Organization and Mechanics of the Oral Presentation	Presents information in a logical and interesting sequence. The delivery is free, or almost free, of grammatical or punctuation errors. Errors do not detract from meaning.	Presents in a logical sequence. The delivery has few grammatical or punctuation errors. Errors may be slightly distracting but do not affect meaning.	Presents in a logical sequence but may lack cohesive devices. The delivery has noticeable but acceptable grammatical or punctuation errors. Meaning is affected.	Logical sequence in the presentation is not obvious, but can be discerned with effort. The delivery has many grammatical or punctuation errors, sometimes making the meaning unclear.	No logical sequence in the presentation. Presentation is full of grammatical, or punctuation errors, making meaning difficult to understand.
