- It will be possible to register for online-only classes, regardless of your current location.
- Each student should register for courses during "Course Registration Periods" via <u>Campusmate</u>. These periods are held before each semester begins. Please see the Graduate School website [<u>News Section</u>] for the detailed schedule.
- Each student is responsible for securing the necessary equipment and network connections required to take online classes via Zoom. Please see the Academic Office website [Online Classes (Zoom)] page for requirements.
- If taking a class on campus it is not required to bring a PC or tablet, but it is possible there will be groupwork with students taking the class online. Please check the syllabus and announcements in the first class meeting to confirm what equipment will be required for class.
- If you have continuous on campus classes and online classes in your schedule, it will be possible to use designated classrooms on campus to take online classes. Zoom-style classes have a designated classroom in parenthesis () in the <u>Course Timetable</u> on the Graduate School website. Rooms for other classes will be announced on Campus Terminal.
