

Results of the 2026 Spring Semester AP House 1.2.5 Survey

AP House provides residential education centered on the "Living Learning Program," which fosters autonomous learning and personal growth among residents in a diverse dormitory environment.

This article reports the results of the dormitory student survey for the Spring Semester of 2026, focusing mainly on items that reveal the students' actual living conditions and comparing domestic and international students. (The dormitory survey is conducted once per semester.)

1. Overview of the Survey

(1) Objectives

- ① To understand the actual condition of students living in an educational dormitory where they can experience intercultural understanding, tolerance, and communication among different cultures through living together in a multinational and multicultural environment, thereby fostering their capability of thriving in a multicultural society
- ② To verify whether AP House fulfills its fundamental role as a foundation for international students to adapt to life in Japan, specifically those who enter the University on an English basis and do not possess Japanese language proficiency.
- ③ To inspect the achievements in floor management and community building conducted by Resident Assistants (RAs) at AP House.

(2) Target Participants

- Residents of AP House 1, 2, and 5 *Mainly first-year students, except for RAs.

(3) Implementation Period

- Thursday, May 7th, 2026, ~ Friday, May 15th, 2026.

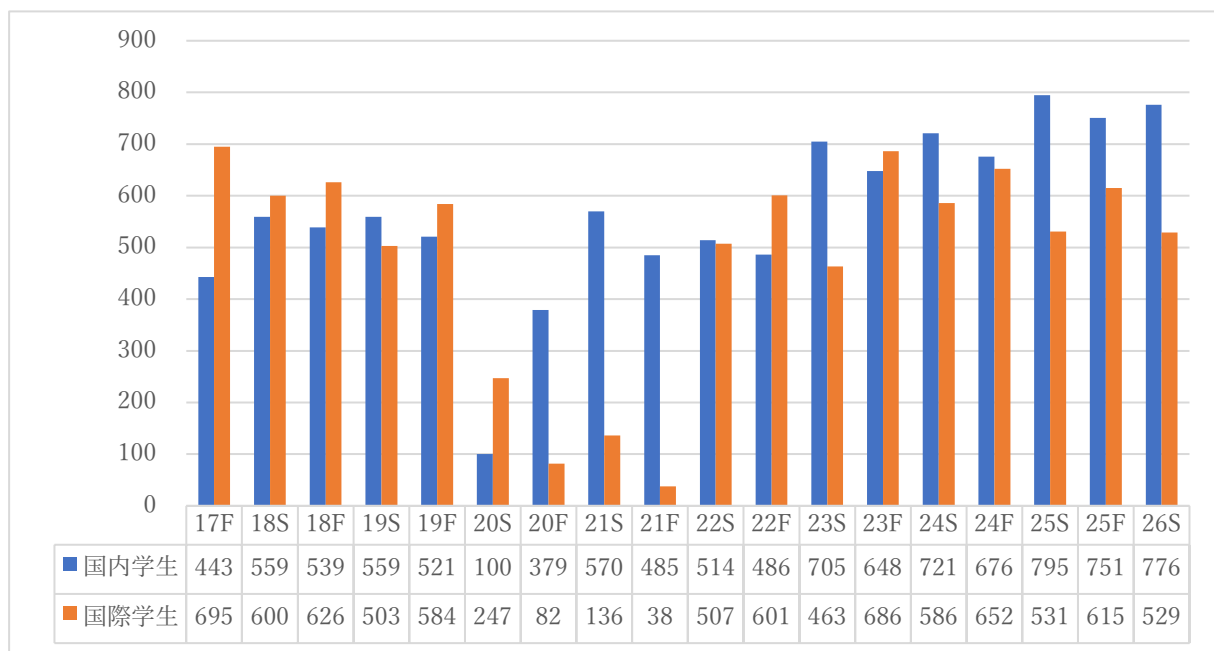

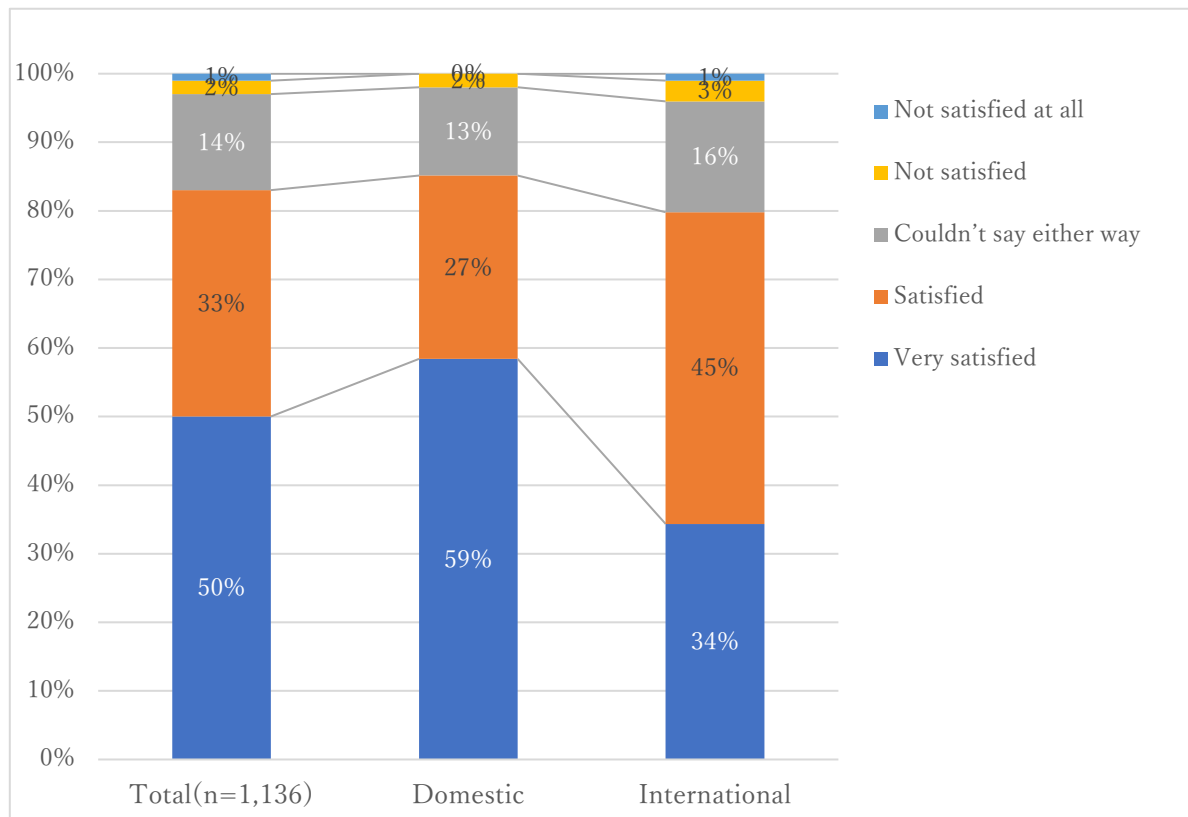

(6) Number of dormitory residents in past fiscal years

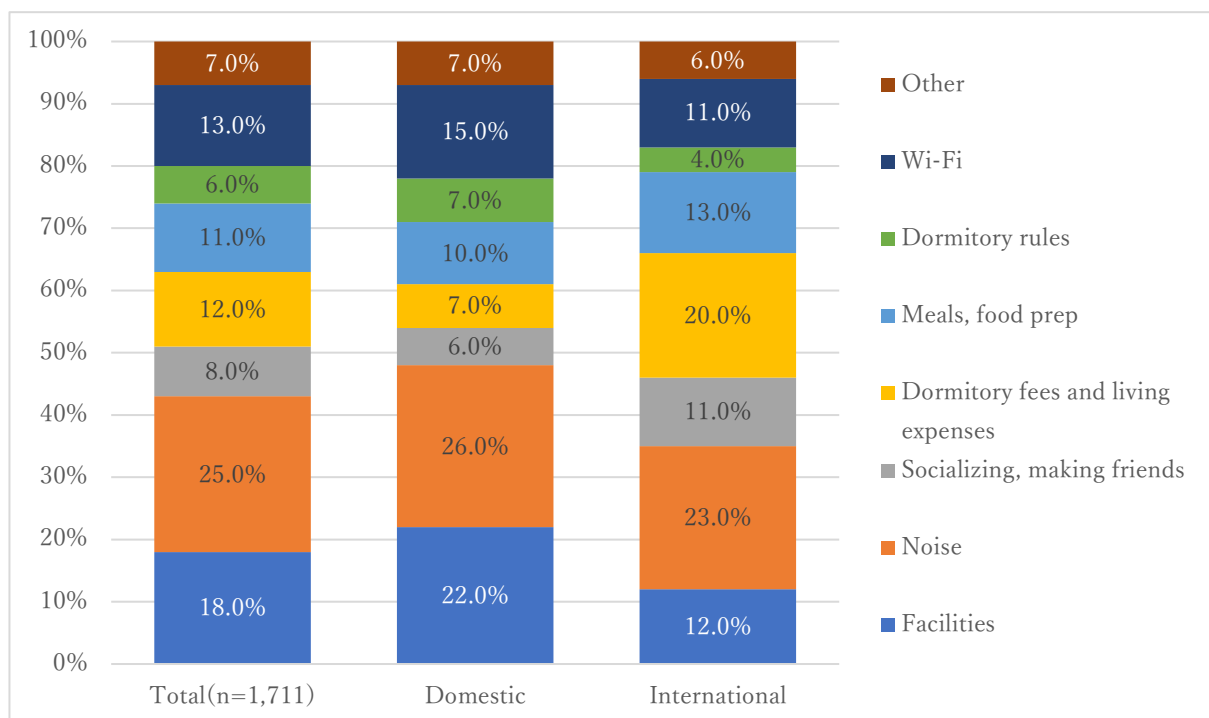

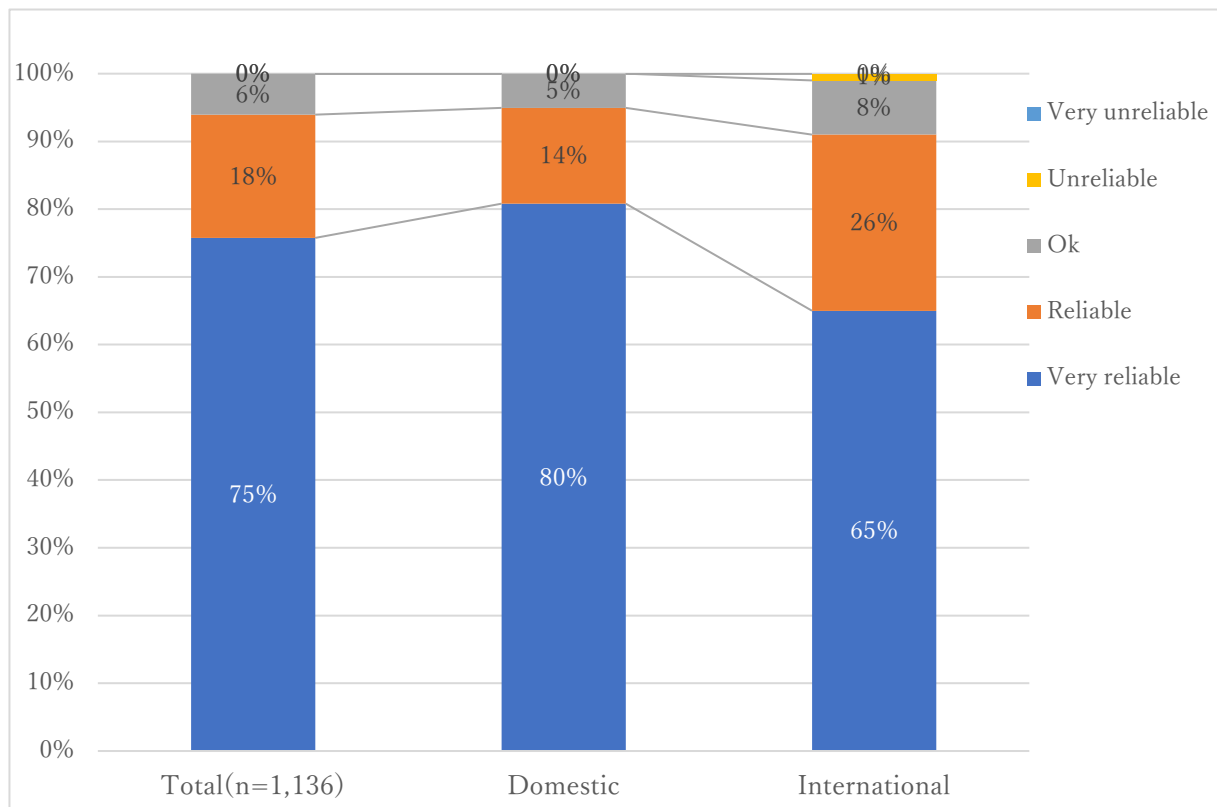
(1) Q5, How satisfied are you with your life in AP House?



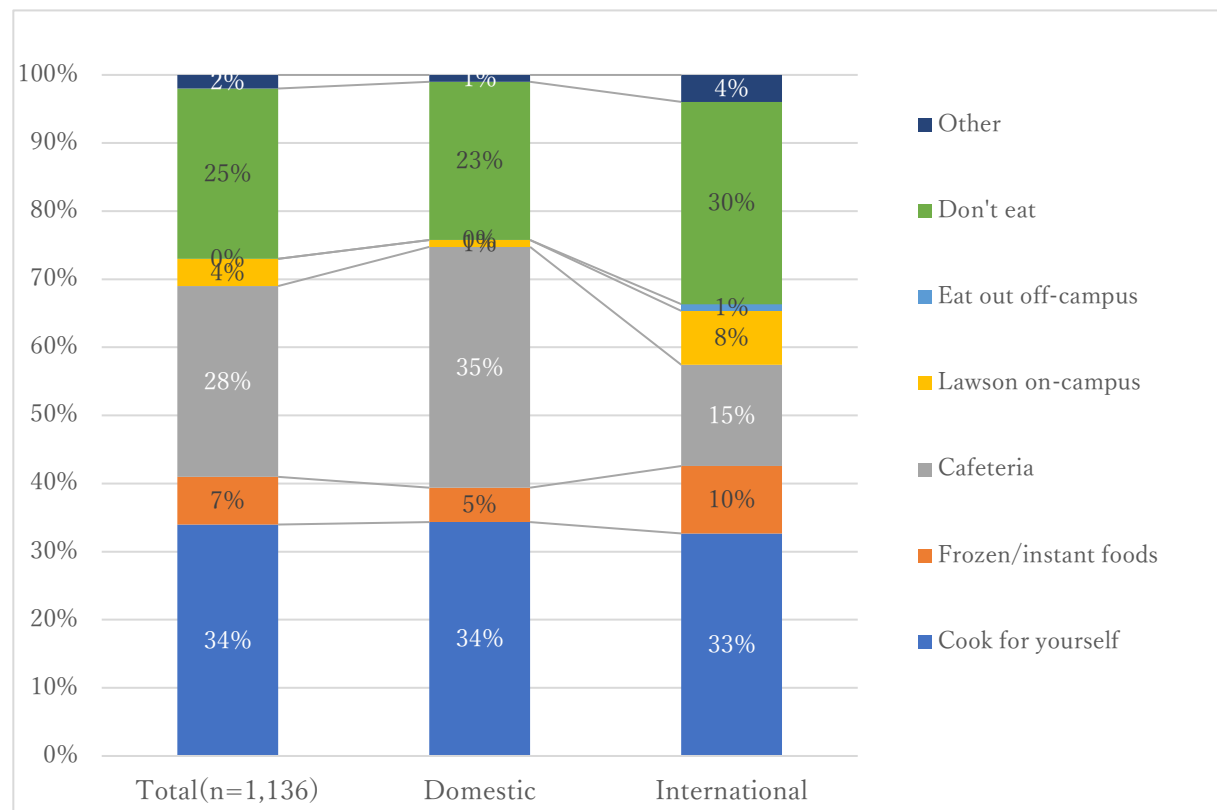
(2) Q7, What concerns do you have about your residential life? (Multiple answers allowed)



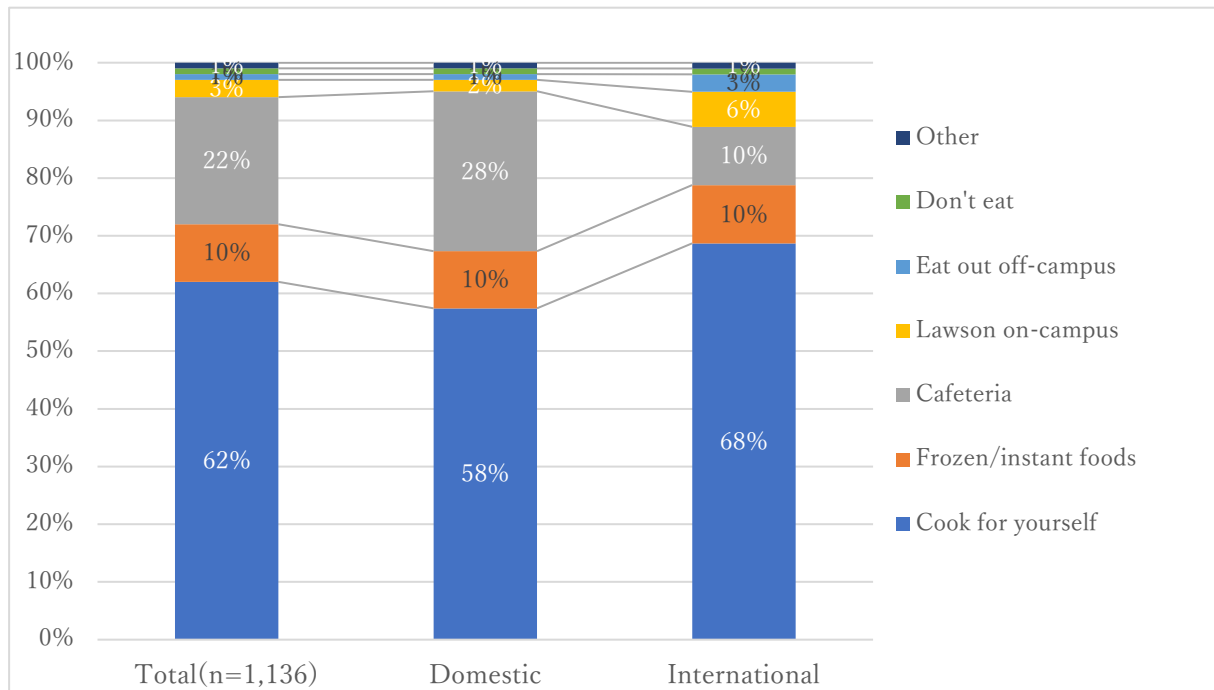
(3) Q8, How do you feel about RA(s) on your floor?



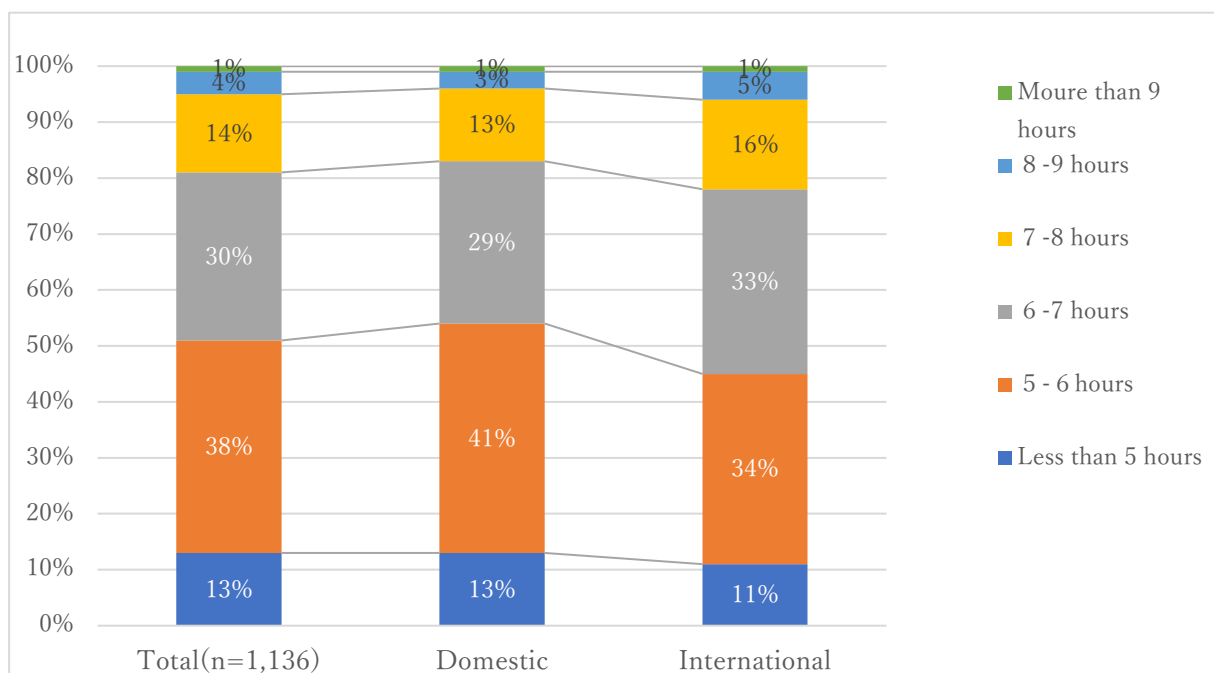
(4) Q10, What do you typically do for breakfast on weekdays?



