Issuance of Student ID Card and Opening a Japan Post Bank Account

On Thursday, April 2, we will issue your Student ID Card and support you to open your Japan Post bank account so please come to F104 regardless of your college during the hours of 9 am to 11 am.

<Procedure you need to carry out by this date>

- ① On this day, we will confirm the new address on your residence card. Thus, please make sure to register your address at the Beppu City Hall by March 31. If you do not complete your address registration, you will NOT be able to open your Japan Post Bank Account on this day.
- ② You will need Japan Post Bank Account (Yucho Bank account) to receive scholarship, pay tuition fee, as well as to make any other transactions for your everyday life such as receiving your part time payment and paying for electricity bills, etc.

In order to open your bank account, you need to fill in the following survey by the deadline.
Deadline: April 1, 11:59pm

<Things you need to bring on the day>

- ①Passport
- ②Residence card
- ③A device which you can check your e-mail
- ④A screenshot of the screen showing your student ID number in the email which was sent to you on the Admissions Office
- ⑤Black ballpoint pen (erasable pens are not acceptable)
- ⑥INKAN: Personal Seal (if you have one)
- ⑦Social Security Number (for U.S. citizen students only)
- ⑧Bankbook of your Yucho Bank account (if you already have an account)
