Obtaining a Visa to stay in Japan for Job-hunting after Graduation

There is a system in place making it possible for international students to apply to the Immigration Bureau for a change in visa status to stay in Japan after graduation for the purpose of job hunting. APU students wanting to apply for a change in visa status for this purpose must first be issued a 'Recommendation Letter' by the university.

Students due to graduate in <u>September 2017</u> who are still searching for a job are encouraged to come to the guidance about these procedures.