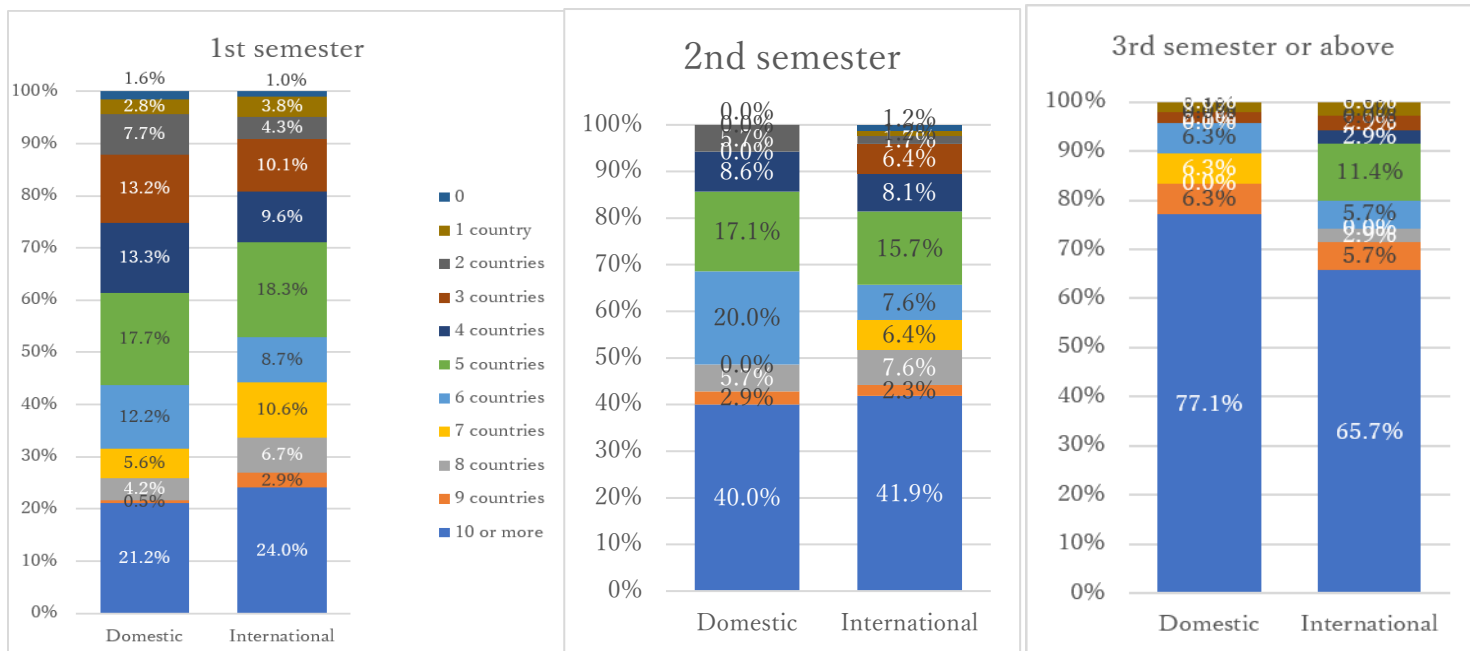
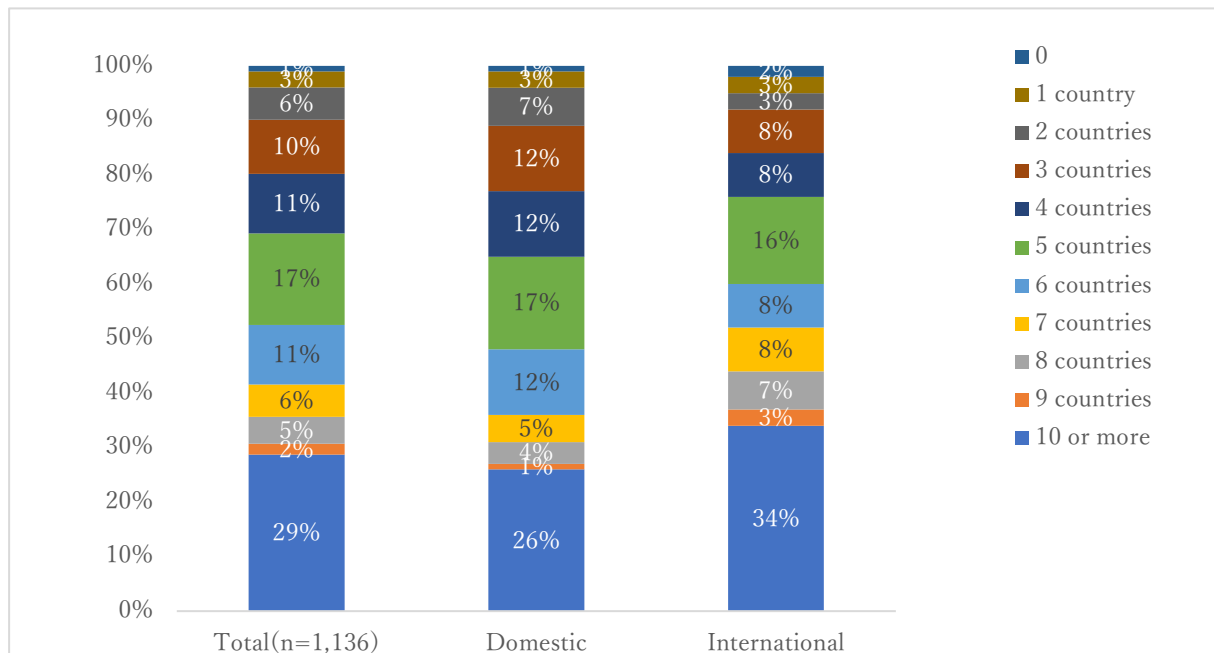
(5) Q11, What do you typically do for dinner on weekdays?



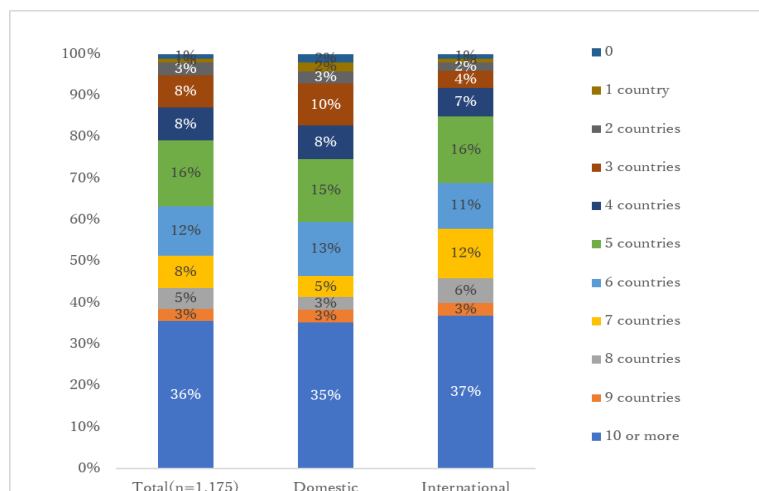
(6) Q12, Please select the average amount of hours of sleep you get on weekdays.



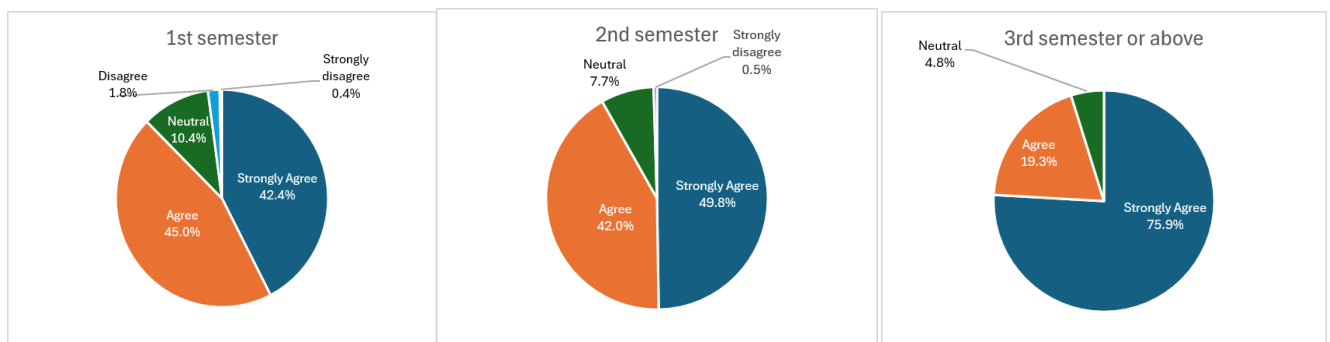
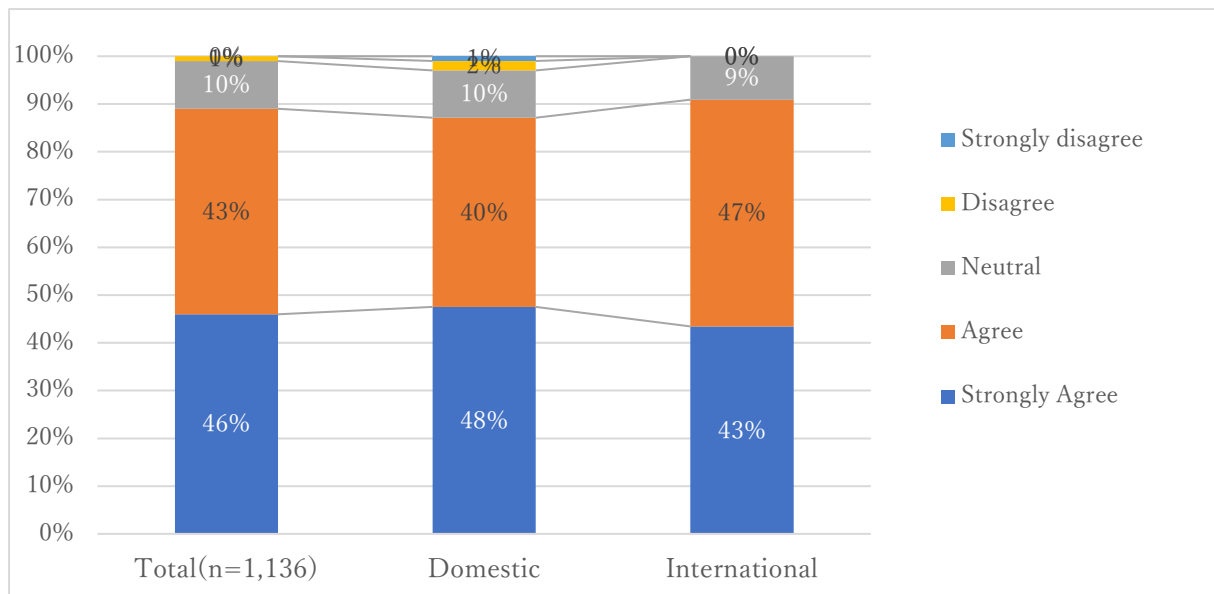

