

Ezra Vogel to Deliver Special Guest Lecture at Ritsumeikan APU

Renowned professor and author of the best-selling *Japan as Number One* will speak on "China and Japan: Learning from Each Other" in his first appearance at APU since 2013.

Professor Ezra F. Vogel, a Henry Ford II Professor of the Social Sciences Emeritus at Harvard University and author of the recent Harvard University Press publication *China and Japan: Facing History*, will give a special lecture at the Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University campus in Beppu City, Oita Prefecture on Friday, November 15, 2019. In this lecture, which is to be delivered in English and will be open to the public, Professor Vogel will look at the relationship between Japan and China, and what the two countries can gain from each other.

This lecture is part of the lead-in to APU's 20th anniversary celebration, taking place next year. An academic advisor of APU; this will be Professor Vogel's fourth visit to the campus.

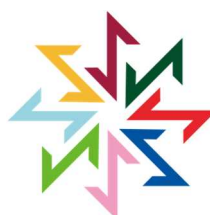
