

How to cancel your student visa

(Immigration procedures for students departing Japan on a leave of absence or withdrawal from APU)







- You are not allowed to have a student visa during your leave of absence or after withdrawal. Be absolutely sure to cancel your student visa.
- **X** If you do not cancel your visa. you may have trouble returning to school later on.
- Keep your invalidated card (with the punched hole).


Items to present at immigration

(1) Embarkation card for reentrant



Say you want to cancel your student visa: "Ryuuqaku biza wo kyanseru shimasu."

2 Residence Card or **Certificate of Alien Registration**



The immigration officer will punch a hole in your card. (This will make your card invalid.)

Be sure to get a hole punched in your card!

The consequences of not cancelling your student visa

If you leave Japan without canceling your student visa, according to the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, you might be punished. You could also get disadvantage(s) when applying for COE and/or visa renewal.

Once there was a student who were taking a leave of absence and did not cancel student visa at airport. He applied for visa renewal after reinstated, but it took 3 months to complete the procedure at Immigration Bureau, renewed visa was valid only for 6 months, and work permit application was denied.

To avoid such disadvantages and humiliation, you MUST cancel your student visa at airport immigration when you leave Japan.

Cancelling your Student Visa

You have a student visa. This visa allows you to attend school in Japan. If you take a leave of absence or withdraw from the University, you cannot keep your student visa. You must cancel your visa when you leave Japan.

1. When leaving Japan


You will go through an immigration screening when you are leaving Japan. At this screening, you will submit an Embarkation Card (ED card) to the immigration officer. You can get an ED card from the Student Office or when you are going through immigration.

2. Do not check any boxes for "Re-entry Permission" on the ED card

The immigration officer may ask if you plan on returning to Japan in the future. Even if you plan to return to APU in the future, you need to cancel your current student visa. Be sure to tell the immigration officer that you want to cancel your visa because you are leaving school.

Because you will cancel your student visa, you will need to get a temporary visa or other new visa if you want to come to Japan after starting your leave of absence or after withdrawing from the University.





When you want to return to APU

You will apply for a new student visa after your application to return to APU has been approved. If you take a leave of absence or withdraw from the University without cancelling your student visa when you leave Japan and if it can be shown that you reentered Japan using your student visa during your withdrawal or leave of absence, not only will your application for a new student visa become very complicated, but you may suffer serious penalties. This could also cause problems for you when renewing your visa after returning to APU.

Don't make things difficult for yourself. Cancel your student visa when you leave Japan.
