AY 2022 Fall Semester Class Implementation Format (October 3~)



As announced on July 26, 2022, the class implementation format for the AY 2022 fall semester will be based on the BCP Level.

- As of September 22, the BCP Level is currently Level 2, so classes will be held in the classroom at 100% capacity from October 3. If the university's BCP level changes in response to the COVID-19 situation going forwards, the university will notify students through Campus Terminal.
- Please note, in the AY 2022 fall semester, on-campus classes will be held in-person from the first week. In the first week of the spring semester, all classes were held online, this will not be done in the fall semester.

BCP Level	Class Implementation Format
BCP Level 2 or below	Classes held in the classroom at 100% seating capacity.*
BCP Level 3	Classes may be held in-person with seating capacity up to 50%. Seats are available first-come-first-serve, and if the capacity is reached, then students may take the class online from another classroom. However, language classes will be held online.*
BCP Level 4 or higher	In principle, all classes held online.

^{*} If a student is unable to take classes in-person in the classroom due to an underlying health condition that increases their risk of developing severe symptoms if they contract COVID-19, they may apply in advance to receive permission to attend class online.
