\* If you are selected as a scholarship recipient by a scholarship organization, you are required to communicate with them and become actively involved in their activities.

### 【Important Note】

(1) Students in the following categories are not eligible to apply:

- Students whose lack of morality and/or impaired sense of responsibility makes them unsuitable scholarship recipients.
- Students who have not completed matters that are required by University Rules, such as a regular health check (including re-examinations and detailed examinations).
- Students who have already been selected as a recipient of another scholarship that does not then allow recipients to be awarded any additional scholarship, or who have applied for such a scholarship.

(2) Even after being selected as a candidate or a scholarship recipient, that status will be revoked in the case that the following matters are confirmed:

- False information in application materials
- Any incident that breaches the conditions of the scholarship, such as a scholarship recipient being the subject of any University Disciplinary Actions
- Incompletion of matters that are required by University Rules, such as a regular health check (including re-examinations and detailed examinations)
