On Thursday, May 6, the prefecture of Oita announced "Requests to Oita Prefecture Residents in Order to Contain COVID-19 Infections." At present, no new cases of infection have been identified among APU students, faculty, or staff members. However, the number of infected persons is increasing in the prefecture, pushing Oita into stage 3. Beppu City, in particular, has had many reports of infection spread through groups eating and drinking together, as well as going to karaoke. Students, faculty, and staff members should be even more alert and thoroughly implement infection control measures.

With regard to classes, extracurricular activities, or in the work of staff members, there are no changes in policy at this time.
