## **AY2020 Fall Semester Tuition Re-extensions**

< Tuition Re-extension Application Procedures >

Students who are unable to pay tuition by January 31 and wish to have the tuition payment deadline re-extended until February 15 <u>must complete all of the following application procedures by the designated application deadline.</u>

1. Application Procedures: Apply by January 29, 2021 via the survey below.

(Those who submitted the survey for payment extension before also have to complete the following survey if they wish to apply for re-extension to February 15, 2021.)

2. Tuition Payment Deadline: 11:59p.m. (Japan Standard Time), February 15, 2021

- 3. Send an email to confirm that you have paid tuition.
  - Deadline: Emails must be received by 11:59 p.m. (JST) on February 15, 2021.
  - Write your student ID number and name in the body of the email and attach proof that you have made the tuition payment (copy of the payment transfer form, etc.).

Please be advised that you will be withdrawn for nonpayment of tuition fees if you do not complete all the above application procedures by the deadline as well as in the case the university is unable to confirm receipt of your tuition payment.

<Overseas Remittance>

- Please be aware there are cases where it may take more than a month for the payment to be deposited in the university's bank account when transferring your tuition payment from an overseas bank account.
- Be sure that your payment is able to be transferred to the university's account by the payment deadline.

<Invoices>

- Domestic Students living in Japan: The university will resend tuition invoices to students living in Japan on January
   7 and 8.
- Domestic Students living outside of Japan and International Students: The University will send an email to you on January 8.
- \* If the campus will be closed due to the wild weather, the notice will be sent to the later dates.
- \*Address are based on the information registered on the Campusmate.

<Bank opening hours in Japan>

• Japanese banks are only open weekdays. You must transfer your tuition payment by 15:00 for the university to

receive your payment if paying on February 15.

<Financial Aid for Domestic Students by Government>

The Japanese government will provide financial aid to students from families that have experienced a significant drop in income. Students must apply within 3 months from when their family began experiencing financial difficulties to be eligible for this support.

<Tuition Payment Deadline from AY2021>

- Tuition payment deadlines will change from AY2021. Tuition extensions will not be possible from AY2021 onward. New tuition payment deadlines: May 31 (Spring Semester) / November 30 (Fall Semester)
- Students will be unable to apply for an extension from AY2021. Failure to pay tuition by the deadline will result in withdrawal for nonpayment of tuition fees.
- International students (students who possess a "student visa") who have been withdrawn for nonpayment of tuition fees will be unable to apply for readmission from the next semester due to the time it will take to reapply for a student visa.
