Graduation Requirements – 3rd Year **APS** Transfer Students



3rd year English-basis transfer students must fulfill the requirements shown below to graduate from the College of Asia Pacific Studies (APS).

	Requirements
1	Enroll for at least two years at APU
2	Complete at least 124 credits (including the 62 transferred credits) in total
3	Fulfill the credit requirements for each subject field
4	Choose and register for an Area of Study
5	Complete at least 2 credits of required subjects for your Area of Study (Common Liberal Arts Subjects)
6	Complete at least 28 credits of Major Education Subjects for your registered Area of Study

3rd-year Transfer Students – Credit Transfers on Enrollment



- 3rd year transfer students may transfer <u>a maximum of 62</u> <u>credits</u> at the time of enrollment.
- Credits will be transferred into their subject fields based on the results of the credit transfer application process.
- Students may not transfer more than 62 credits, even if they have earned more than that at their previous institution.
- Grades for transferred credits appear as "T"= Transfer on your grade report and are not included in your GPA.

Notes



In principle, the following kinds of subjects are not eligible for transfer at the time of enrollment:

*For the double degree program, credit transfer will be conducted based on the agreement between the partner university and APU.

- APS required subjects for each Area of Study (Common Liberal Arts subjects)
- APM required subjects
- * Required courses should be taken at APU.

In addition to the 62 credits of major education subjects, 3rd year APS transfer students must earn at least 2 credits of required courses (common liberal arts subjects) for their registered Area of Study.

Notes for Course Registration



- First, check the number of credits you need to graduate in each subject field.
- You should prioritize your college's "Major Education Subjects" and "Required Courses" when making your study plan.
- 3rd-year transfer students are NOT required to earn Language Education credits (Japanese). Any credits obtained from the Language Education subjects will be counted as "Language and Common Liberal Arts Subjects" credits.
- Only 3rd-year transfer students who took the Japanese placement test are able to register for designated Japanese language subjects.
