

## Results of the 2024 Spring Semester AP House 1.2.5 Survey

### (1) Objectives

- ① To understand the actual condition of students living in a living learning dormitory where they can experience intercultural understanding, tolerance, and communication among different cultures through living together in a multinational and multicultural environment, thereby fostering their capability of thriving in a multicultural society
- ② To verify whether AP House fulfills its fundamental role as a foundation for international students who enter the University on an English basis, and do not possess Japanese language proficiency, to adapt to life in Japan.
- ③ To inspect the achievements in floor management and community building conducted by Resident Assistants (RAs) at AP House.

### (2) Target Participants

- Residents of AP House 1, 2, and 5 \*Mainly first-year students, excluding RAs.

### (3) Implementation Period

Thursday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024, ~ Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

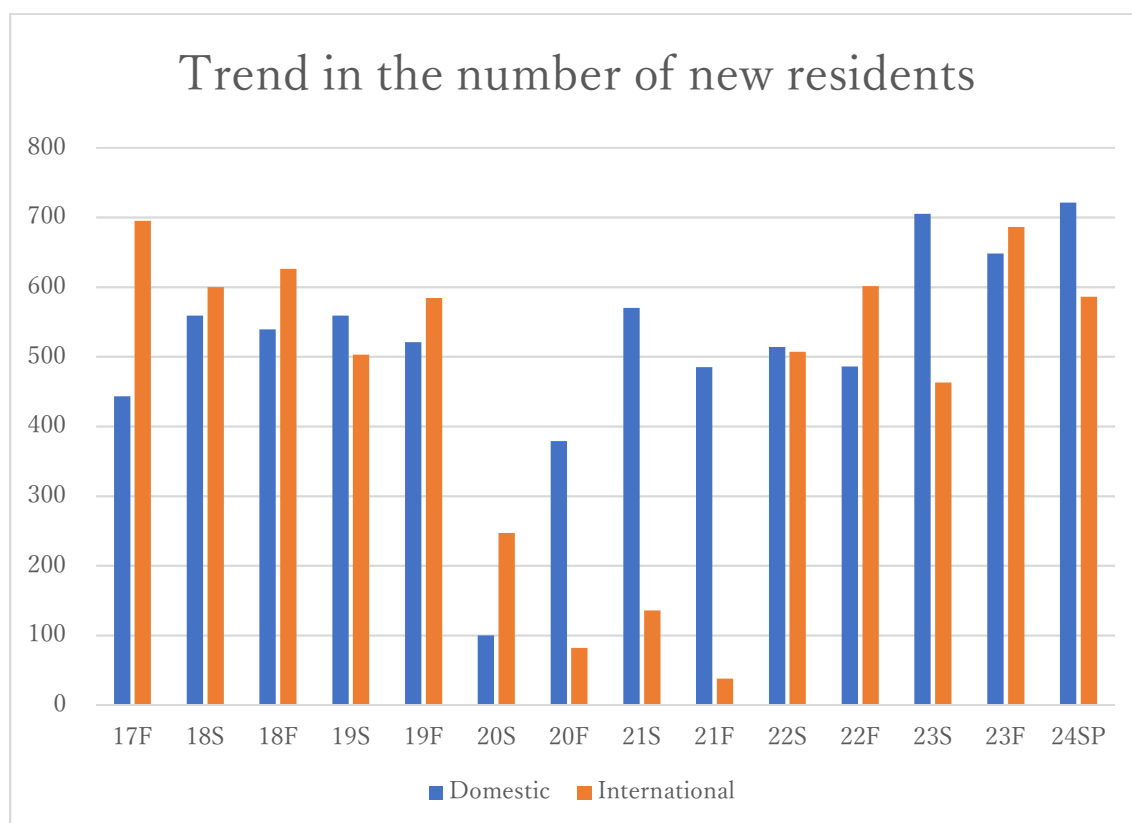

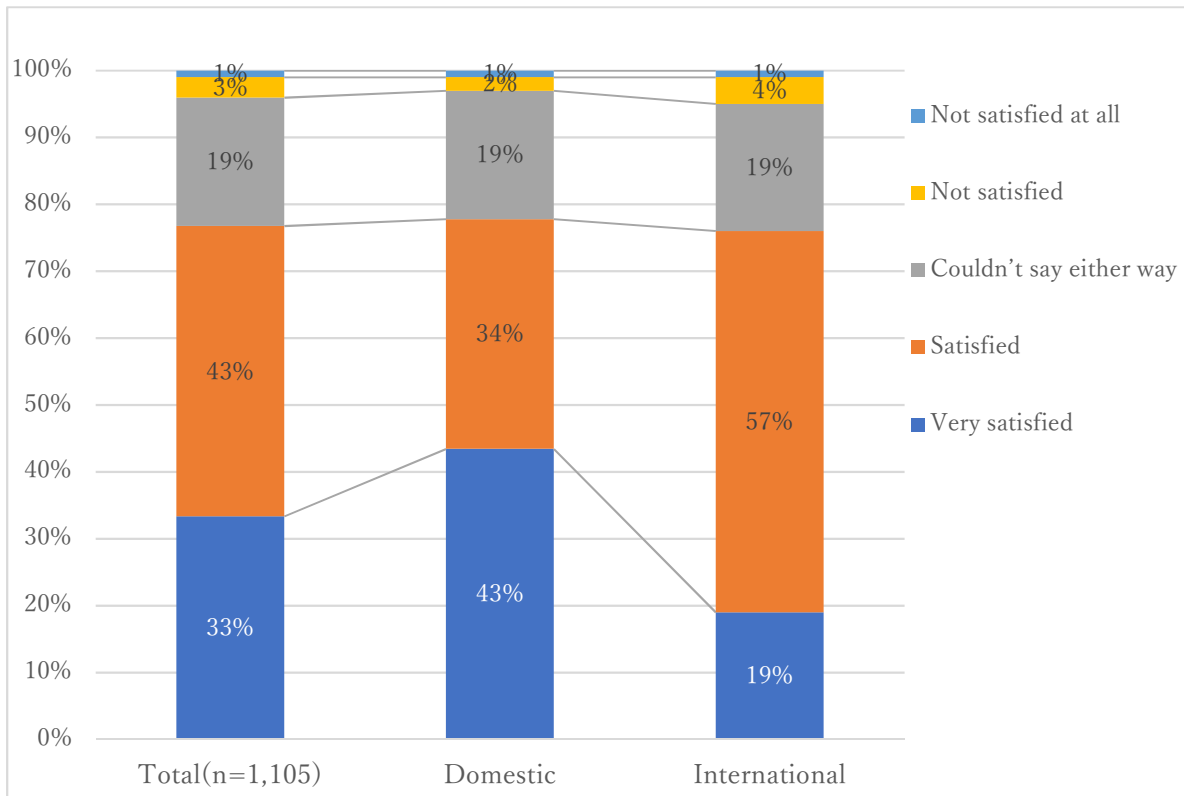

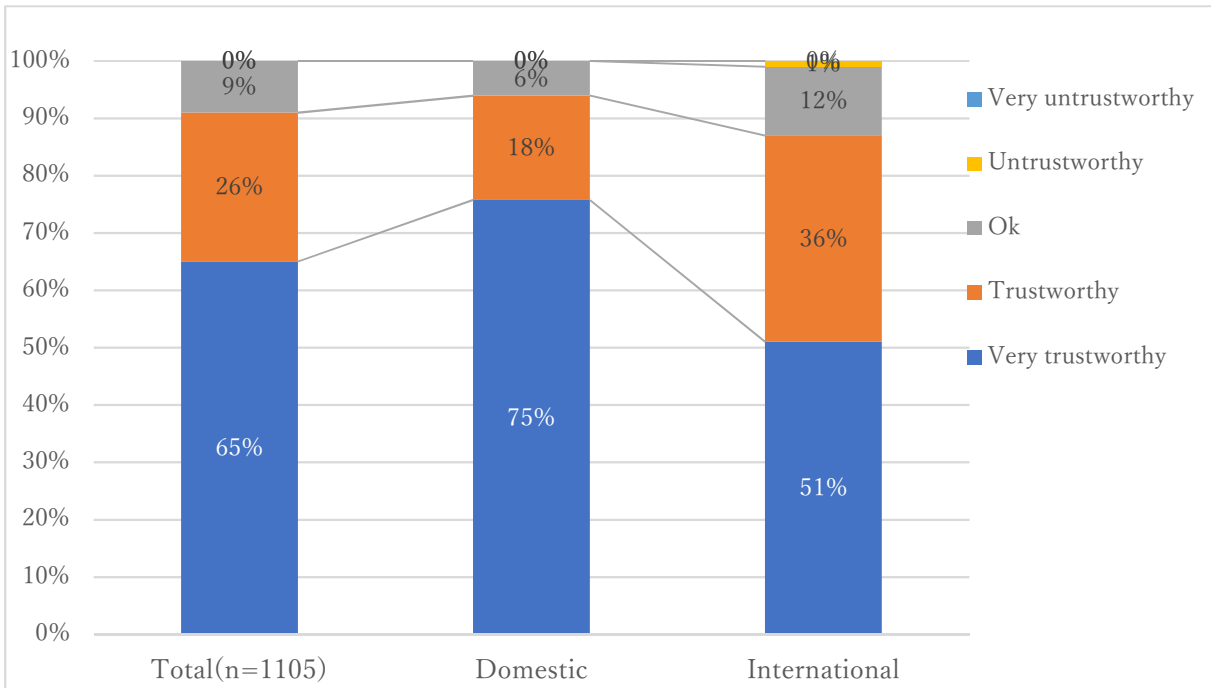


(3) Q7, What concerns do you have about your residential life?

