

Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University Governing Advisory Board Regulations

May 17, 2006
Regulation No. 689

Article 1

The APU Governing Advisory Board (hereinafter, “the Board”) will be established to evaluate the University and proffer advice.

Article 2

1. The Board, with the advice of the President, shall evaluate the University and provide the President with advice on university administration and projects.
2. The President will reflect the evaluation outcomes and advice in university plans.

Article 3

1. The scope of evaluation and advice to be provided by the Board are as follows:
 - (1) Advice on the status of program execution by the University Senate and executives
 - (2) Advice on the main operational policy of APU (medium- to long-term plans and vision, recruitment of executives via international public offering, etc.)
 - (3) Advice on the SGU Project and other specific challenges
 - (4) Advice aimed at improving brand power and international competitiveness of APU
 - (5) Evaluations of self-assessment based on university evaluation (Japan University Accreditation Association/JUAA) standards
2. The Board will convene once a year; however, meetings will not be convened in those years in which the University undergoes accreditation.

Article 4

1. The Board shall consist of external stakeholders who are not Ritsumeikan Trust officials, faculty or staff.
2. The members in the preceding paragraph shall be appointed by the President as needed in academic years in which evaluations are conducted.

Article 5

1. The Board shall have a Chair.
2. The Chair will be designated by the President from among the Board members.

Articles 6

Revision and Abolishment of Regulations

Article 7

1. Revision or abolishment of these regulations shall be conducted by the President upon deliberations by the University Senate Meeting.

Supplementary Provision
These regulations shall take effect on June 1, 2006.

Supplementary Provision (2008.6.10: Partial revisions in line with changes to Committee roles, duties and membership)
These regulations shall go into effect on June 10th, 2008, to be applied from April 1st, 2008.

Supplementary Provision (September 9th, 2014: Partial revisions in line with changes in committee structure and meeting convocation)
These regulations shall go into effect on September 9th, 2014.

Supplementary Provision (October 2nd, 2018: Partial revisions in line with changes to the committee name and meeting convocation)
These regulations shall go into effect on October 2nd, 2018.
