





# FLOW OF RESPONSE WHEN A STUDENT, STAFF OR FACULTY FAINTS



## REQUEST TO PROTECT FAINTED INDIVIDUALS' LIVES


- If they are lying on their back, please turn them to the side as there is the danger of choking hazard.
- If their heart has stopped, please activate AED and perform CPR.



**Important notes regarding evacuations:**

During an evacuation, be mindful of aftershocks, remain calm, and take action in such a way as to avoid jeopardizing the safety of the people around you.

- If you are indoors, be careful of glass, etc., move along the walls when inside rooms, and walk in the middle of the hallways.
- Always use stairs to evacuate. Do not use elevators.
- If possible, open all doors first. During evacuations, place priority on helping people with injuries or disabilities.
- Carefully check no one is left behind, and leave all doors open.  
(However, in case of a fire, the doors of rooms affected by the fire should be closed).



**Important notes regarding evacuations:**

- Key principles for safe evacuation: Do not push, do not run, do not talk, do not go back to the site of the fire.
- If you are surrounded by smoke, cover your mouth and nose with a towel or other cloth, keep your head close to the ground, and escape. When breathing, inhale through your nose, and exhale through your mouth.