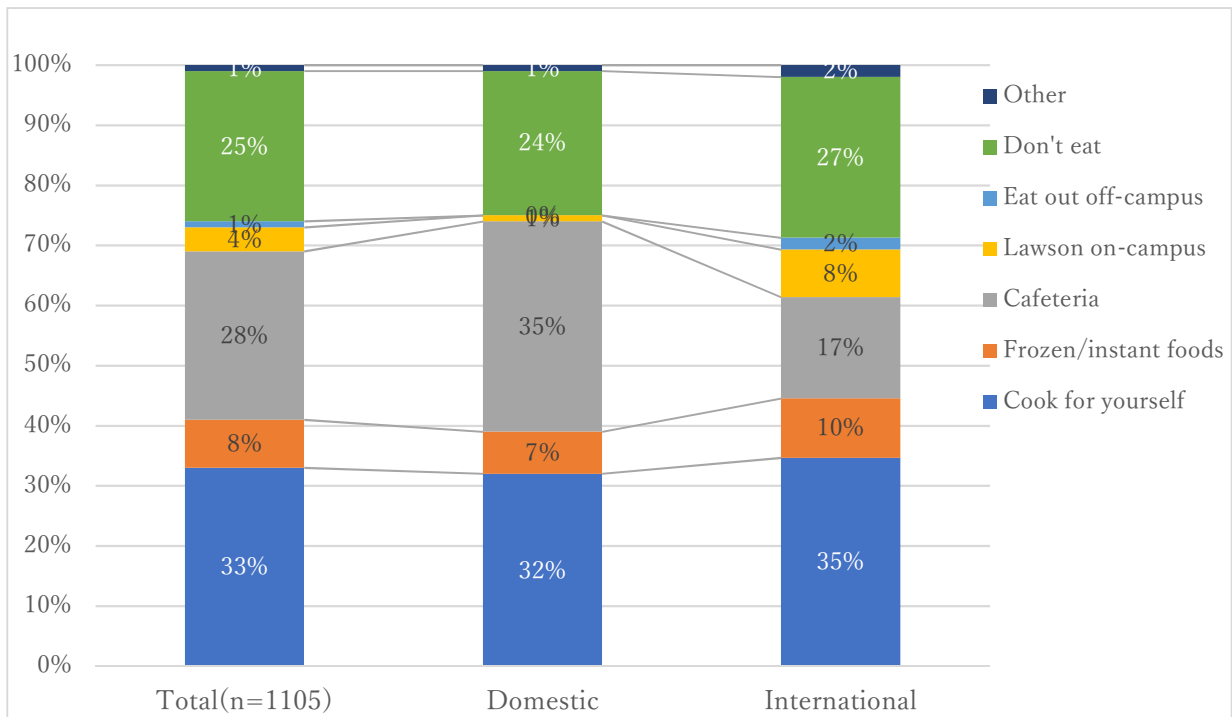

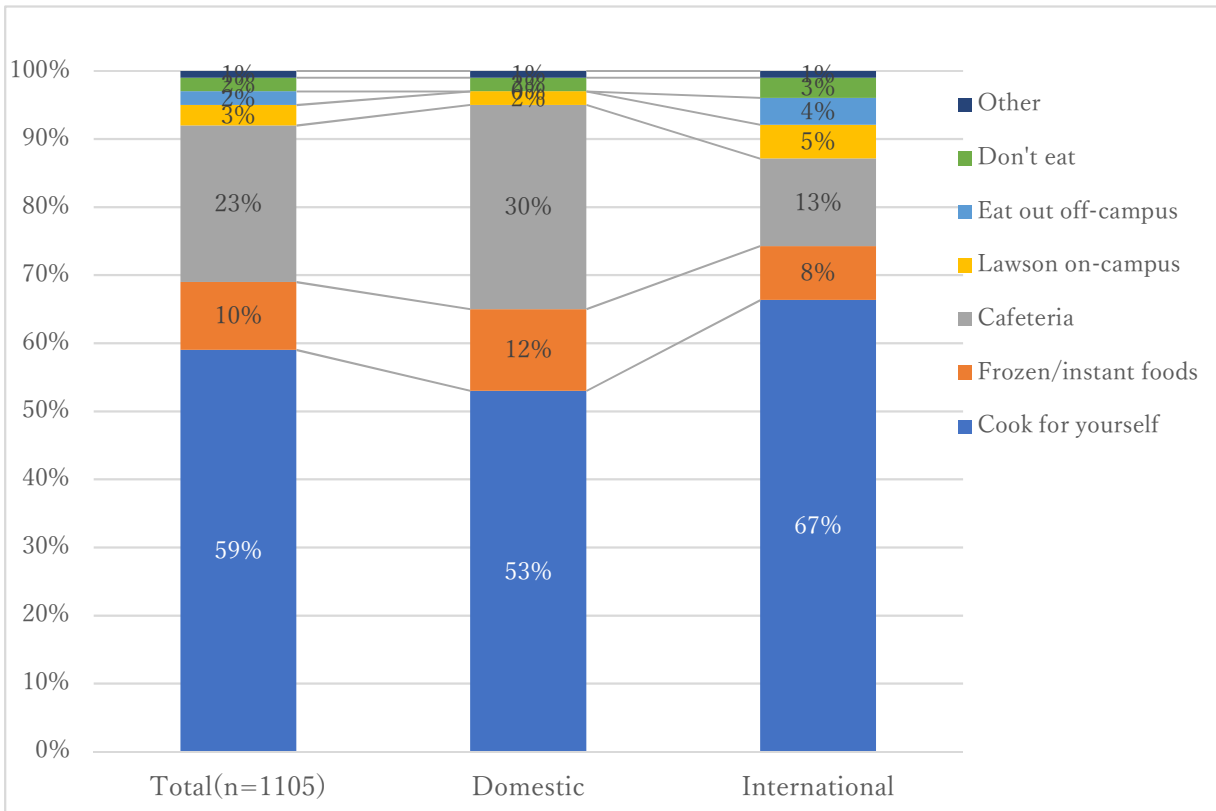
(4) Q8, How do you feel about RA(s) on your floor?



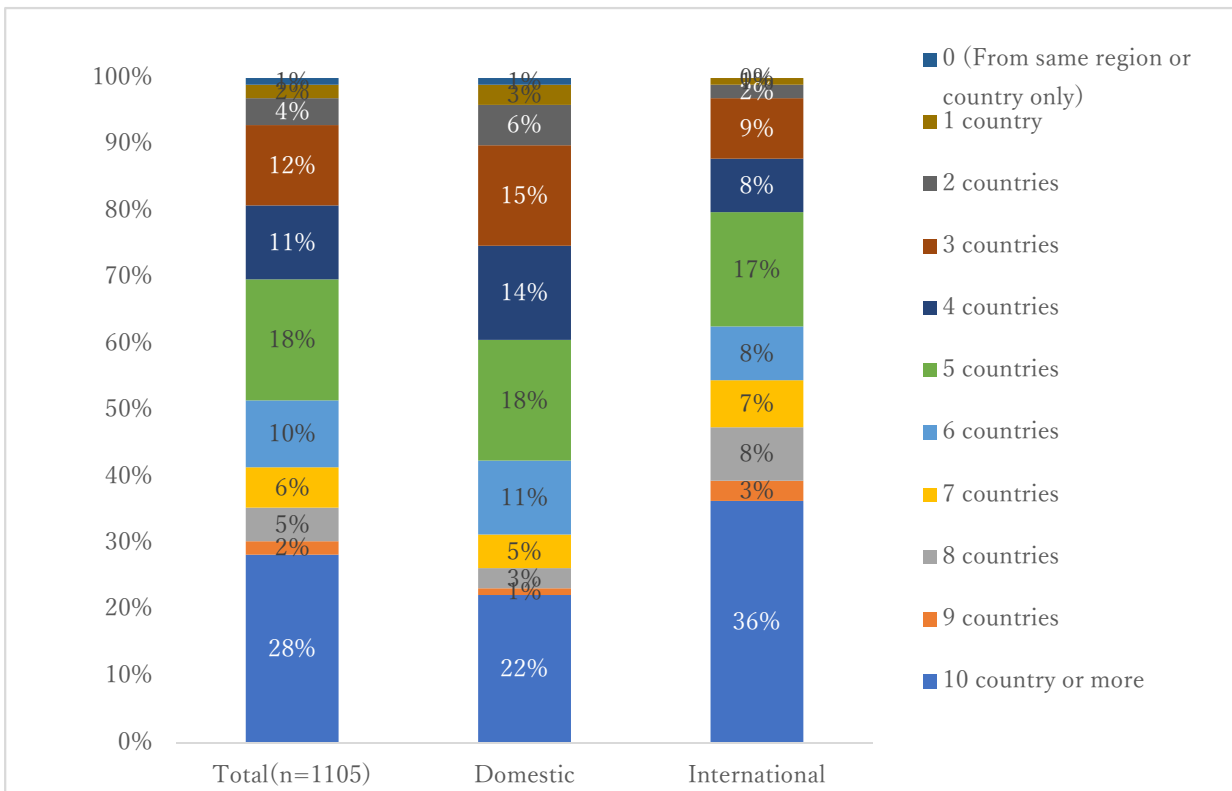

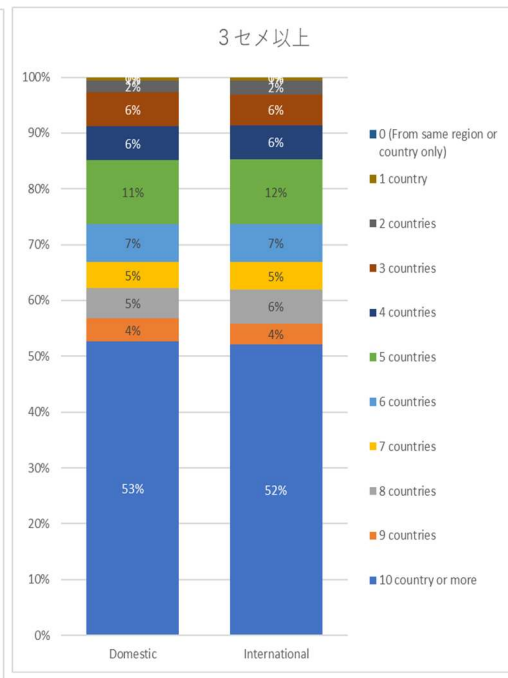
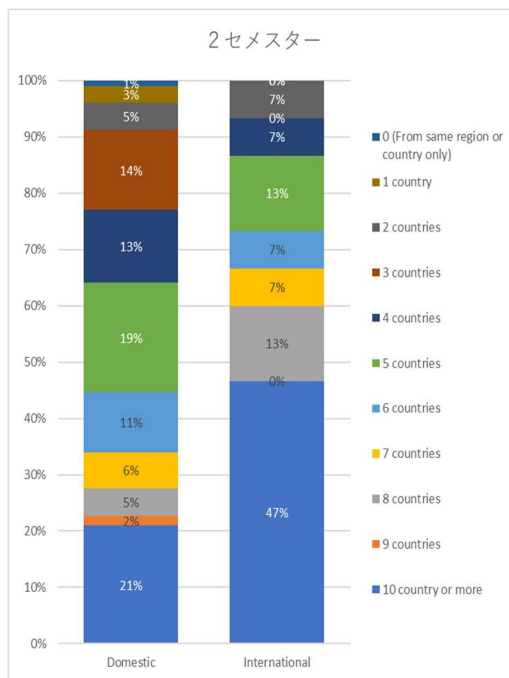
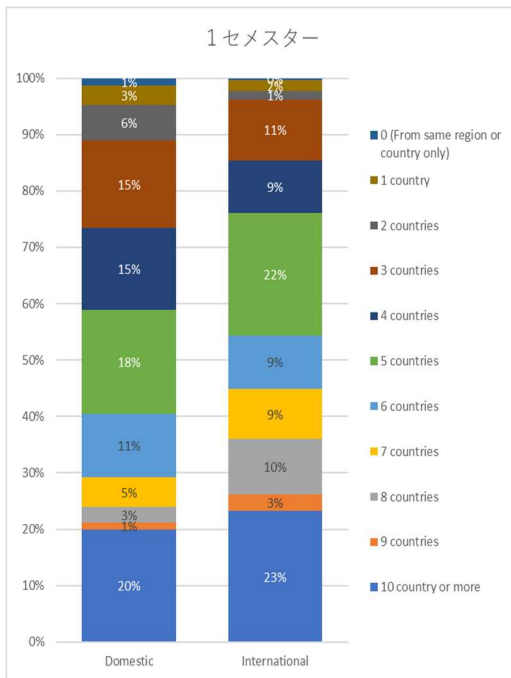


