

# AY 2022 Fall Semester Class Implementation Format (October 3~)

As announced on July 26, 2022, the class implementation format for the AY 2022 fall semester will be based on the BCP Level.

- As of September 22, the BCP Level is currently Level 2, so classes will be held in the classroom at 100% capacity from October 3. If the university's BCP level changes in response to the COVID-19 situation going forwards, the university will notify students through Campus Terminal.
- Please note, in the AY 2022 fall semester, on-campus classes will be held in-person from the first week. In the first week of the spring semester, all classes were held online, this will not be done in the fall semester.

| BCP Level             | Class Implementation Format  |
|-----------------------|--|
| BCP Level 2 or below  | Classes held in the classroom at 100% seating capacity.*   |
| BCP Level 3           | Classes may be held in-person with seating capacity up to 50%. Seats are available first-come-first-serve, and if the capacity is reached, then students may take the class online from another classroom. However, language classes will be held online.* |
| BCP Level 4 or higher | In principle, all classes held online.   |

\* If a student is unable to take classes in-person in the classroom due to an underlying health condition that increases their risk of developing severe symptoms if they contract COVID-19, **they may apply in advance to receive permission** to attend class online.
