

RCAPS 20th Anniversary Logo Design Competition



The Ritsumeikan Center for Asia Pacific Studies (RCAPS) was established in July 1996 as a lead-up to the opening of Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (APU) and this year marks its 20th anniversary. To commemorate the 20th anniversary, RCAPS will hold a competition for a 20th anniversary logo to be the symbol for RCAPS. This logo will be used in promotion.

1. Screening Criteria

One of the main goals of RCAPS is to develop Asia Pacific Studies as a new, policy-oriented academic field, for the purpose of realizing sustainable development and harmonious coexistence in the Asia Pacific region. RCAPS is calling for logos that reflect RCAPS' characteristics and uniqueness. 20th anniversary logo designs should comprise a symbol mark (graphic) and logo type (letters). The letters (logo type) must be "RCAPS".

3. Deadline: June 24 (Fri) 16:30
