement test results and any exemption requests submitted during your enrollment.

## Key Point 4

If the number of credits completed in “— Elective Required\_[CSM]/[GE]/[IR] Introduction to Major” exceeds the required credits for each subject field, the excess credits will be counted toward “· Introduction to Major Studies Subjects” and “<Common Liberal Arts Subjects>.”

## Key Point 5

Credits earned in the following subject fields will be counted toward the <Registered Area of Study ( )>:

- Required\_Graduation Research II
- APS Common Subjects B
- Seminar Subjects

## Key Point 6

The fields indicated above ① and ② will differ based on your registered Area of Study.

- You must complete at least 36 credits in Major Education Subjects designated for your registered Area of Study (including 2 credits from “· Required\_Graduation Research II”)
- Credits completed from Major Education subjects under an Area of Study you are not registered for will be counted toward “<APS Major Education Subjects ( , )>.”