(7) Q11, What do you typically do for dinner on weekdays?

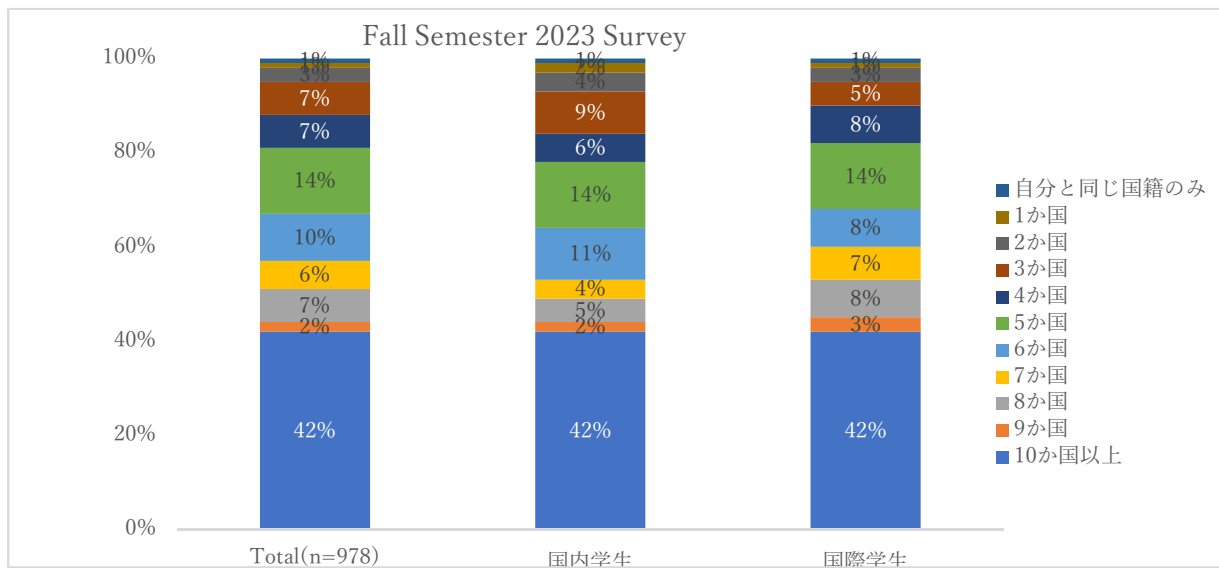


(8) Q12, How many different countries have you made friends from? (Excluding your own country)

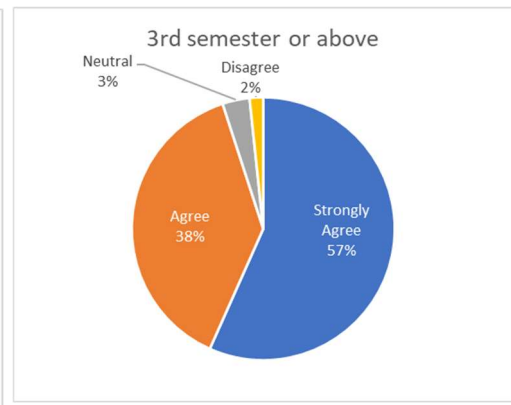
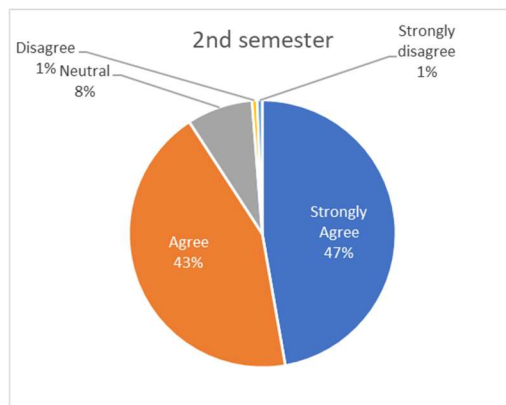
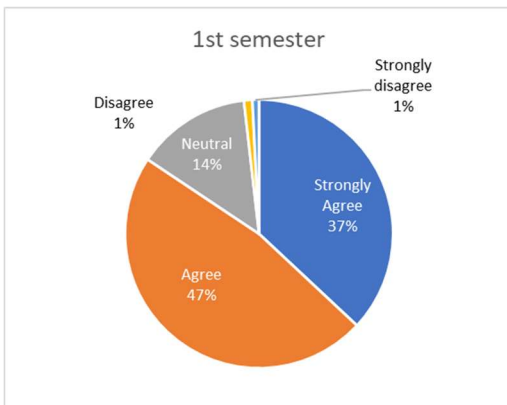
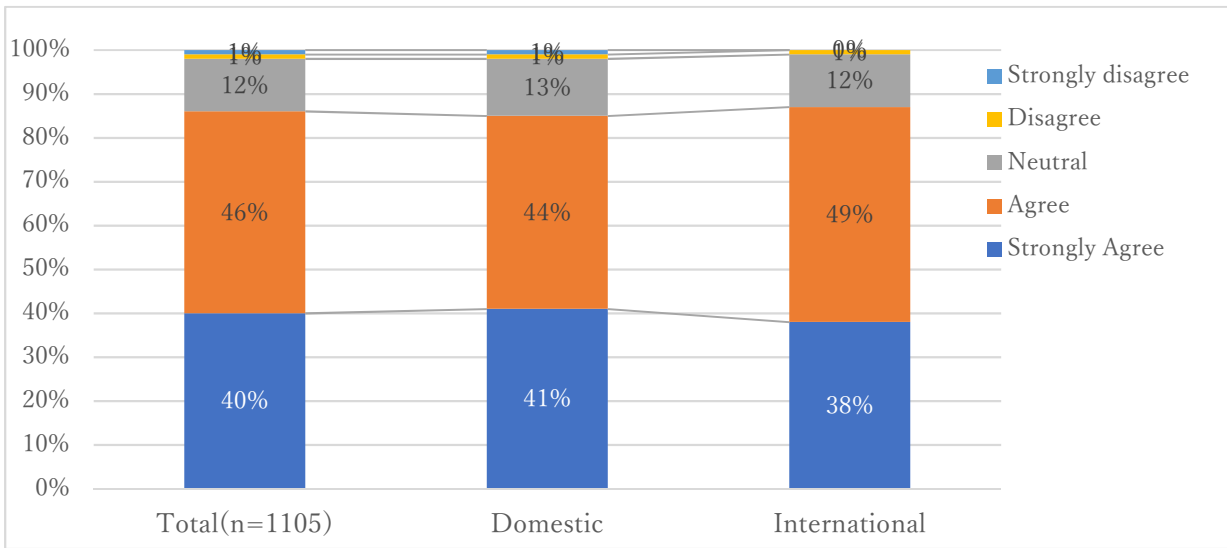




