Responsibilities of Scholarship Recipients	Other Eligibility Requirements	(1) A student with citizenship of a country other than Japan who is paying their own expenses. Someone who intends to study in Japan as an official undergraduate student, graduate student or doctoral student of University designated by JEES as of April 2022 and possesses a student visa. (2) Someone in need of financial assistance (someone who pays for a large portion of their own expenses through part time work, etc.). (3) Someone not receiving other scholarships except for loan scholarships, tuition exemption or one time lump sum scholarships during the scholarship period. (4) Someone eligible to receive the scholarship for at least one year. (5) Someone who has not received the Mitsubishi Corporation International Scholarship in the past. (6) A talented, well-behaved individual in good mental and physical health. (7) Someone with a keen interest in societal contribution geared towards international exchange who has a strong desire to contribute to the development of global society both now and in the future. (8) Someone who does not plan to go abroad for six months total or longer during the scholarship period regardless of whether it is for a leave of absence or not. (9) Someone who comes highly recommended from their university.			
Responsibilities of Scholarship Recipients	[Duties] (1) Scholarship recipients (hereinafter "recipients") must submit a report detailing the status of their studies or research during the scholarship period to their university head at the end of the school year (format designated by JEES). (2) Recipients must send a notice (designated format) to JEES through the university when their student status changes. (3) Recipients must send a notice (designated format) to JEES through the university when their address and/or contact information changes during the scholarship period. After the scholarship period, they must notify JEES directly if there are any changes (no fixed format). (4) Recipients must submit a report (designated format) to JEES on the status of their career after graduation when graduating from the university. (5) Recipients, upon request of JEES or the scholarship donor, will be asked to answer surveys both during and after the scholarship period. (6) Recipients will participate in an exchange event (once a year).				
	[Suspension, Termination, and Cancellation of the Scholarship] (1) The scholarship will not be paid if a recipient is absent from classes for an extended period of time (over one month). It may be possible to begin receiving the scholarship again during the during the scholarship period if the recipient submits an application for recommencement once the reason why the recipient was absent ceases to be an issue. The scholarship period will not be extended. (2) The scholarship will be terminated if a recipient: ① graduates, withdraws, expelled, suspended, takes an extended leave of absence from school or repeats the same year (including equivalent cases). ② plans to go abroad for six months total or longer during the scholarship period regardless of whether it is on a leave of absence or not. ③ fails to fulfill the duties of a recipient. ④ no longer fulfills all of the application requirements. ⑤ engages in conduct deemed to be unacceptable. (3) The scholarship will be terminated if the scholarship donor ceases donation. (4) The scholarship will be cancelled if it is discovered that any of the application materials were incorrect. (5) The scholarship will be cancelled if a recipient does not come to Japan due to personal reasons once travel restrictions are lifted.				
	[Others (Cautions)] (1) Recipients do not bear the responsibility to pay back the scholarship except in the cases listed above in [Suspension, Termination, and Cancellation of the Scholarship] , in which case recipients may be asked to refund part or all of the scholarship. Also, the scholarship is in no way connected to the recruitment procedures, etc. of the scholarship donor. (2) Applicants must notify JEES immediately through their university when they decide to receive an other scholarship before the University receives the selection results. Applicants must not decline for the purpose of receiving other scholarships after the selection results have been received. (3) Recipients must not apply for other scholarships during the scholarship period (except for scholarships starting after the scholarship period has ended). (4) Those who have received this scholarship in the past cannot apply again. (5) Recipients can continue to receive this scholarship if studying abroad via one of the university's official programs if the period is less than 7 months and is not considered a long-term absence or leave of absence. (6) As a general rule, recipients must reside in Japan during the scholarship period. (7) If a recipient arrives in Japan in or after May 2022 because of a special reason, the recipient will receive the scholarship from the month they arrive in Japan to the end of the minimum period of study.
