

Iizuka High School student English Presentation Camp Participant Recruitment Guidelines

Based on the cooperation agreement between Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (APU), Kyushu Institute of Technology (Kyutech), and Iizuka City, we are now recruiting participants for the “High School Student Presentation Camp.”

Local high school students will give English presentations on the themes of “Digital,” “Global,” “Inclusive Society,” and “Inclusion.” Through receiving advice and feedback from university students, they will deepen mutual exchange and foster personal growth. We look forward to the participation of students from APU!

1. Purpose of the Event

In March 2025, the international conference “APNG Camp” was held at the Kyutech Iizuka Campus, bringing together young people from across the Asia-Pacific region to discuss various issues and build cooperative relationships for the future. During the event, local high school teams gave English presentations and engaged in Q&A and exchanges with students from various countries.

To continue promoting interaction between local high schools and universities and to provide opportunities for personal development, we are organizing this event.

2. Activity Details

※As a general rule, participants are expected to take part in both (1) and (2).

However, if the high school teams do not wish to have (1), participation may be limited to (2) only.

(1) Online Discussion Session (Advice for High School Students)

※Only the desired team

- ①Date Mid-February 2026 (Approx. 1 hour)
- ②Format Online
- ③Content University students will provide advice to help high school students improve their presentation content.

(2) High School English Presentation Event

- ①Date Sunday, March 15, 2026, 13:00 – 17:00
- ②Venue Learning Agora Building, Kyutech Iizuka Campus
- ③Content
 - ・Q&A and feedback on high school students’ English presentations
 - ・Group work with junior and senior high school students (reflection and

discussion)

※ Group work will consist of 5 high school students, 2 university students, and 1 junior high school student per group.

- Facilitation Skills : Enhancing guidance and support skills through advising high school students
- Presentation Evaluation Skills : Developing logical thinking and critical analysis through evaluating and advising on presentations