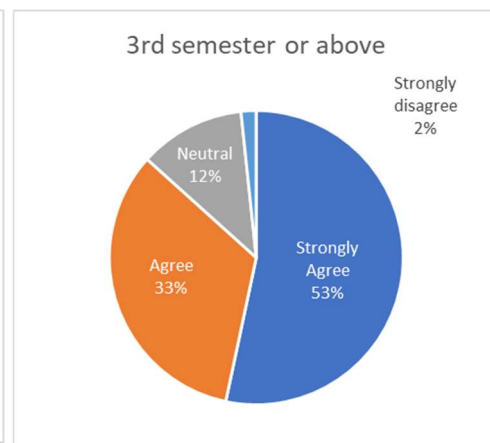
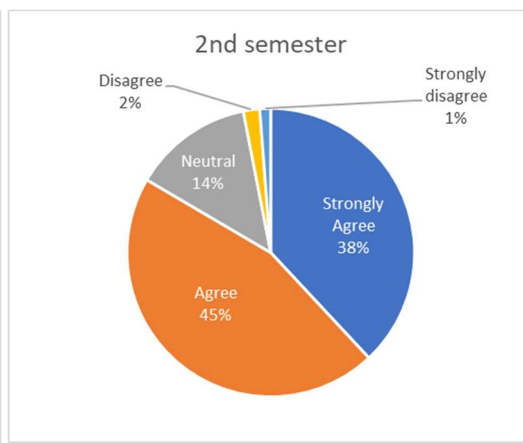
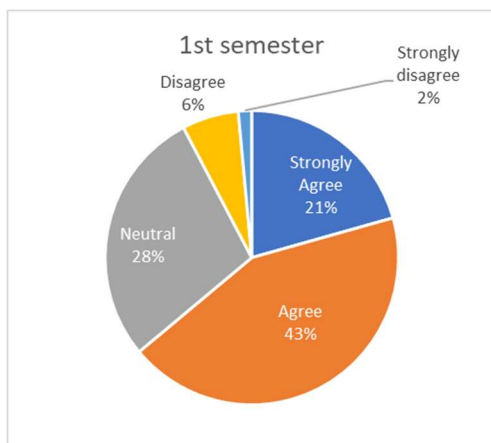
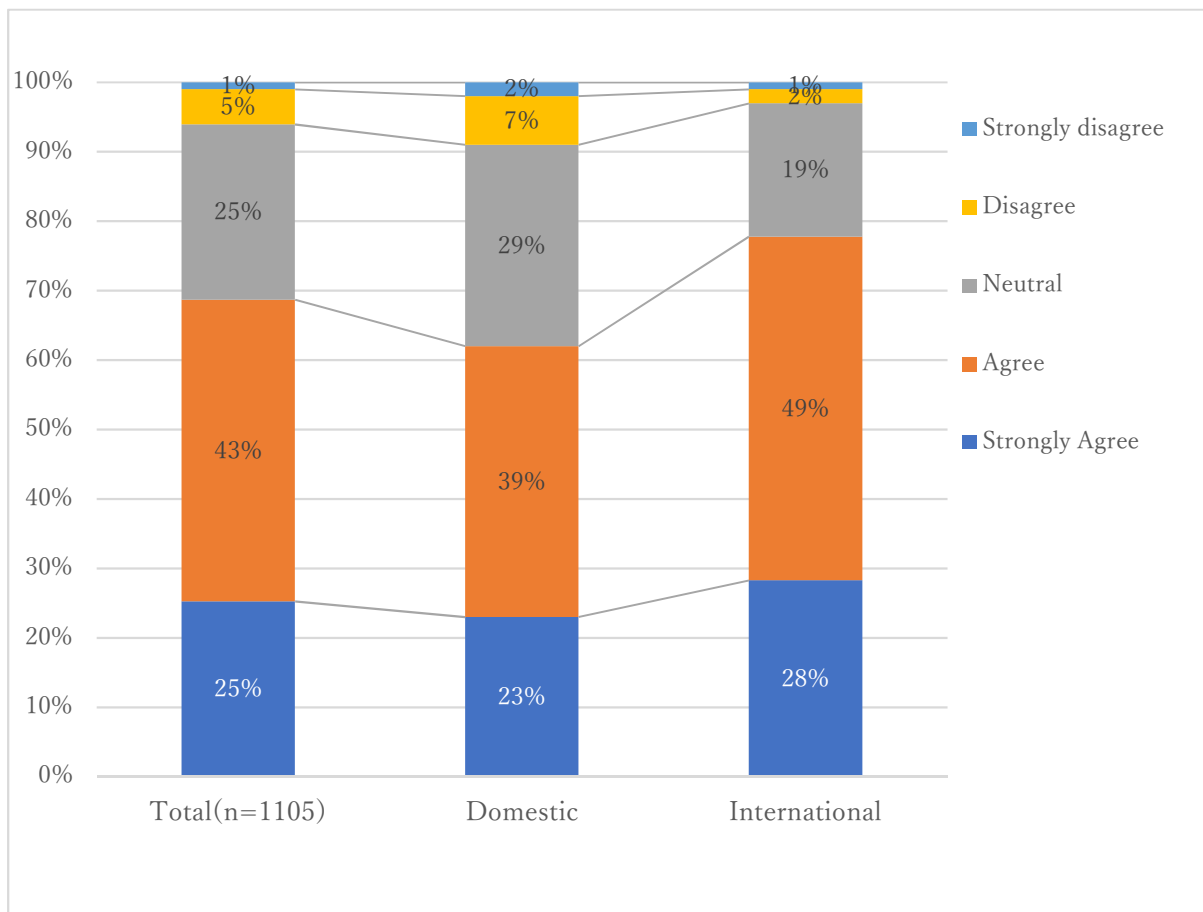

(9) Q13, Your understanding of many cultures and diversity has deepened.

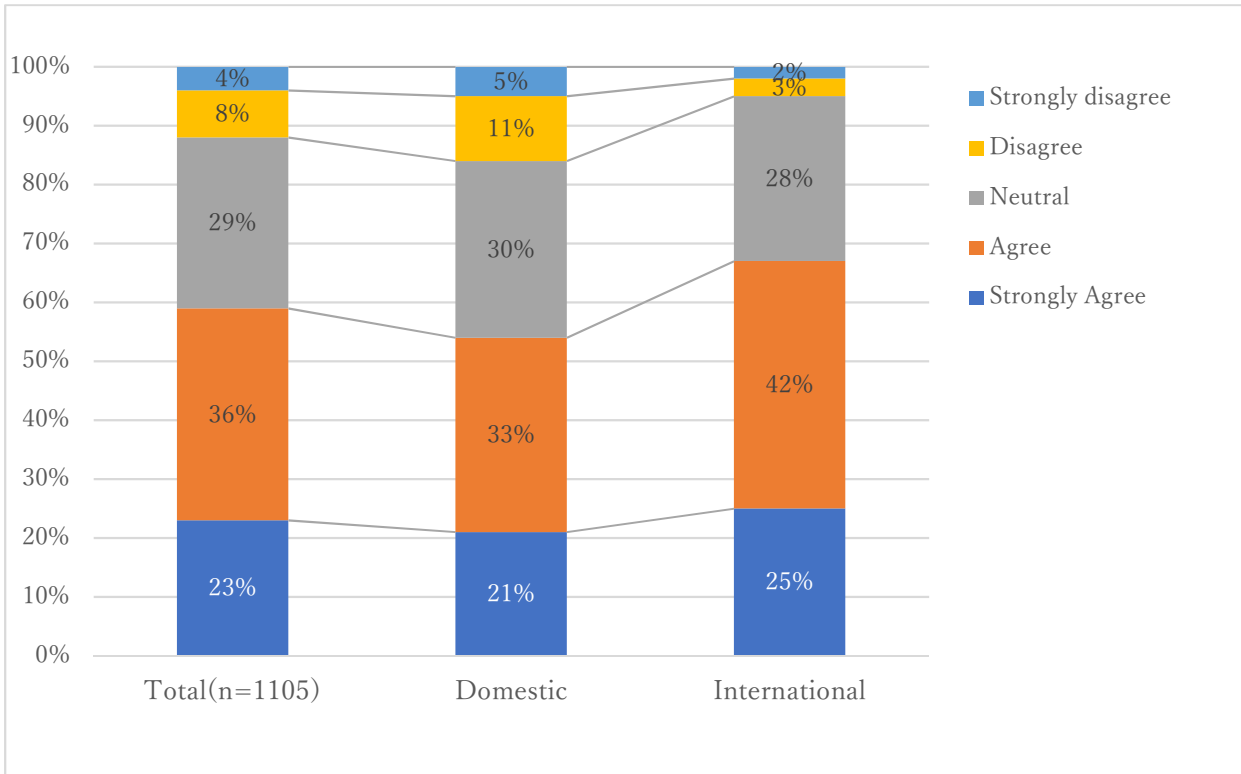


(10) Q14, I feel that living in AP House has improved my language proficiency.

