Actions during Earthquakes

[Indoors]

- · Protect your head and take cover under a desk or a safe place.
- · Open door and secure exit.

[Outdoors]

· Protect your head with a bag or clothes, evacuate to a safe place indoors



[During Tsunami]

· Evacuate to higher ground



[During Typhoons]

- · Beware of landslides
- · Evacuate to sturdy buildings away from rivers and cliffs.
- · Beware of falling into open manholes.

Actions during fires



· Shout"Fire!"loudly

- Notify others and ask for help
- Use the emergency alarm, call <u>119</u>





- · Extinguish the fire within the first 3 minutes
- · If not extinguish able, escape at once
- · If you must escape through smoke: Cover your mouth with a hand kerchief stay low
- · Use stairs to evacuate Do not use elevators
- · Do not return to the fire
- Notify firefighters of an yone
