

【Announcement】 Issuance of APU Account (ID), Password and Student ID Number

Please read this carefully as it is very important information for your campus life.

1. How to notify APU user ID, password, and student number

Students will be informed of their APU account user ID and password through the “Online Enrolment Procedures System” in the evening on March 27. You will need your APU account login details to access all of APU’s systems, including your APU email, the university’s online noticeboard (Campus Terminal), Zoom, and for online course registration.