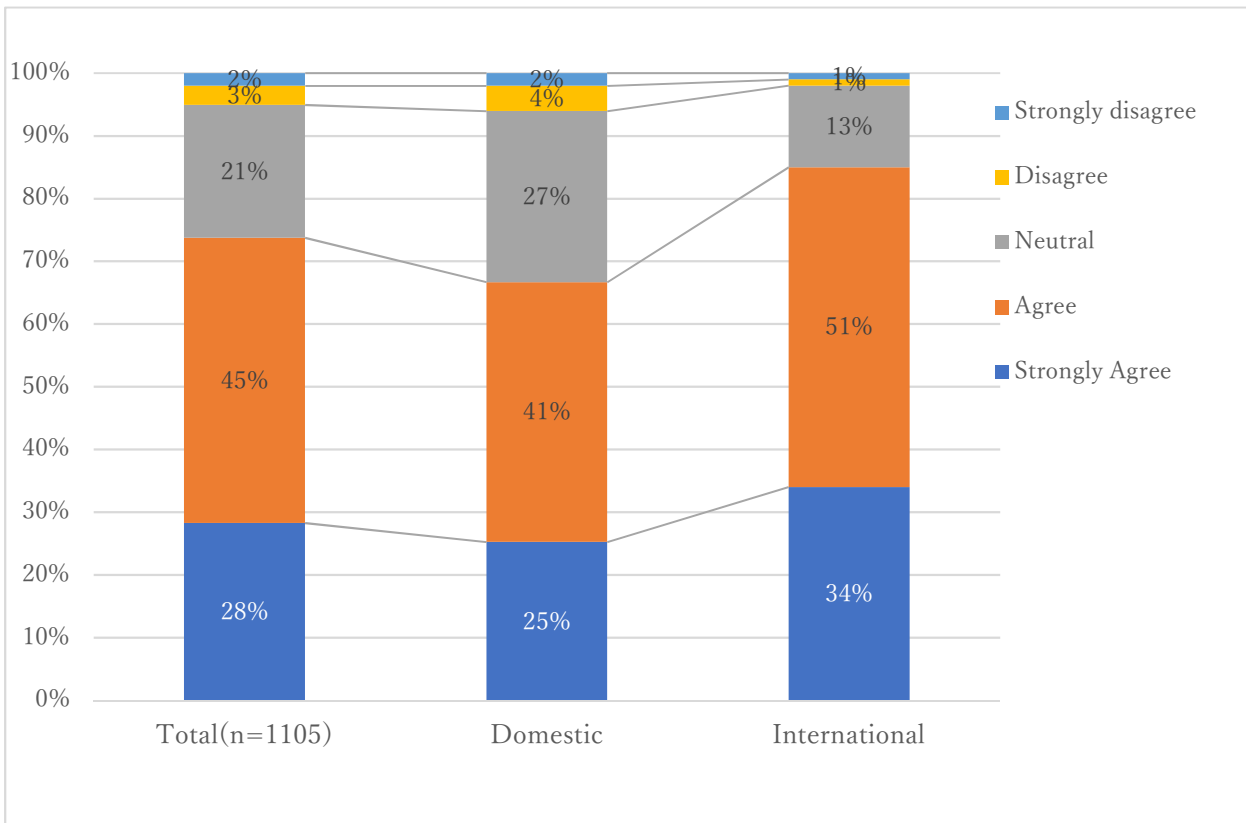




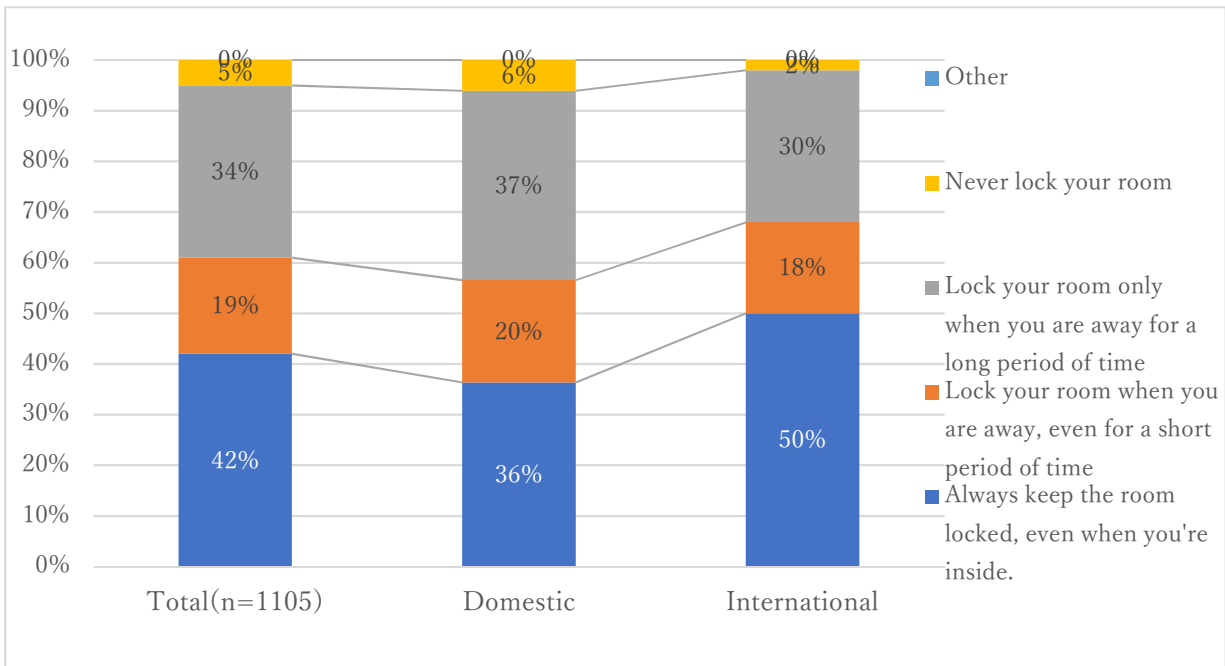

( 1 2 ) Q16, Living in AP House has helped you learn to sort your waste perfectly.

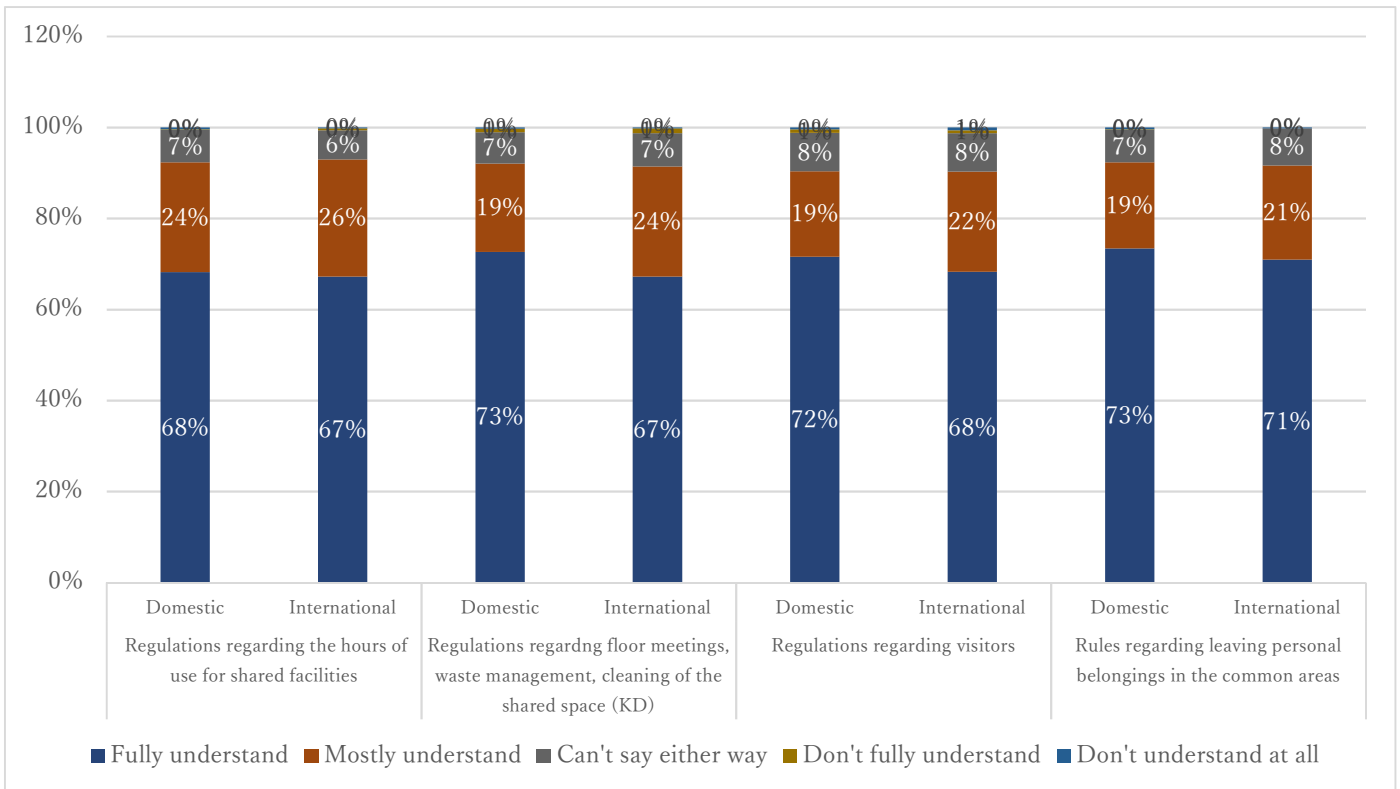


(1 3) Q17, Do you ensure that your room is locked when you are away?

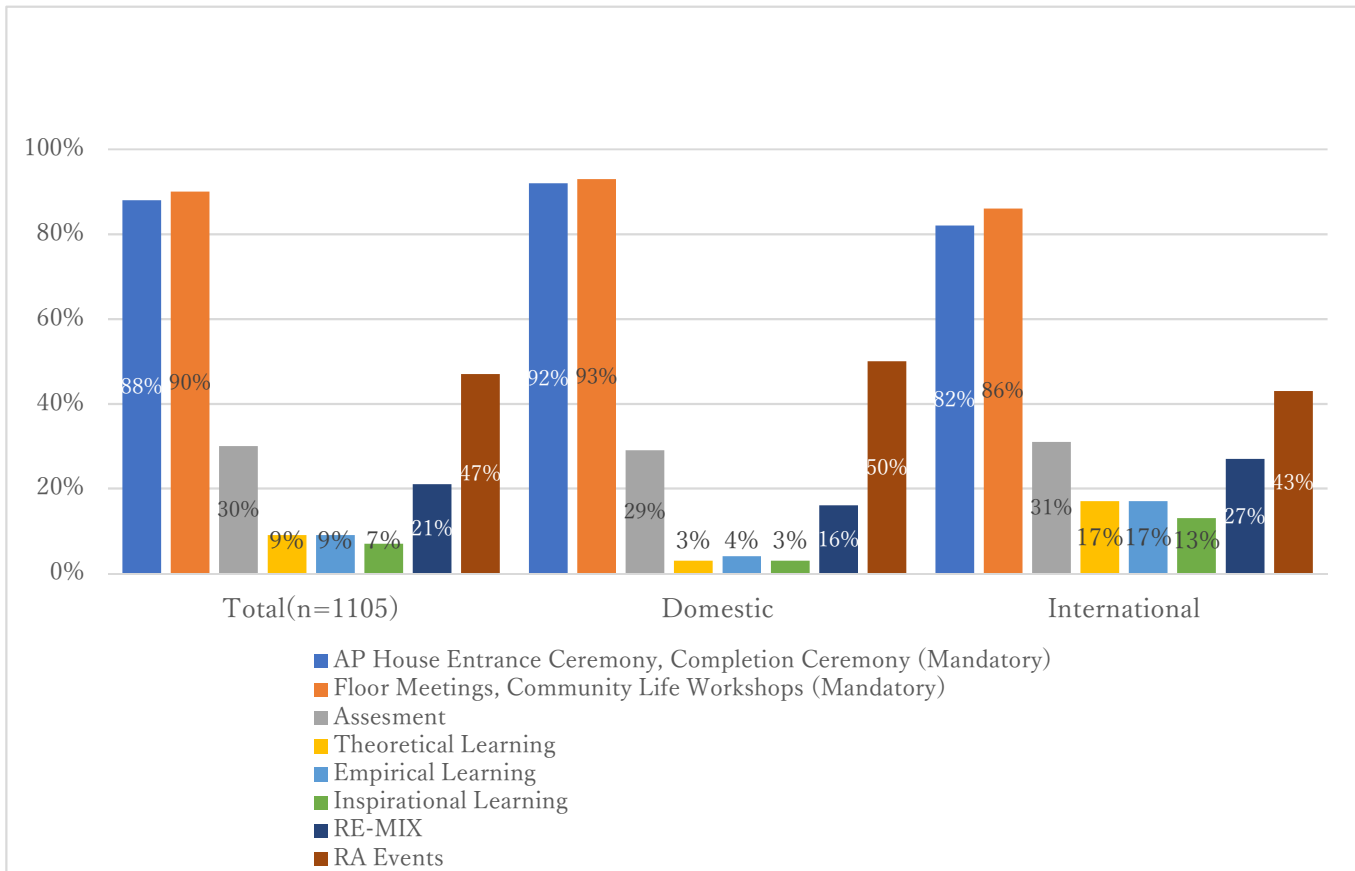


(1 4) Q18, AP House has established rules and regulations for the safety, health and hygiene of its residents. To what extent do you understand the following rules and regulations?