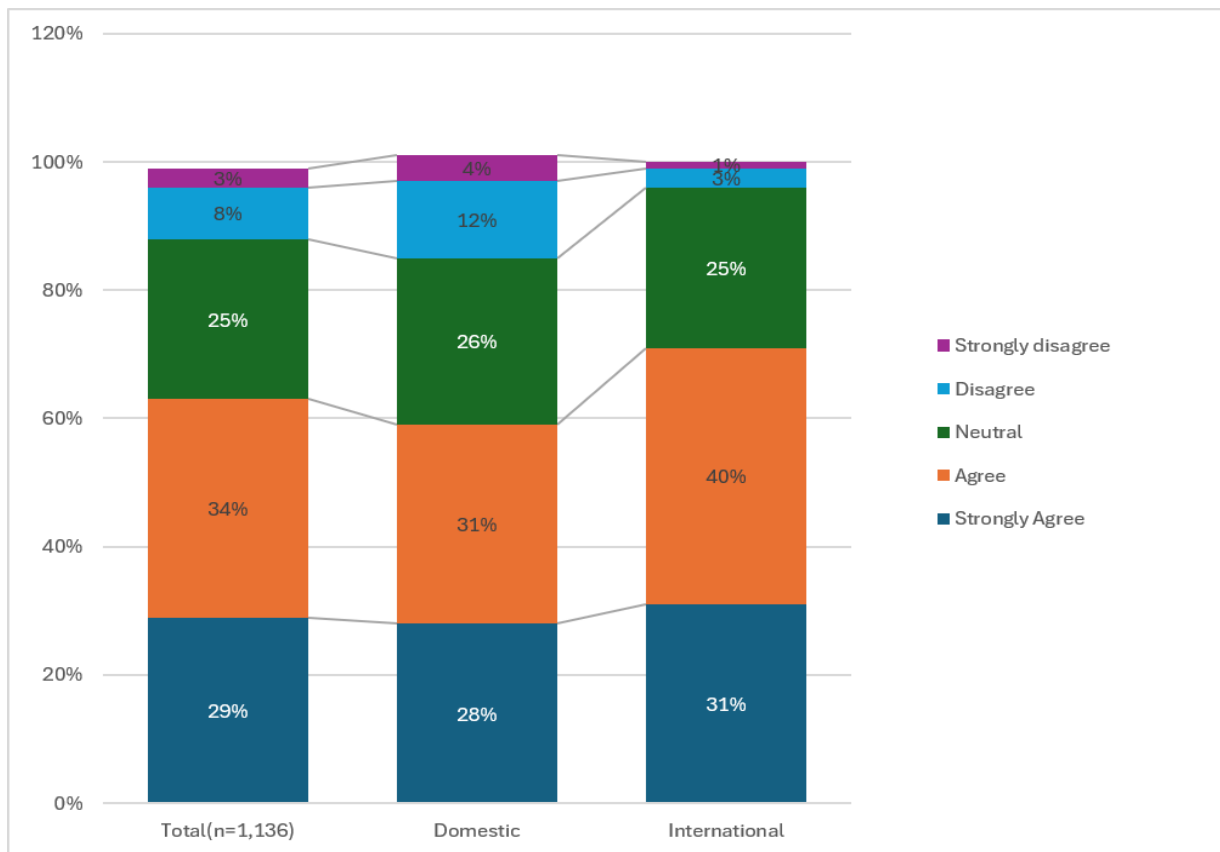

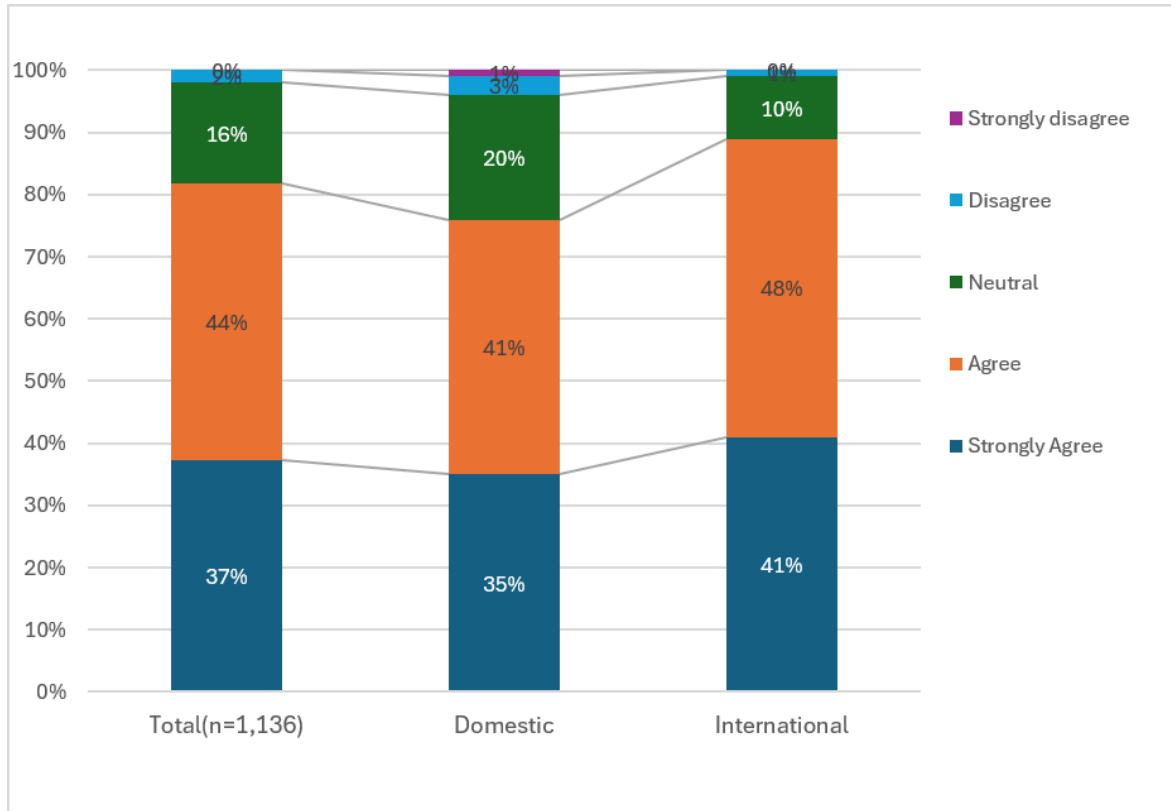

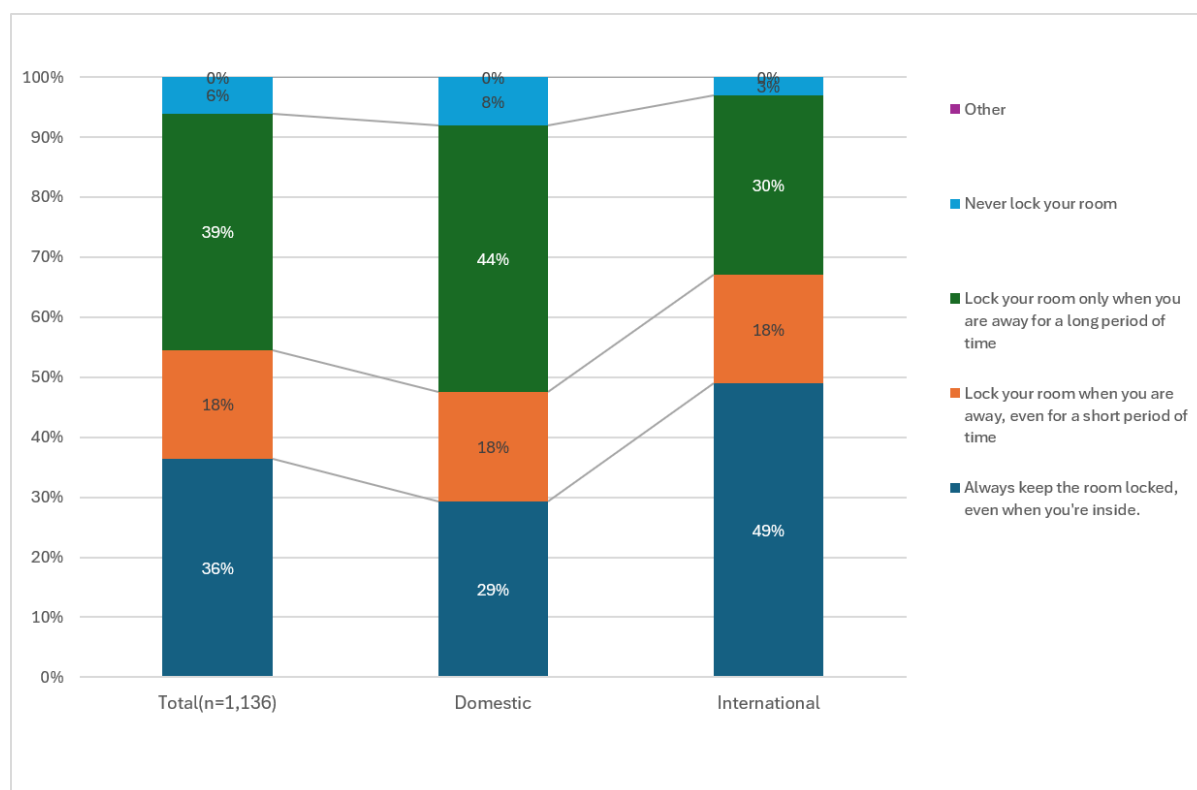

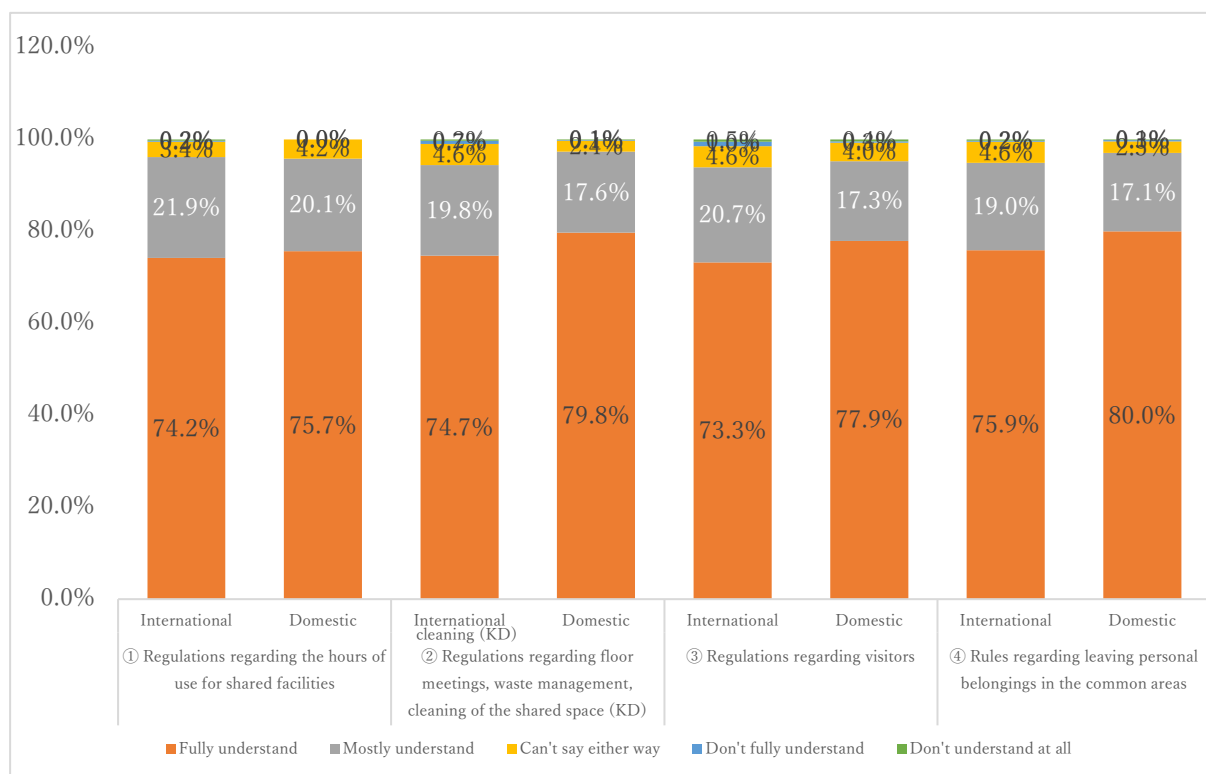

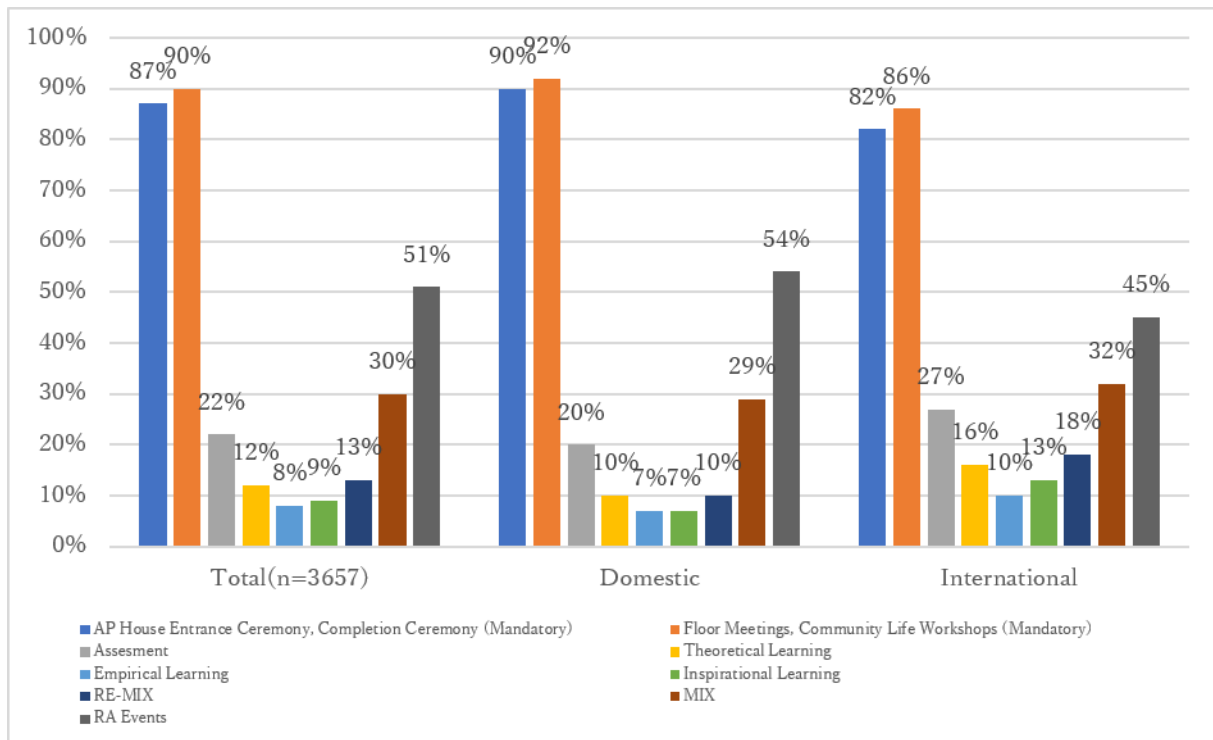
(1 2) Q18, Do you ensure that your room is locked when you are away?



