

If you will attend another school in Japan after graduating from APU:

1. Move-in / Move-out Procedures

- (1) You must first submit a move-out notification at Beppu City Hall.

- (2) Submit a move-in notification to the Citizen's Section in the city hall of your new residence.

<Addresses and your residence card>

You must submit move-out and move-in notifications to your local government office when moving; staff at city hall will write your new address on the back of your residence card once these procedures are complete. If you write your address on your residence card by yourself, it will make your card invalid. **NEVER write your address or anything else on your residence card by yourself.**

3. About status of residence for international students who go on to graduate school after graduating from university

For international students who have decided to go on to a graduate school after graduating from a university, and whose period of stay of "College Student" currently held by the time of enrollment has expired, the graduate school to which they are enrolled will have a relationship with the international student. If you pledge to keep in touch at regular intervals and to contact the regional immigration bureau without delay in the event of cancellation of admission, you will be permitted to change your status of residence to "Designated Activities" and enter the school. (However, it is limited to a period not exceeding one year after graduating from university.). Please find the details at the Immigration Bureau website.