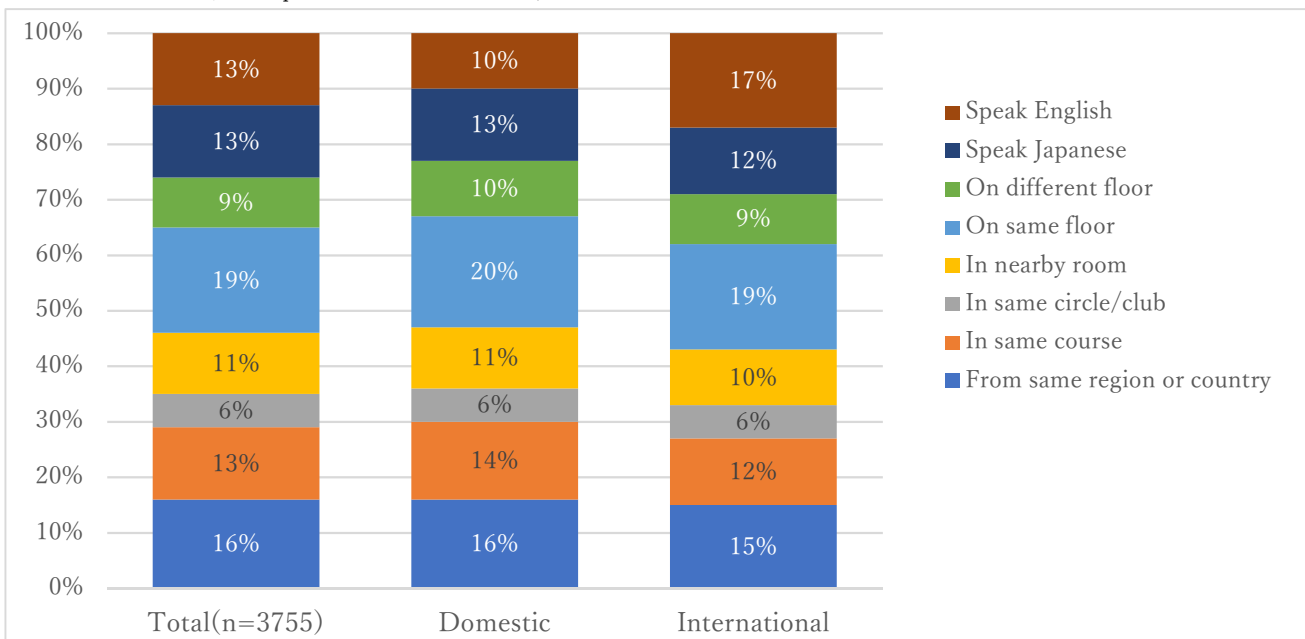

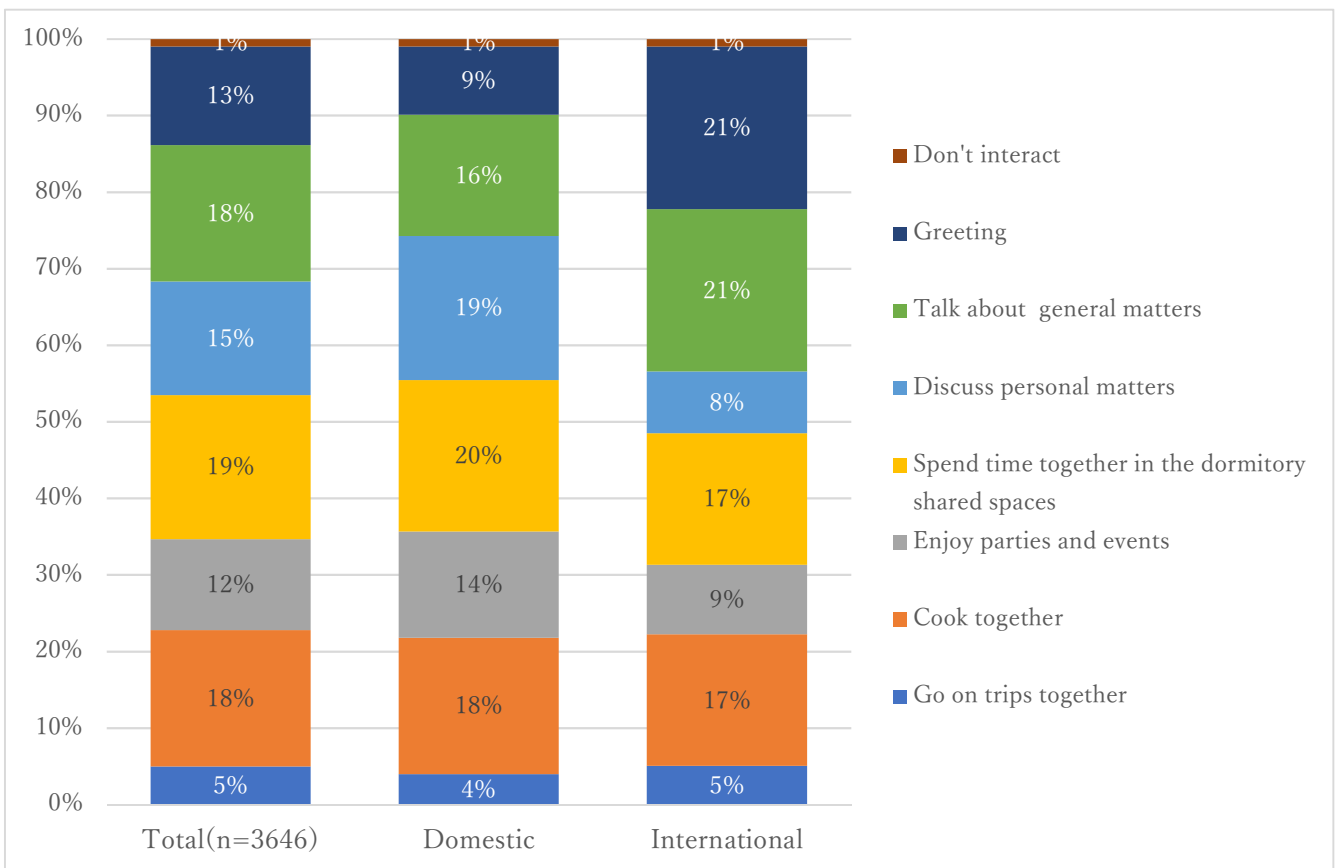

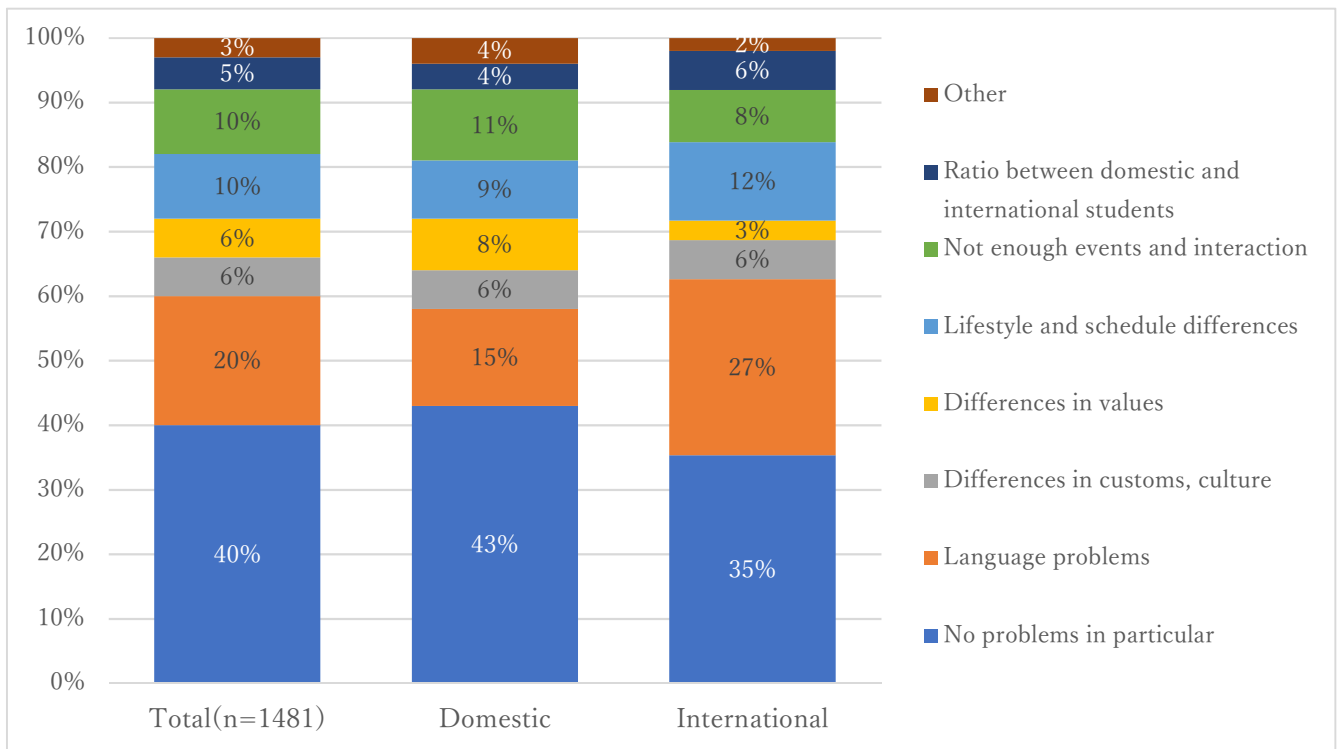
(16) Q20, What kind of residents do you interact with the most? (Multiple answers allowed)



