- The extended abstracts asked for in the application form will be included in the volume of Conference Proceedings to be distributed at the conference.

**Registration**

As this is a joint conference, special registration arrangements have been made for AJJ members.

- (a) Students. The cheapest way to participate in the conference is to pay the student membership fee of 2800 yen. This will cover the meals (two lunches and a dinner), the Conference Proceedings, and one year’s membership of IAAPS including access to the journal, *Asia Pacific World*.
- (b) Professors and others: There are two ways to participate:
  - (i) Pay registration fee of 5000 yen to cover meals (two lunches and a dinner), refreshments and the Conference Proceedings.
  - (ii) Take out a year’s membership of IAAPS, also 5000 yen, which will cover the meals (two lunches and a dinner) refreshments, the Conference Proceedings, and the subscription to the Journal, *Asia Pacific World*.