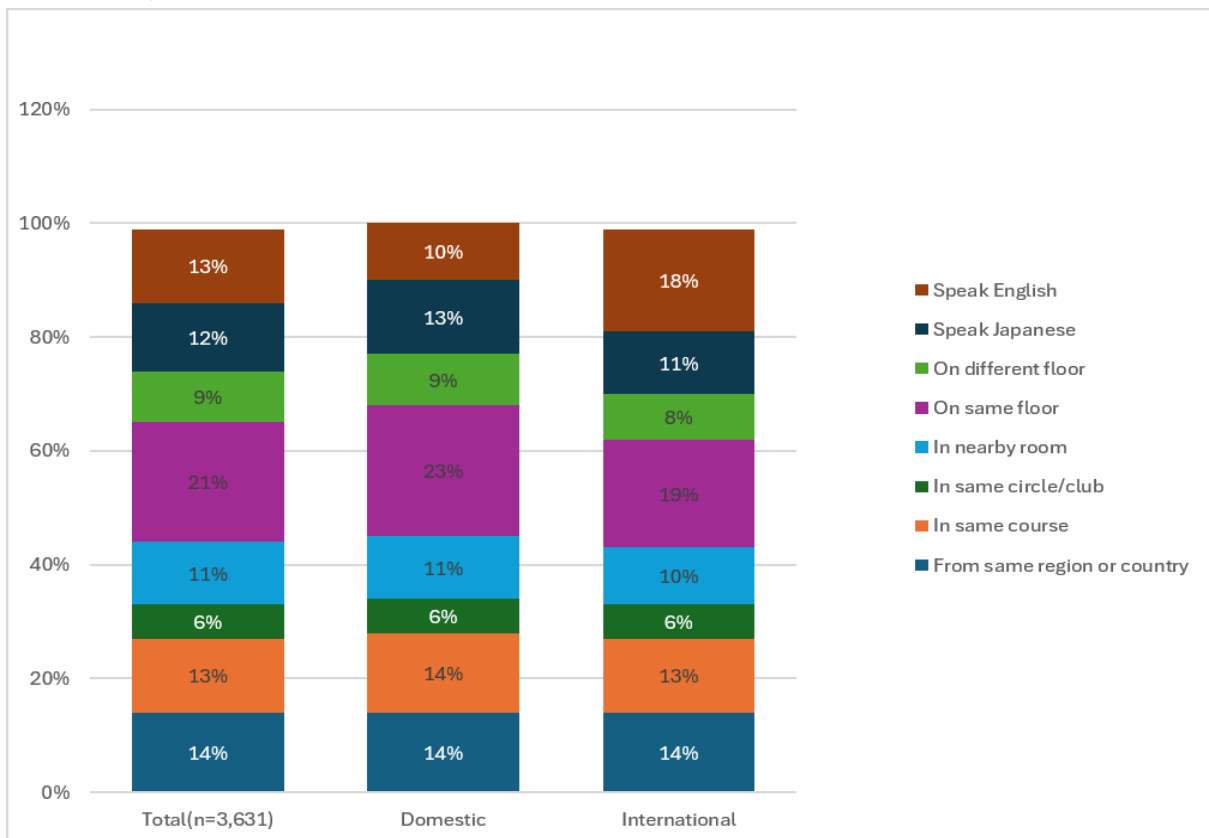
(1 3) Q19, AP House has established rules and regulations for the safety, health and hygiene of its residents. To what extent do you understand the following rules and regulations?