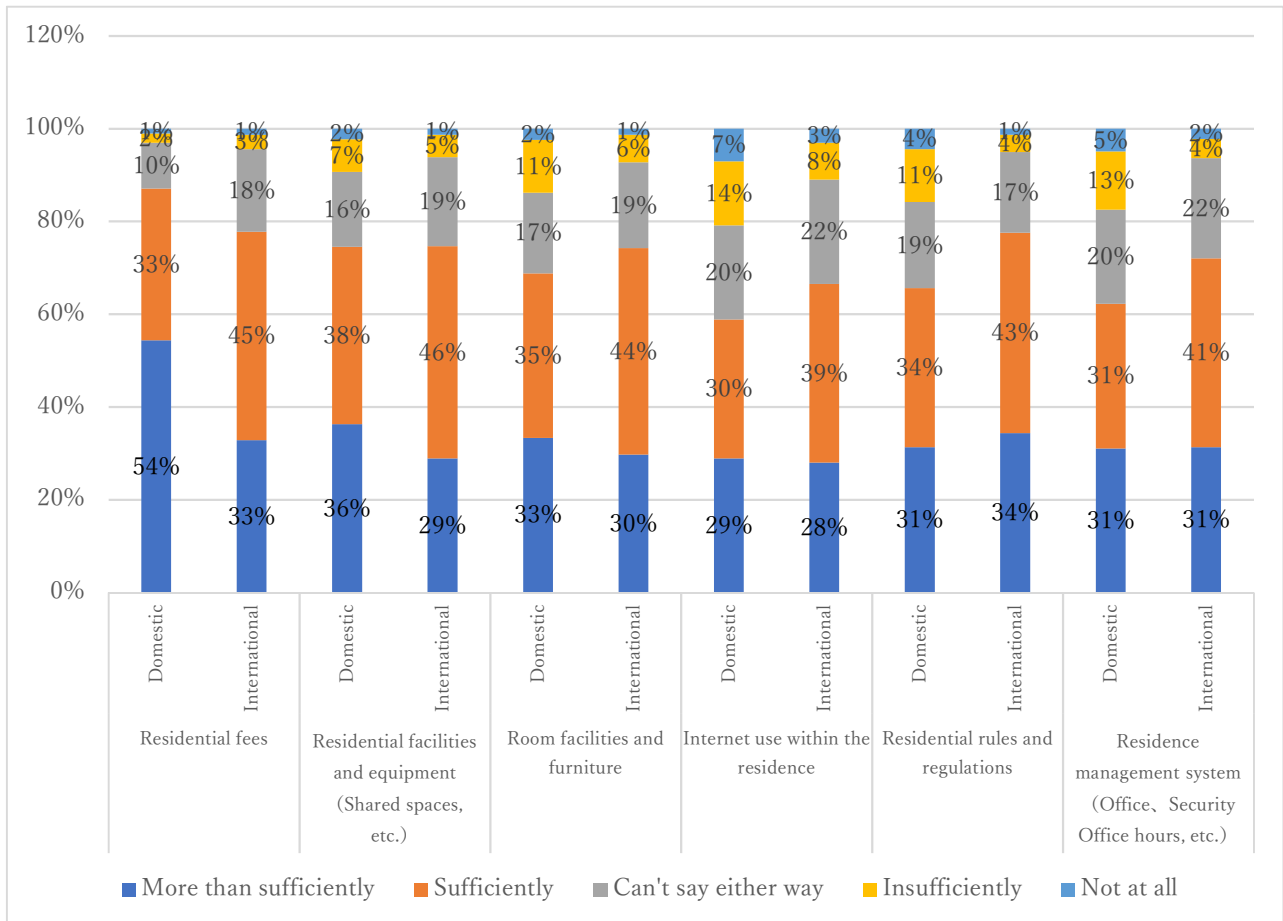

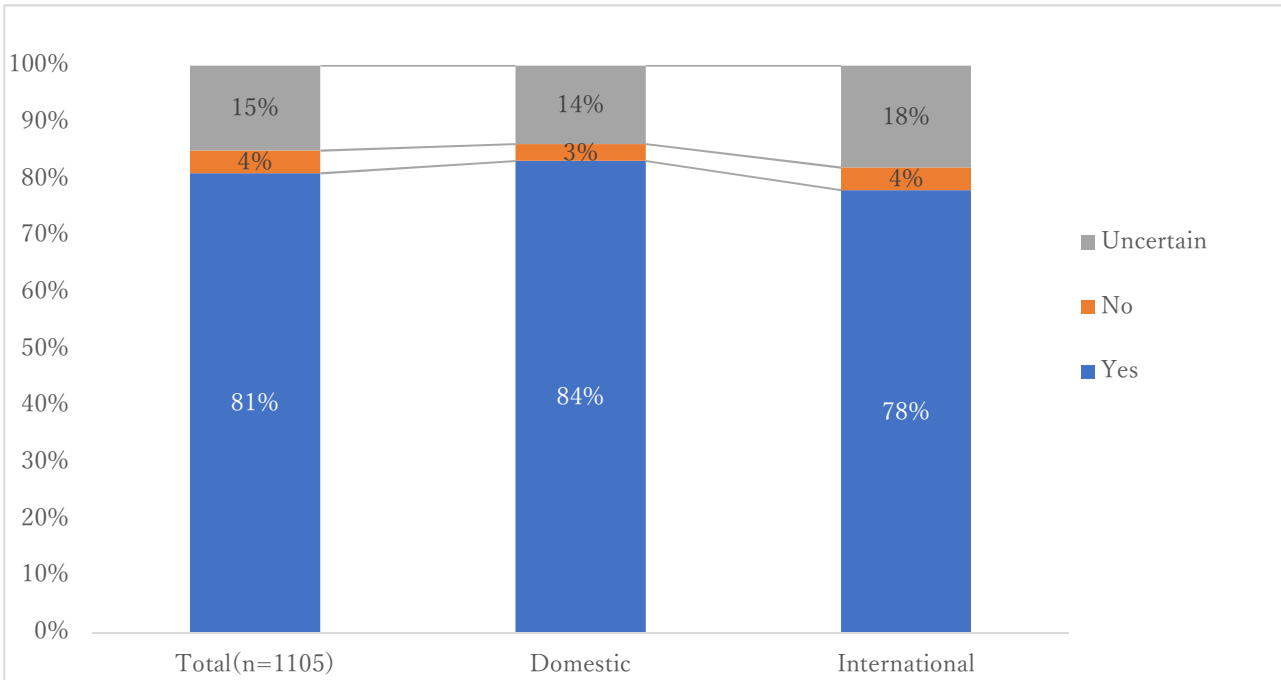

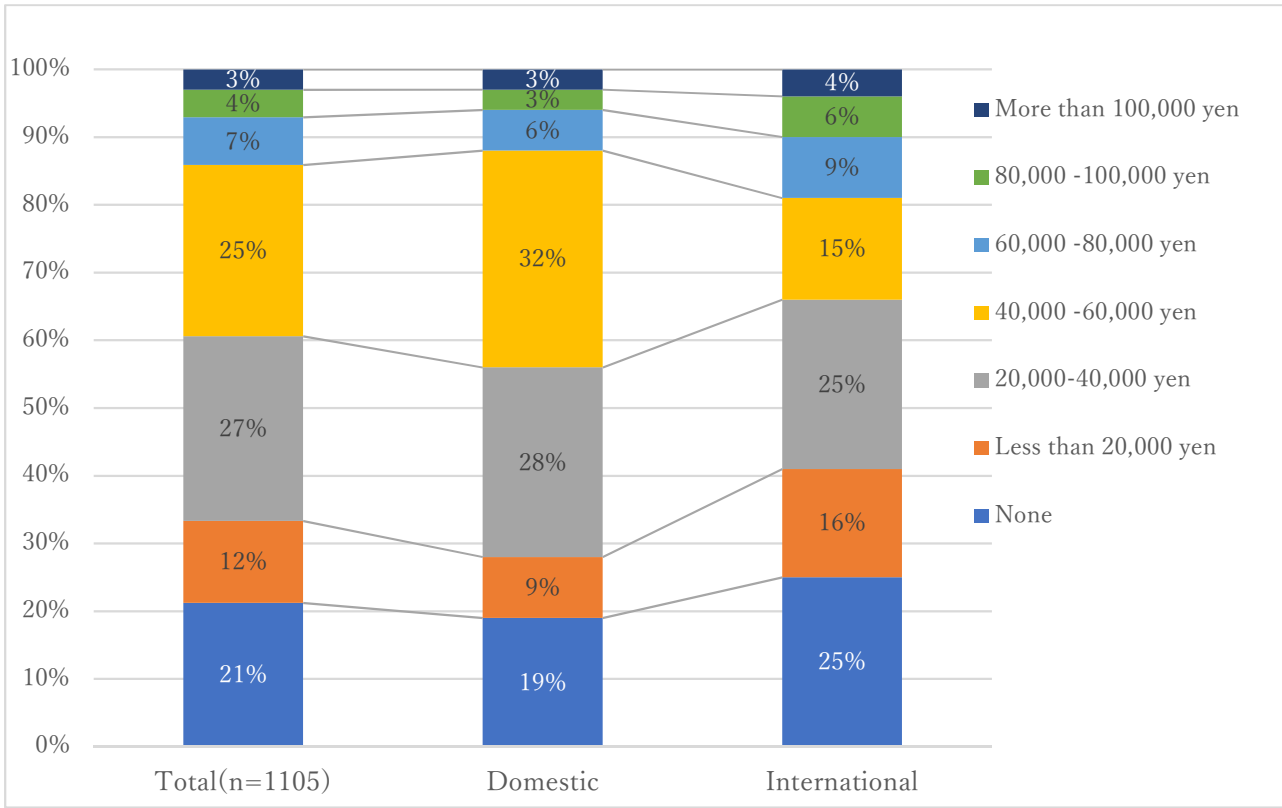

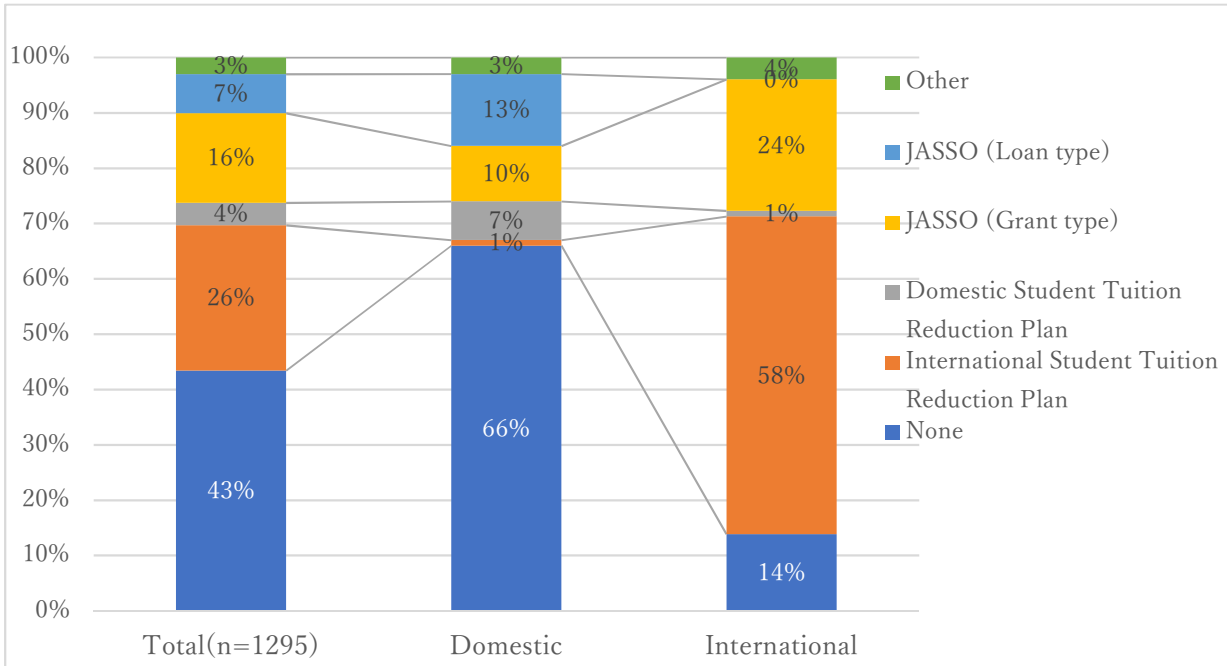
(2 1) Q26, What is the total annual income of your parent(s)?



