	Other Eligibility Requirements	(1) Applicants must be self-supporting international students residing in Japan with "college student" status and must be 38 years old or younger as of April 1, 2025. (2) Applicants must be enrolled in an official degree program at a graduate school in Japan and pursuing studies in business administration. (International relations is also acceptable for students from developing countries where business administration is not an established discipline.) (3) Applicants must have an international perspective and demonstrate the ability to lead and serve as a bridge between Japan and other countries. (4) Applicants must be involved in creative or innovative research. (5) Applicants must be expected to produce research achievements during the period covered by the scholarship. (6) Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial aid . (7) Applicants must give full support and cooperation to events held by the Foundation and must contribute to building a network between scholarship recipients. (8) Applicants must be motivated to study the Japanese language and be highly motivated, possess an outstanding academic record, and demonstrate personal integrity. (9) Applicants must be able to have their supervising professor or other person provide appropriate guidance and pre-check the documents they submit to the Foundation (including application documents). (10) Those who are unlikely to complete their studies within the standard period for completion are ineligible (students using the System for Extending the Period of Registration and over-doctor students are also ineligible). The scholarship will be revoked when it becomes impossible for the scholar to complete their studies within the standard period after being selected. (11) Applicants must not be receiving/be going to receive another scholarship. (12) Applicants must have never directly applied for a scholarship provided by this foundation and must have never applied to APU to be recommended for this scholarship and failed to pass the screening. (13) Applicants are not permitted to leave Japan for 40 or more days in total during the period covered by the scholarship. (Including travel and going back to home country) (*Those who are outside Japan at the time of application, document screening, interview, or certification ceremony are not eligible for selection.)
