

## Regarding Class schedules of undergraduate seminars

### [1] Major Seminar I & II (3rd-year seminar)

The class schedule for 3rd-year seminar (“Major Seminar I” & “Major Seminar II”) on the Syllabus System is temporarily set to 3rd period Saturday. Please be aware that this is an interim schedule. The actual schedule will be announced in conjunction with other lecture courses before Course Registration Period A.

Once you have been accepted into a seminar, the university will automatically register ‘Major Seminar I’ or ‘Major Seminar II’ for you in the actual schedule. Please note that other courses cannot be registered in the same slot as ‘Major Seminar I’/‘Major Seminar II’.

### [2] Research Seminar/Graduation Research I (4th-year seminar)

The class schedule for “Research Seminar”/“Graduation Research I” on the Syllabus System is set to 1st period Saturday by default. Please be aware that this is a “dummy” schedule. Similarly, on your course registration screen on Campusmate, the course is placed by default on 1st period Saturday. Please confirm with your instructor regarding the actual class schedule and the classroom before classes commence.

### [3] Undergraduate Thesis/Graduation Research II (4th-year seminar)

On your course registration screen on Campusmate, “Undergraduate Thesis”/“Graduation Research II” is placed by default on 2nd period Saturday. Please confirm with your instructor regarding the actual class schedule and the classroom before classes commence.

**Note that there have been cases in which students failed to confirm the 4<sup>th</sup> year seminar class schedule before the beginning of the semester and found that the schedule clashed with other courses. Please confirm the schedule with your supervisor before Course Registration Period A to ensure that you don't have any conflicting schedules.**