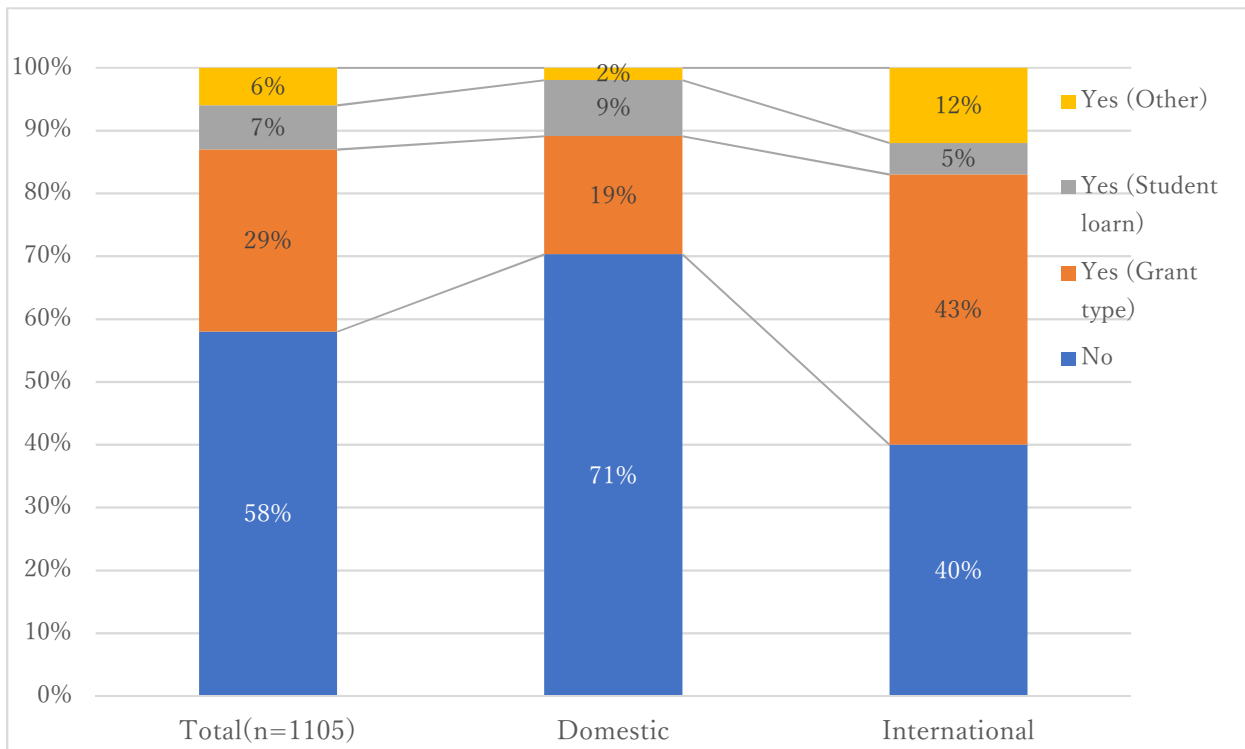

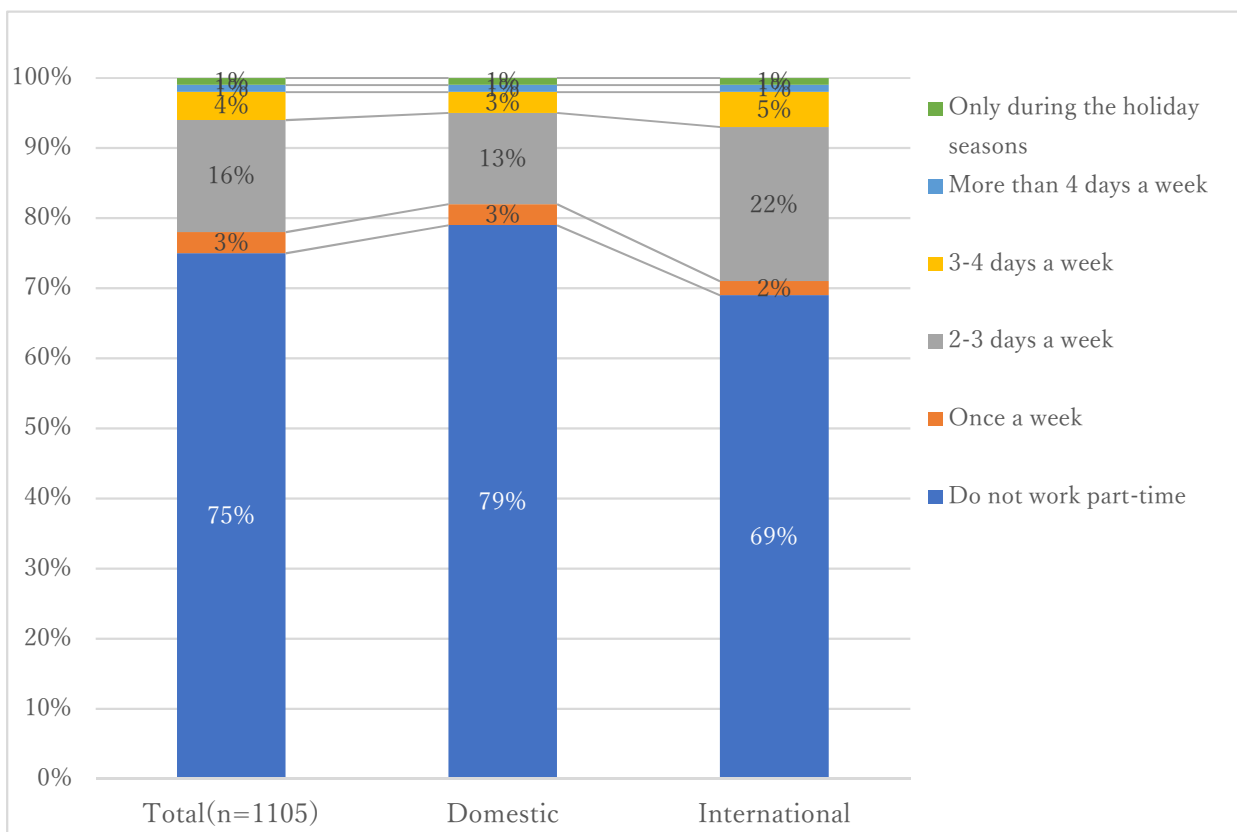

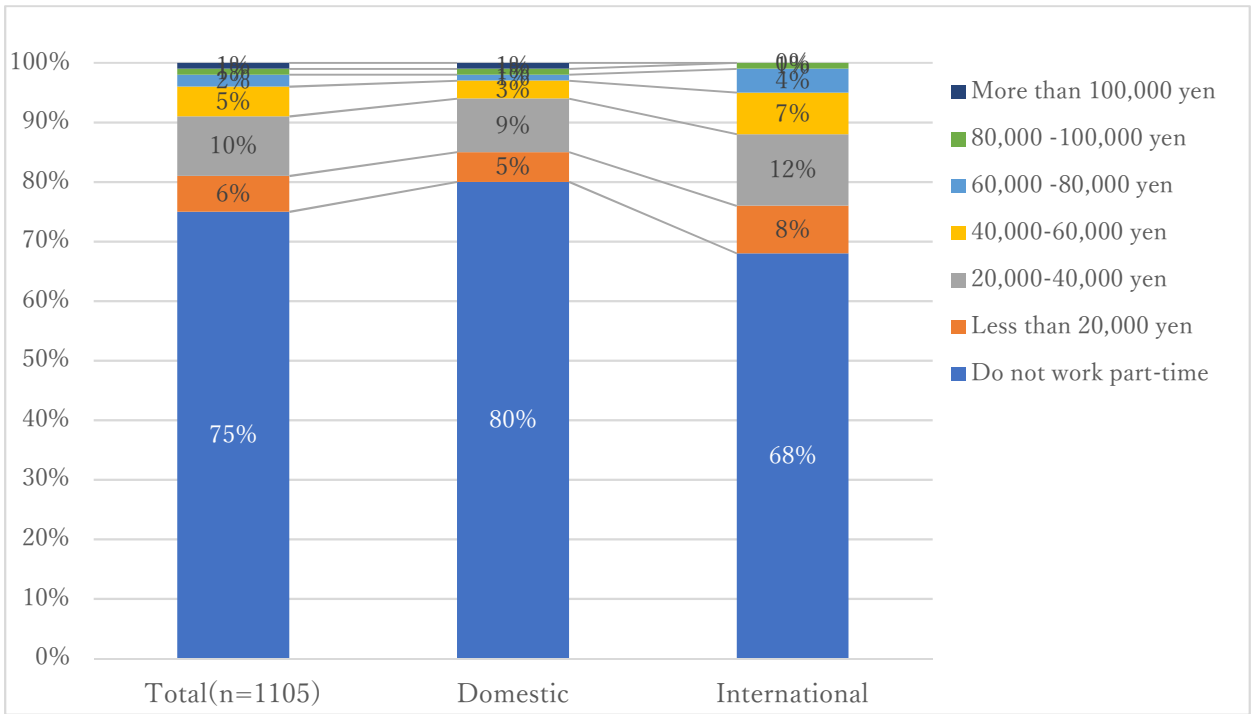


(2 5) Q30, How many days in a week do you usually work part-time?