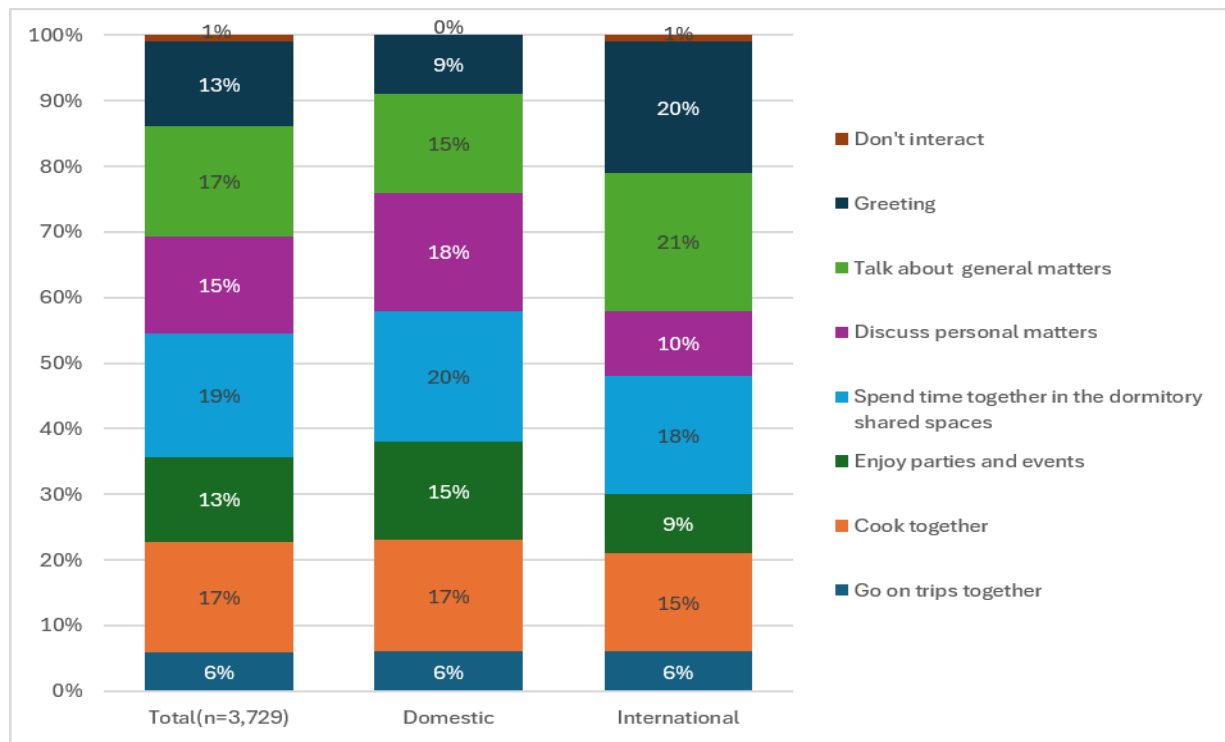

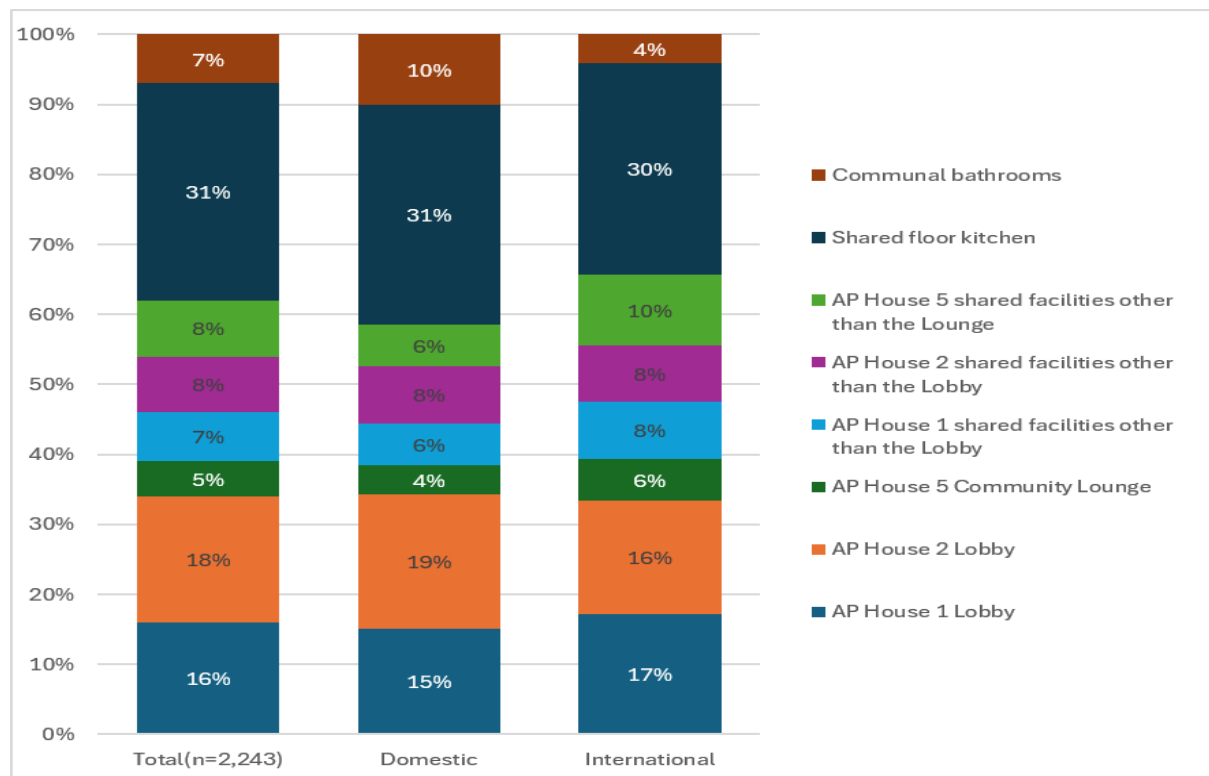
(1 5) Q21, What kind of residents do you interact with the most?



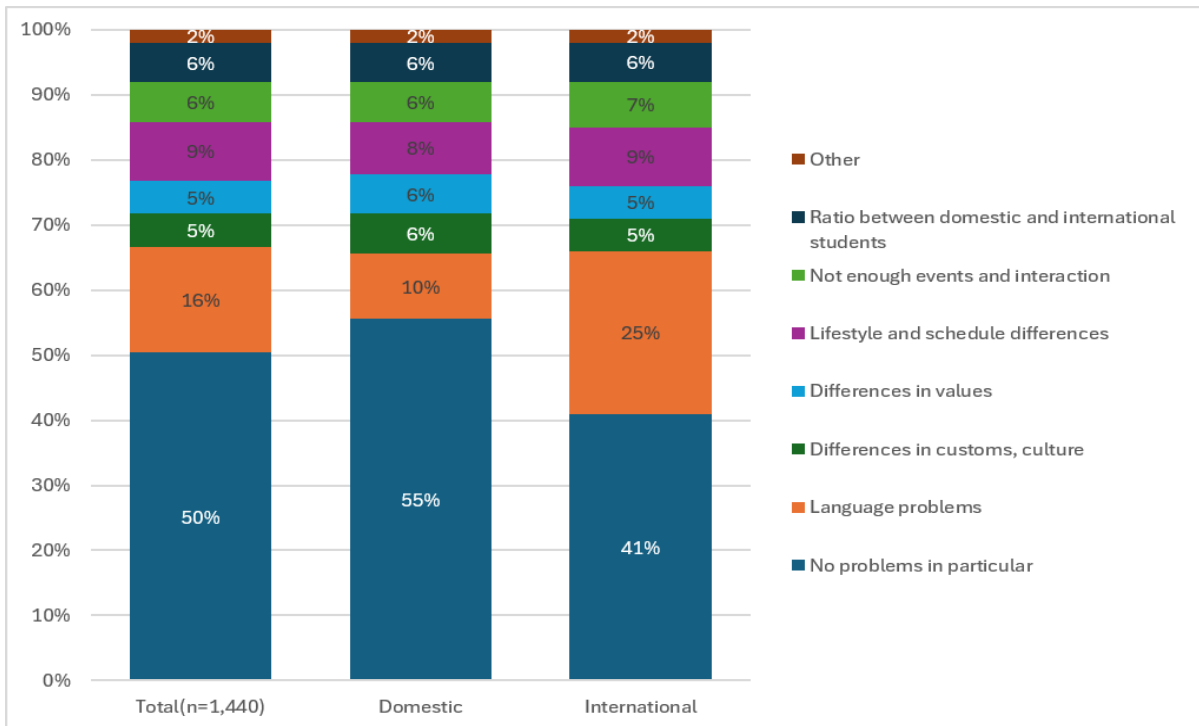

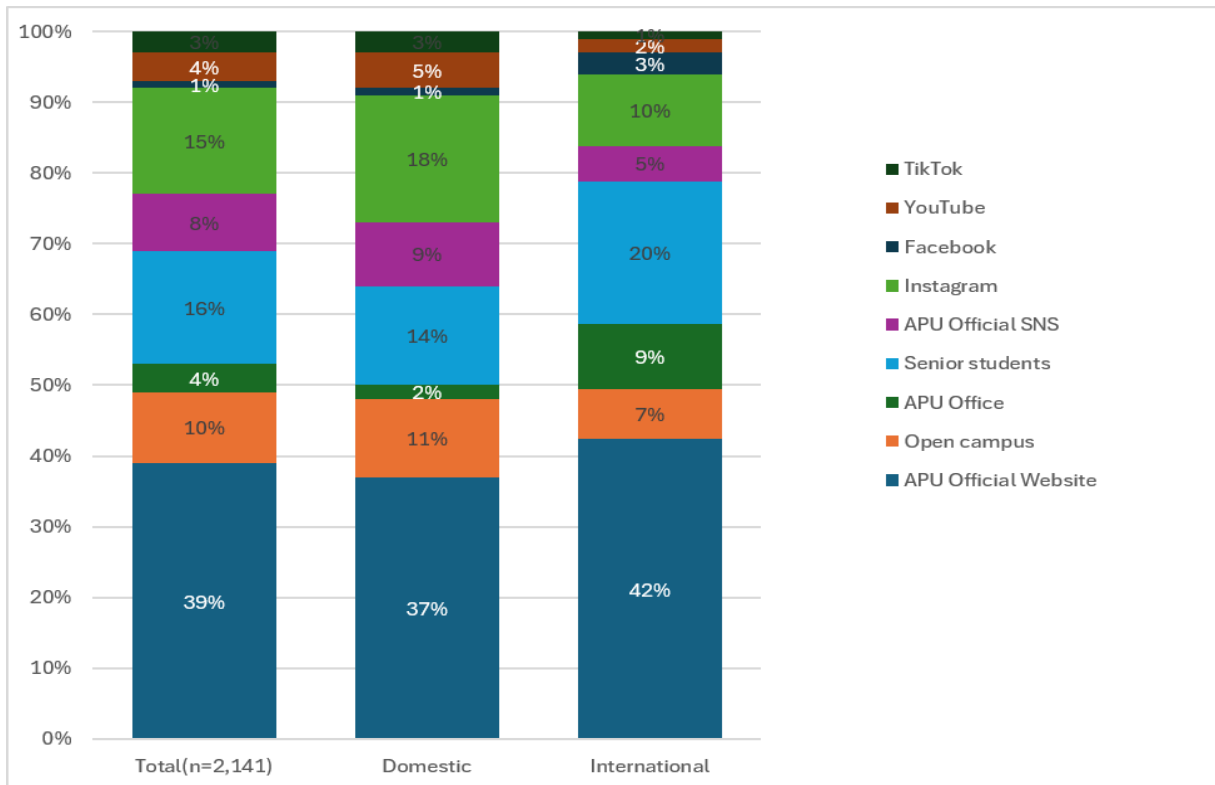
(1 7) Q23, Where do you mainly interact with other residents in the dormitory? (Multiple answers allowed)



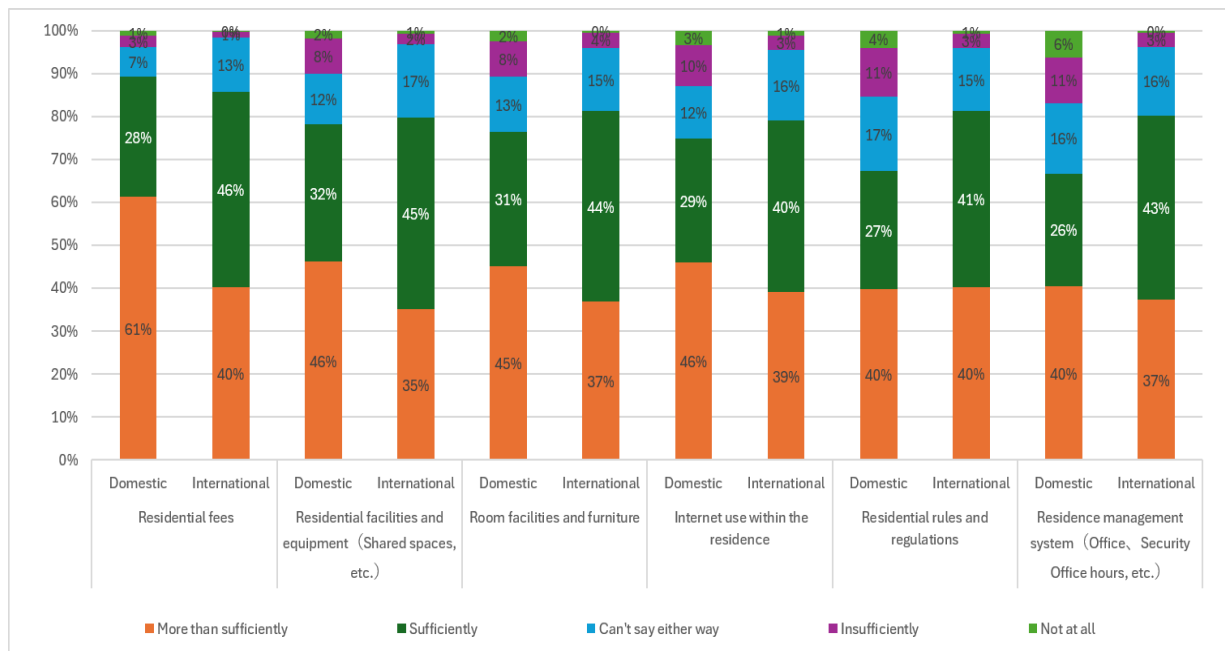

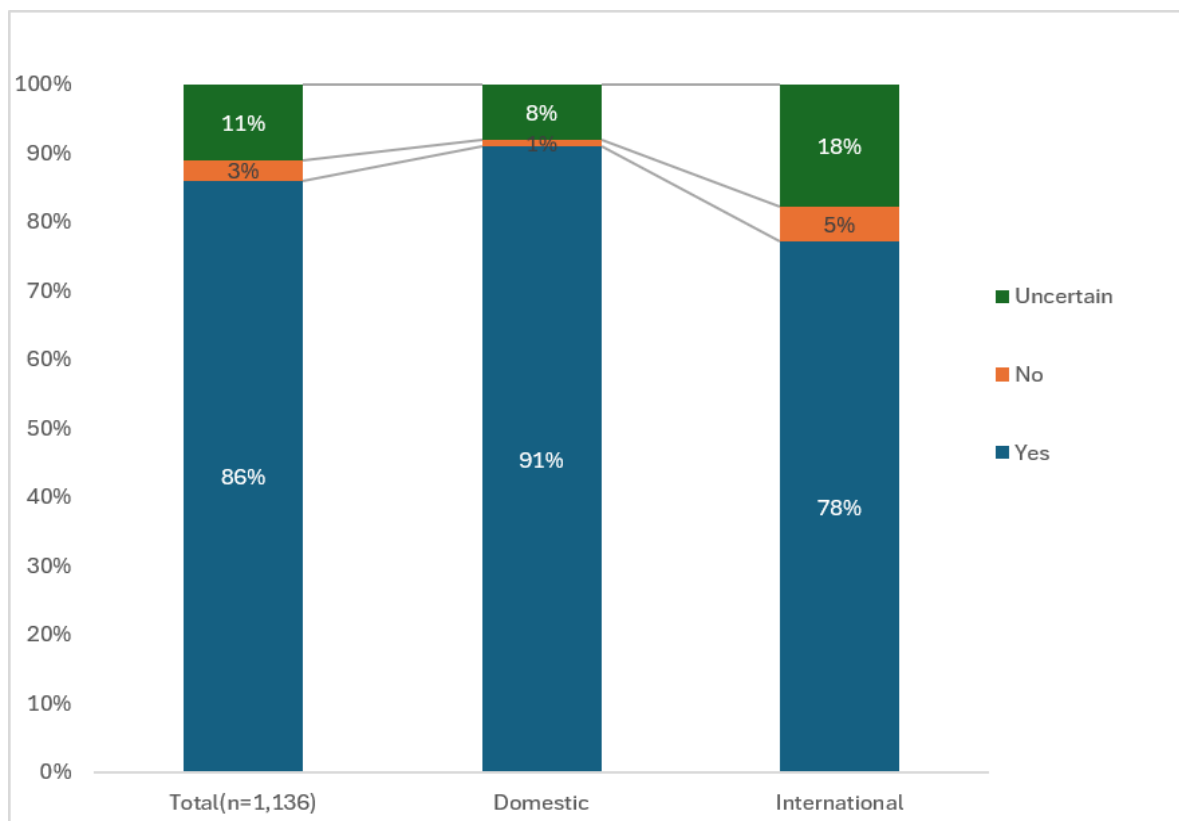

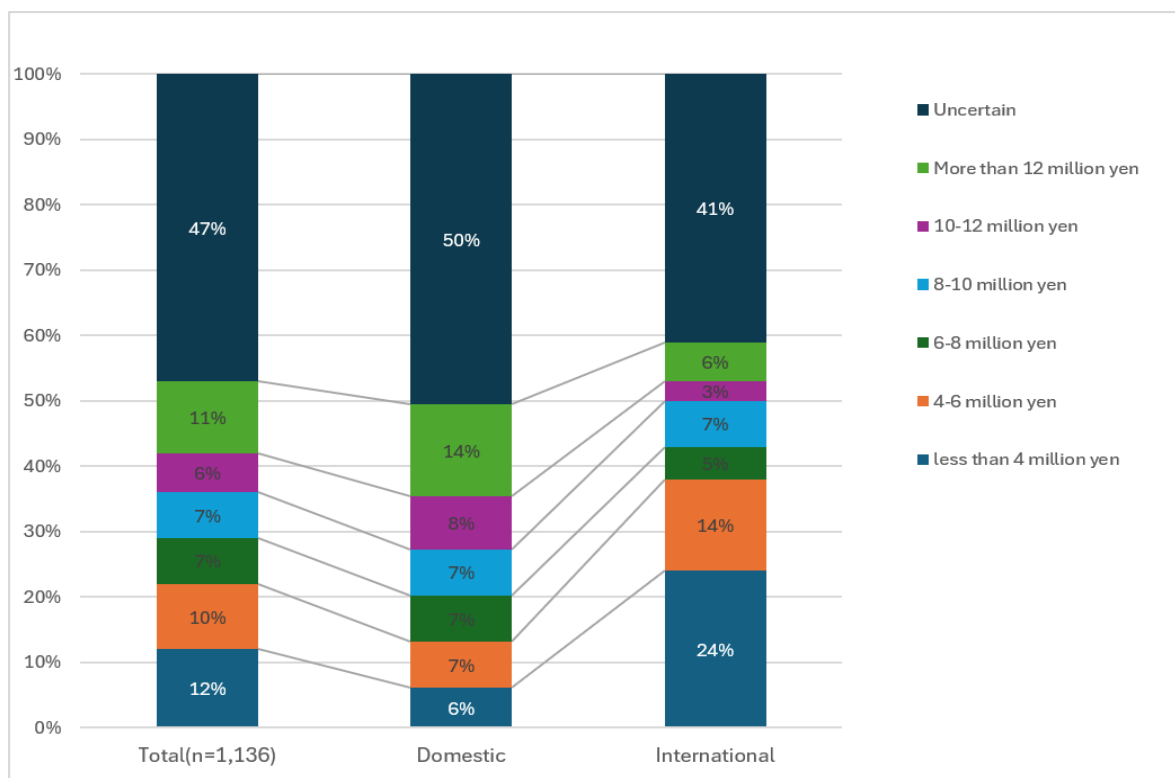

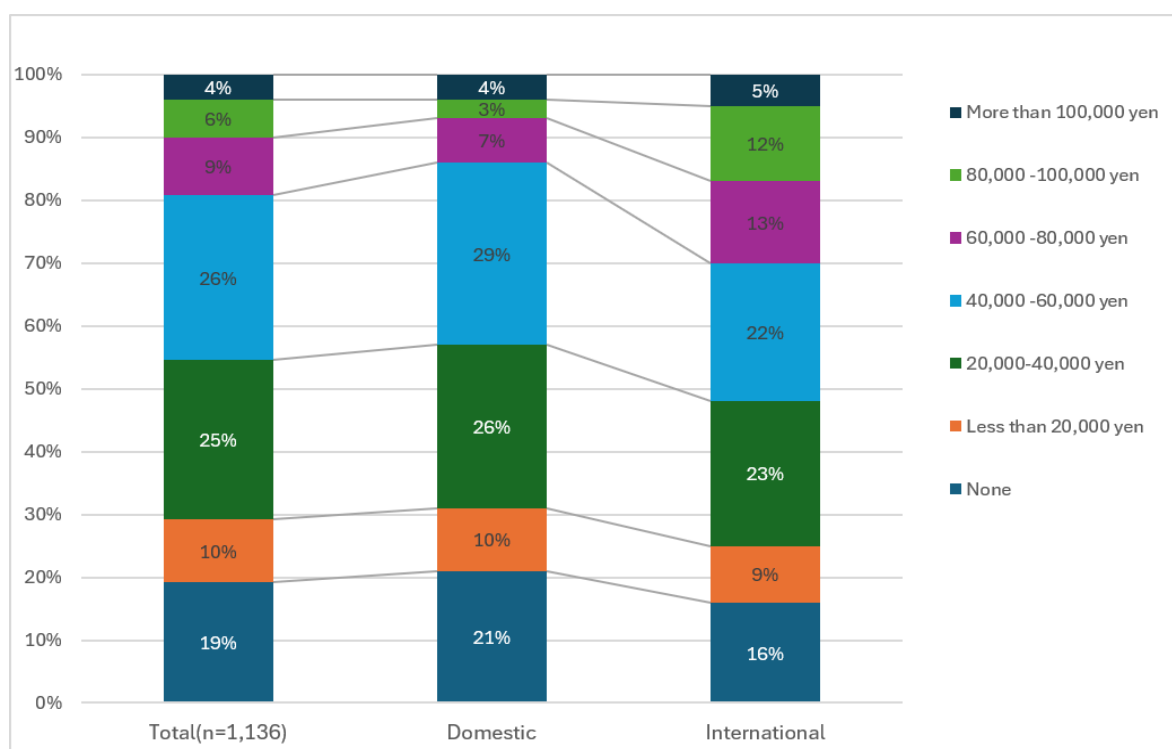

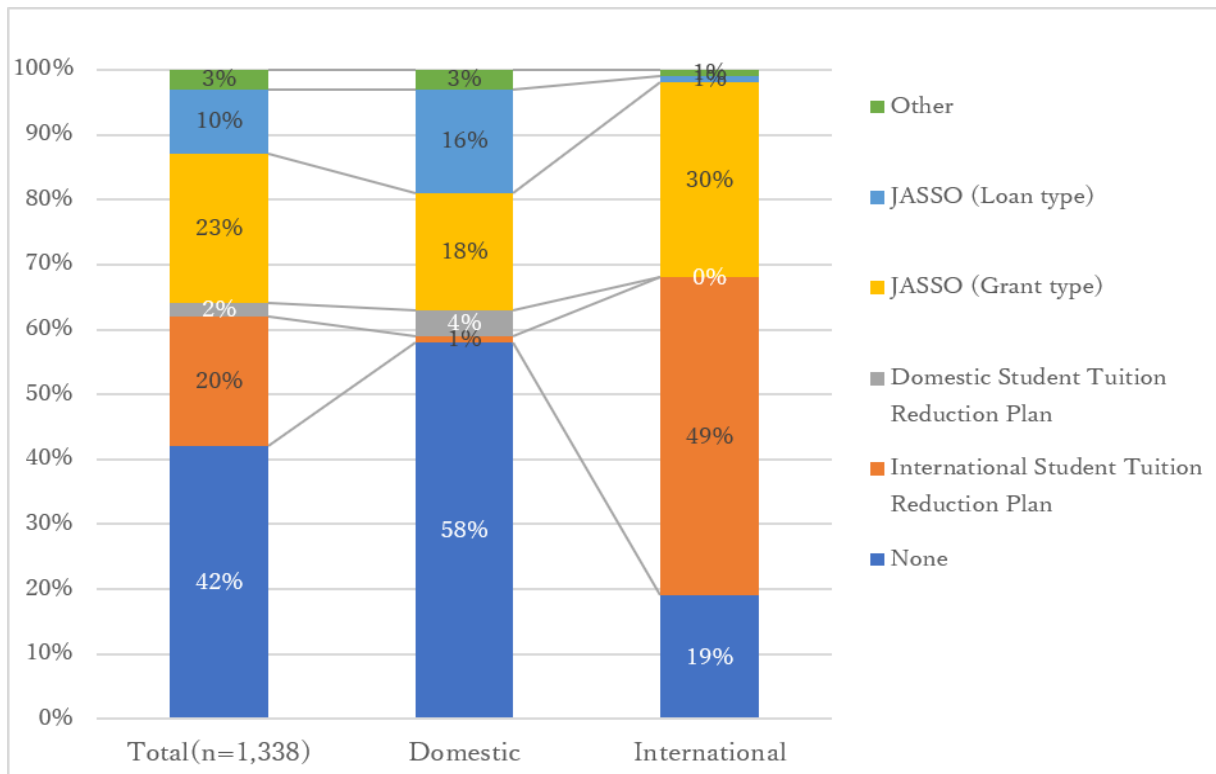
(2 2) Q29, What is the total annual income of your household? (Including both parents)



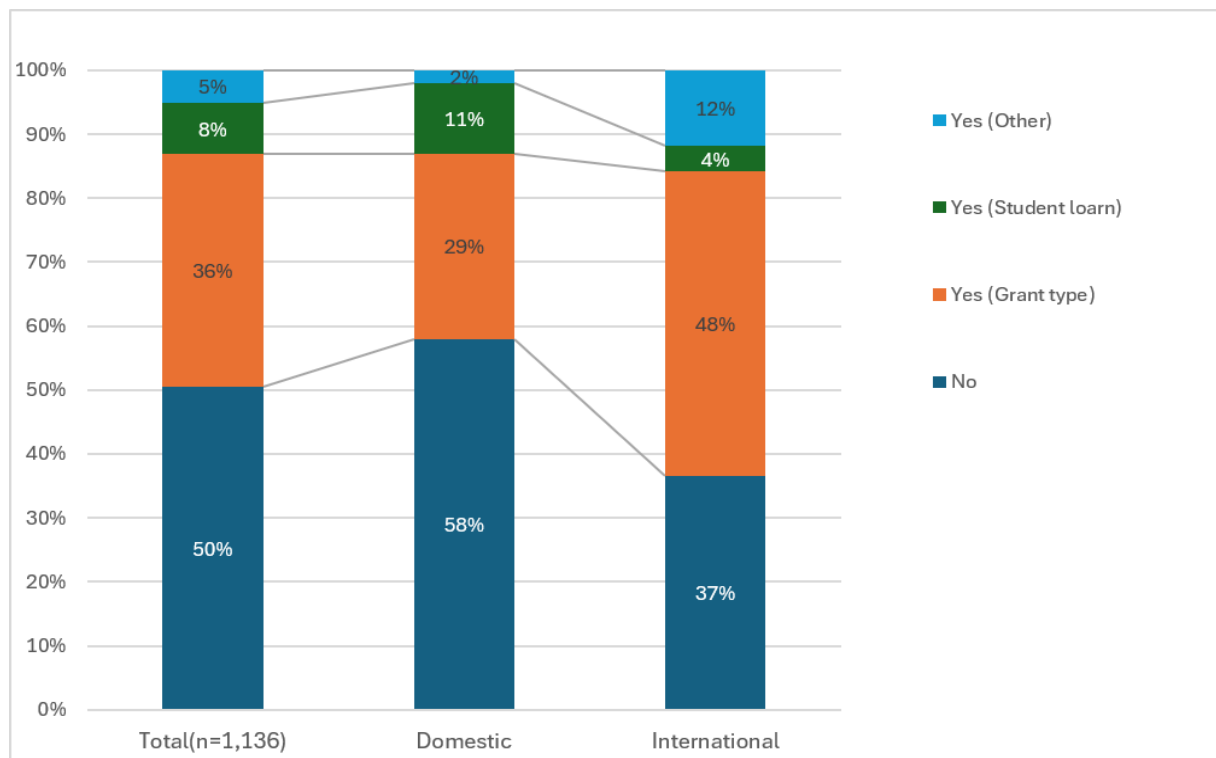
(2 3) Q30, How much money does your family send you monthly? (Excluding rent)



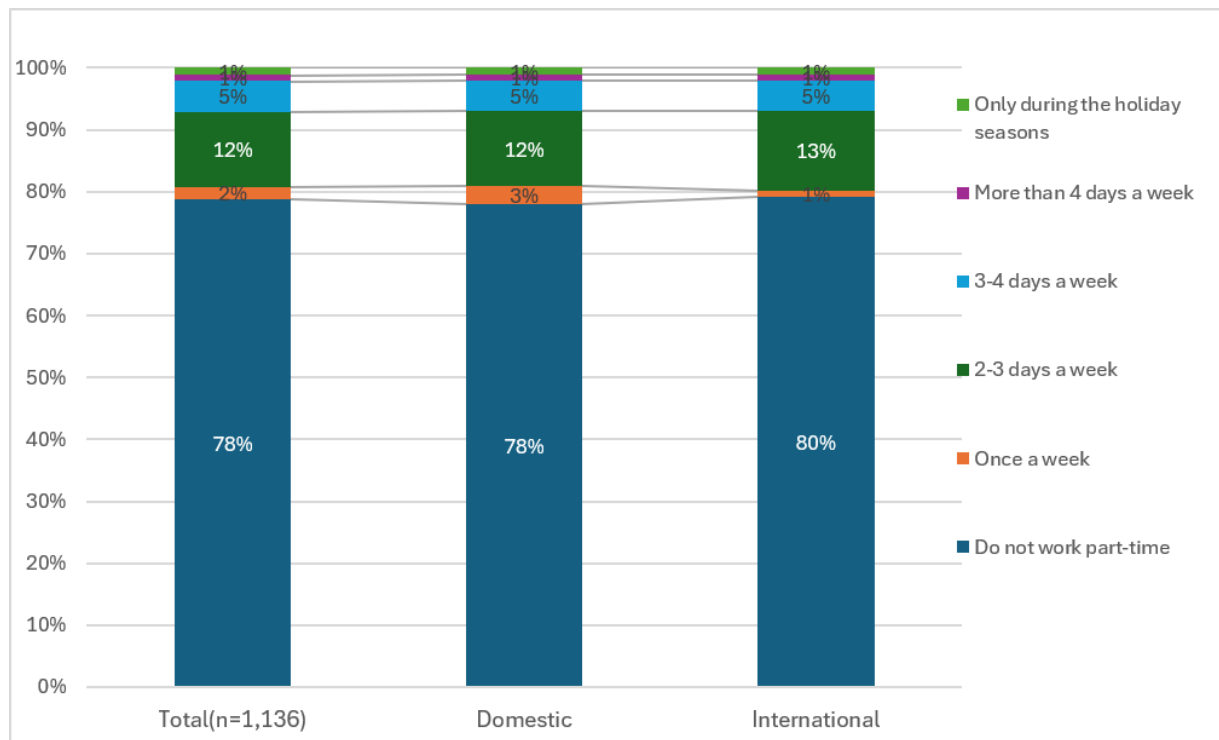
(2 4) Q31, Select the scholarship /student loan you currently receive. (Multiple answers allowed)



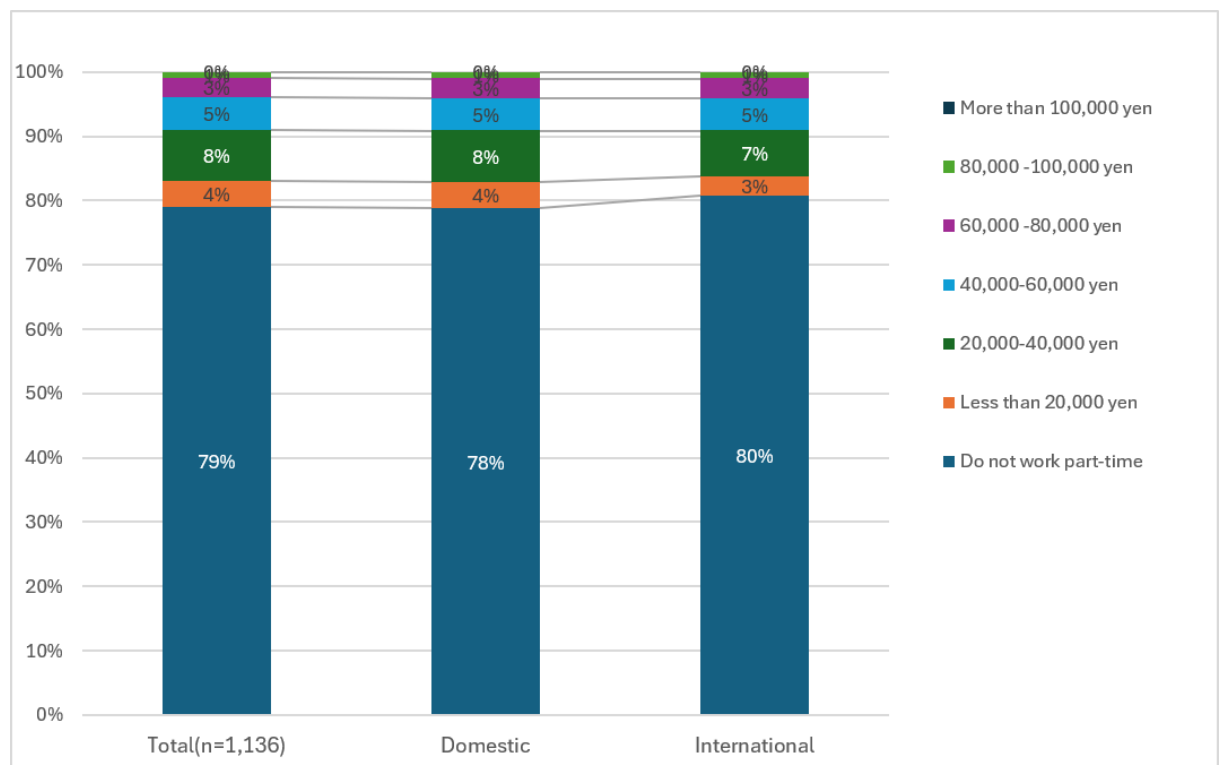
